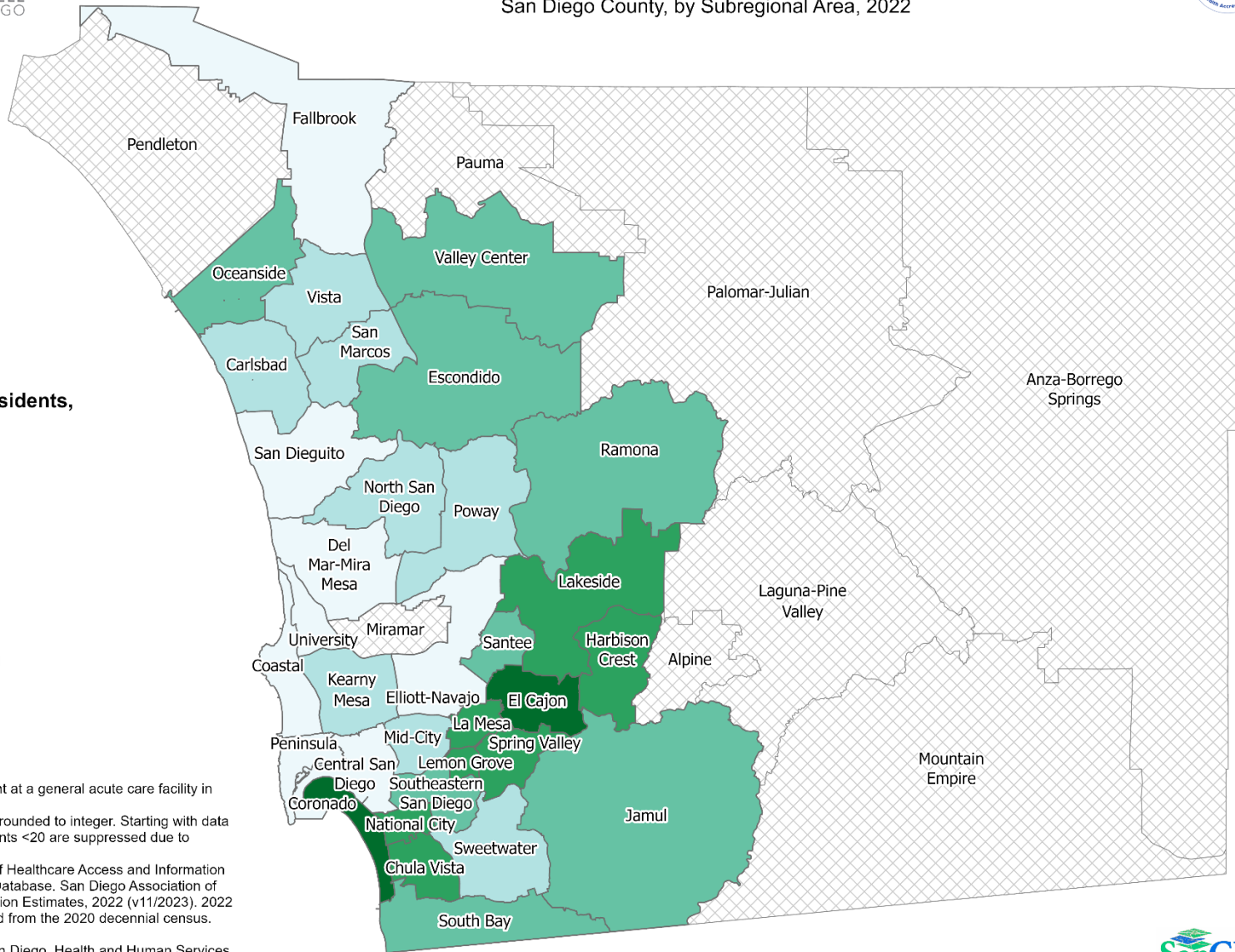
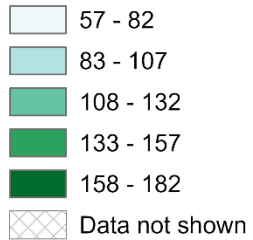


Total Hospitalization Rates* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



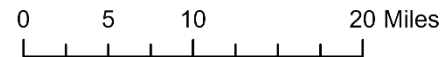

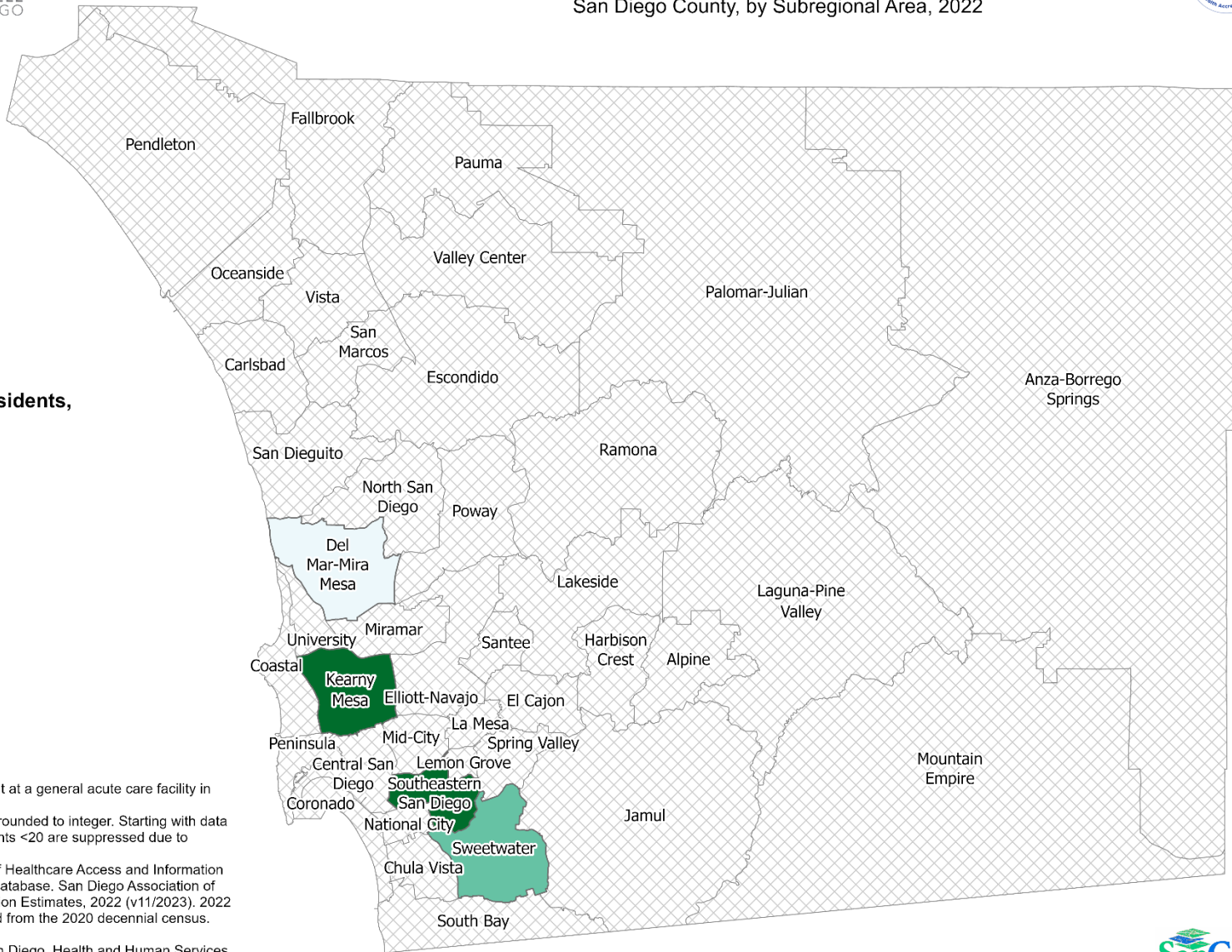
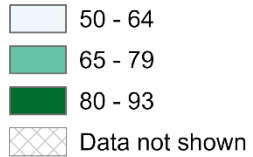


Hospitalization Rates Among Asian/Pacific Islander Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



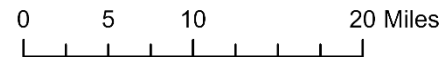

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



Hospitalization Rates Among Black Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022

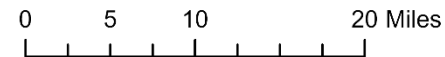

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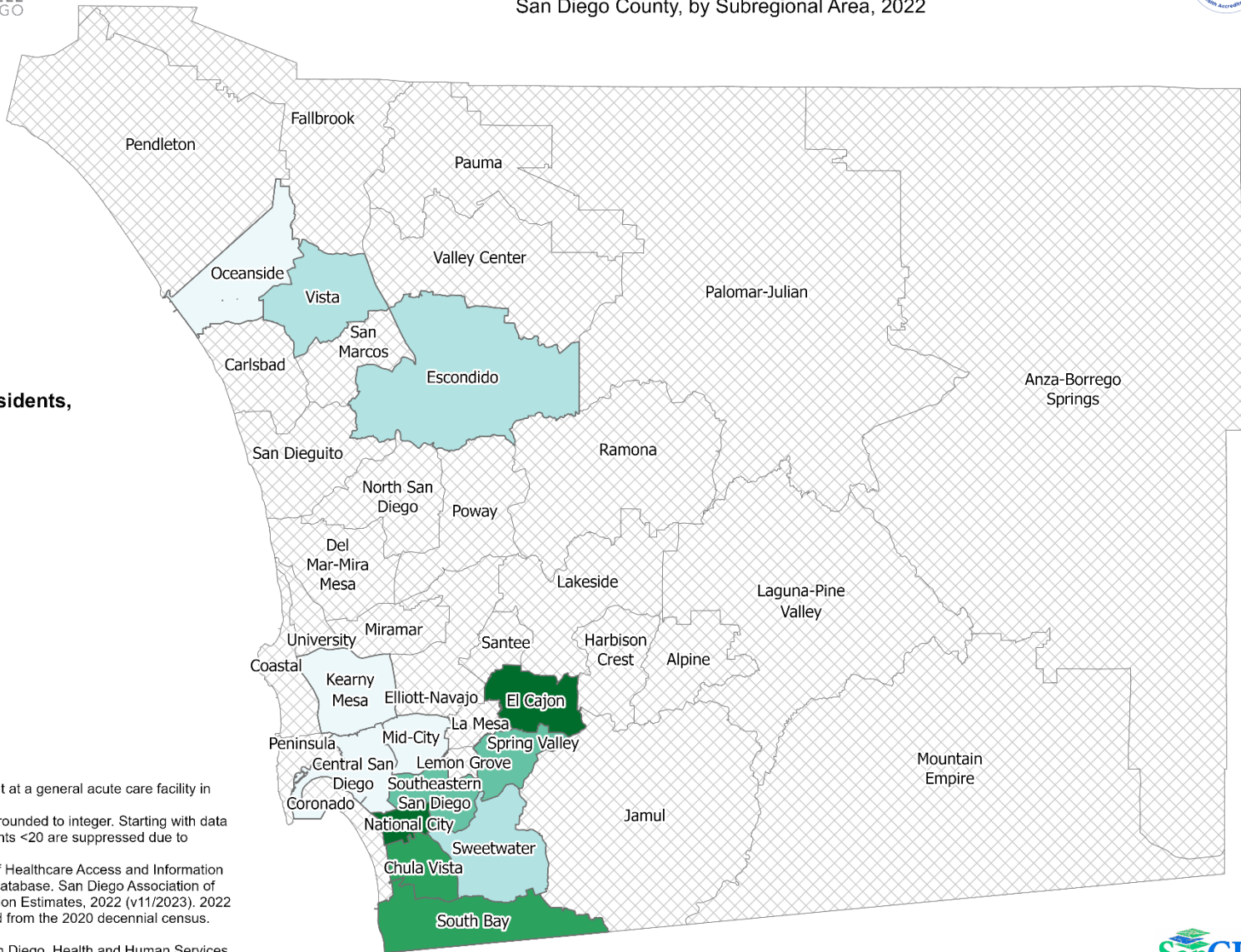
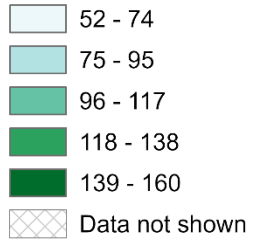


Hospitalization Rates Among Hispanic Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



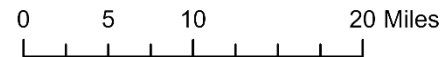

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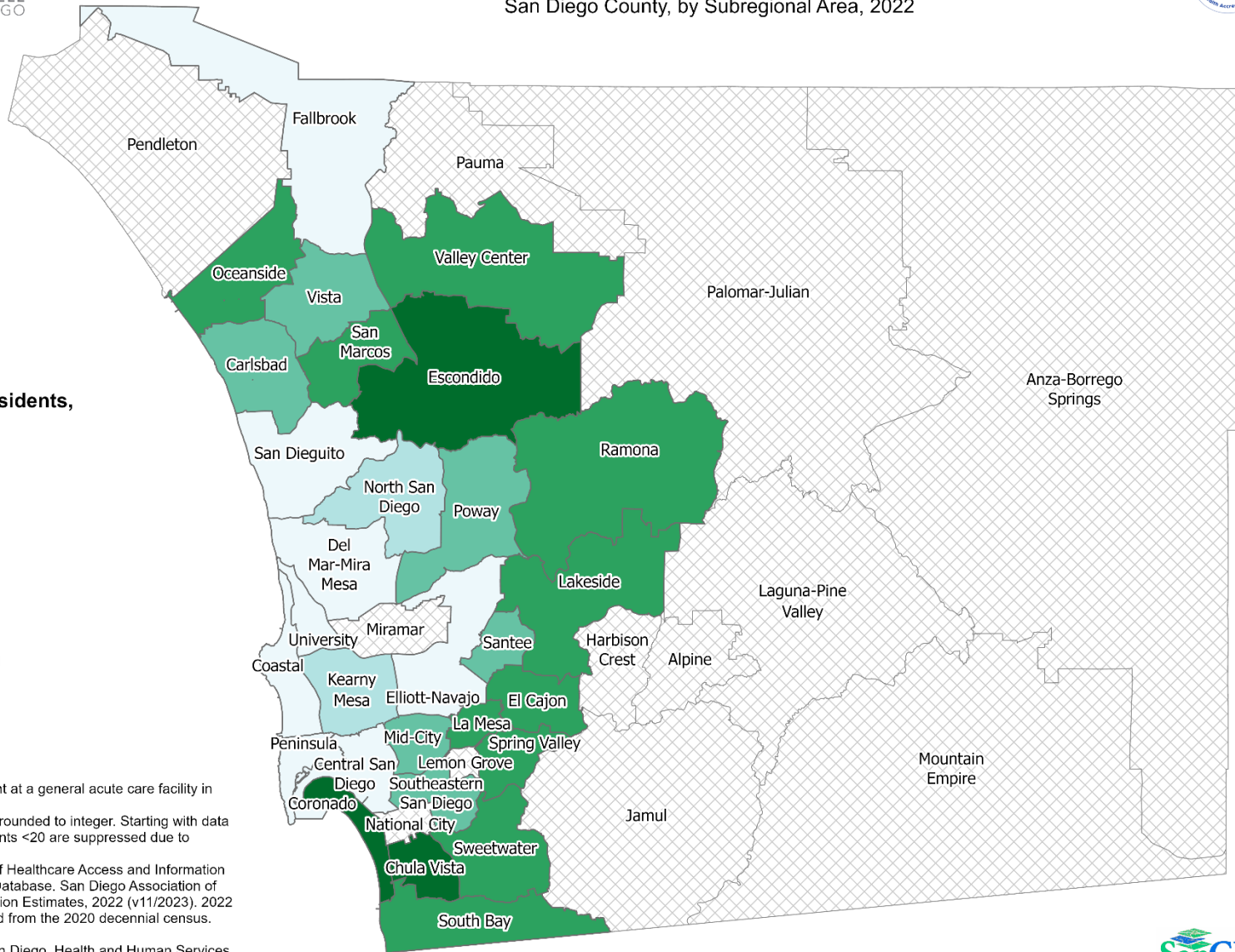
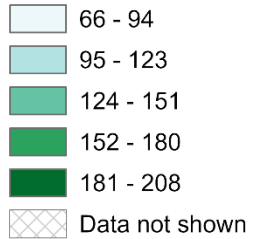


Hospitalization Rates Among White Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



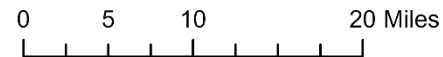

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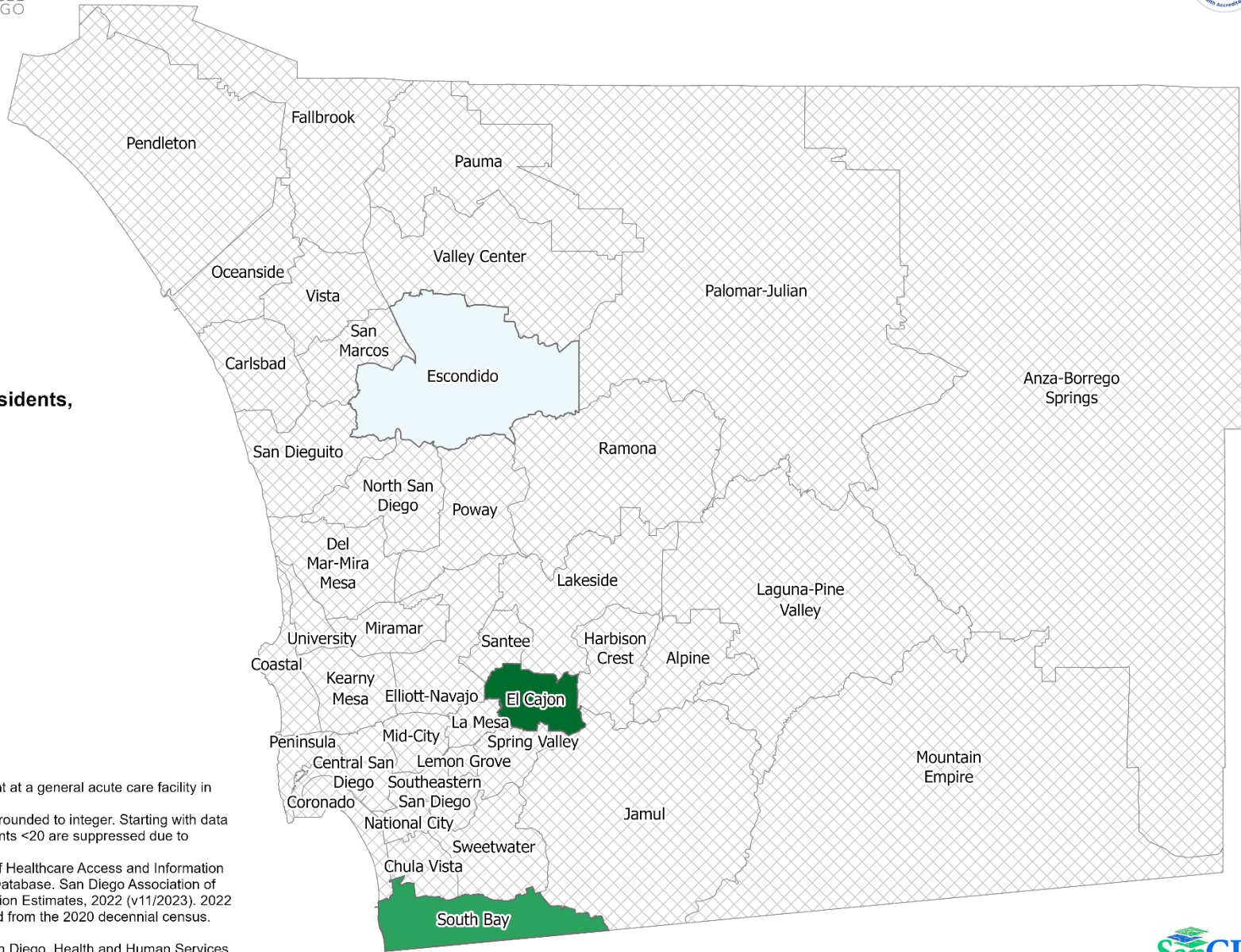
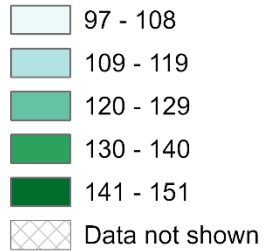


Hospitalization Rates Among Residents, Ages 0-9* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



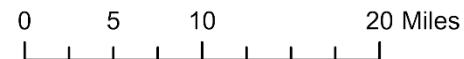

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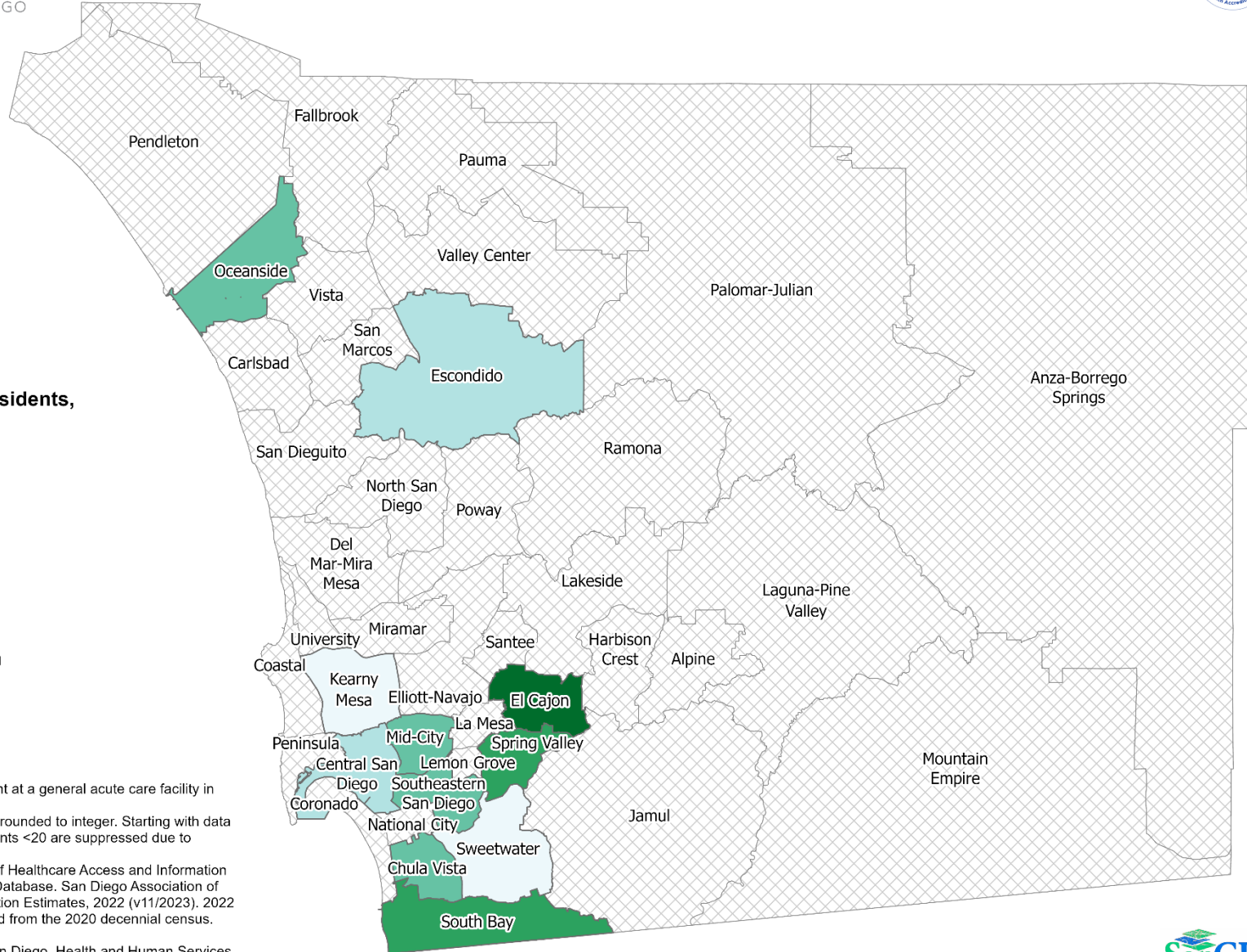
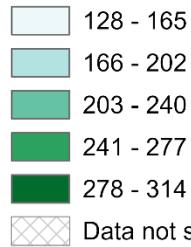


Hospitalization Rates Among Residents, Ages 60-69* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



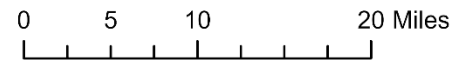

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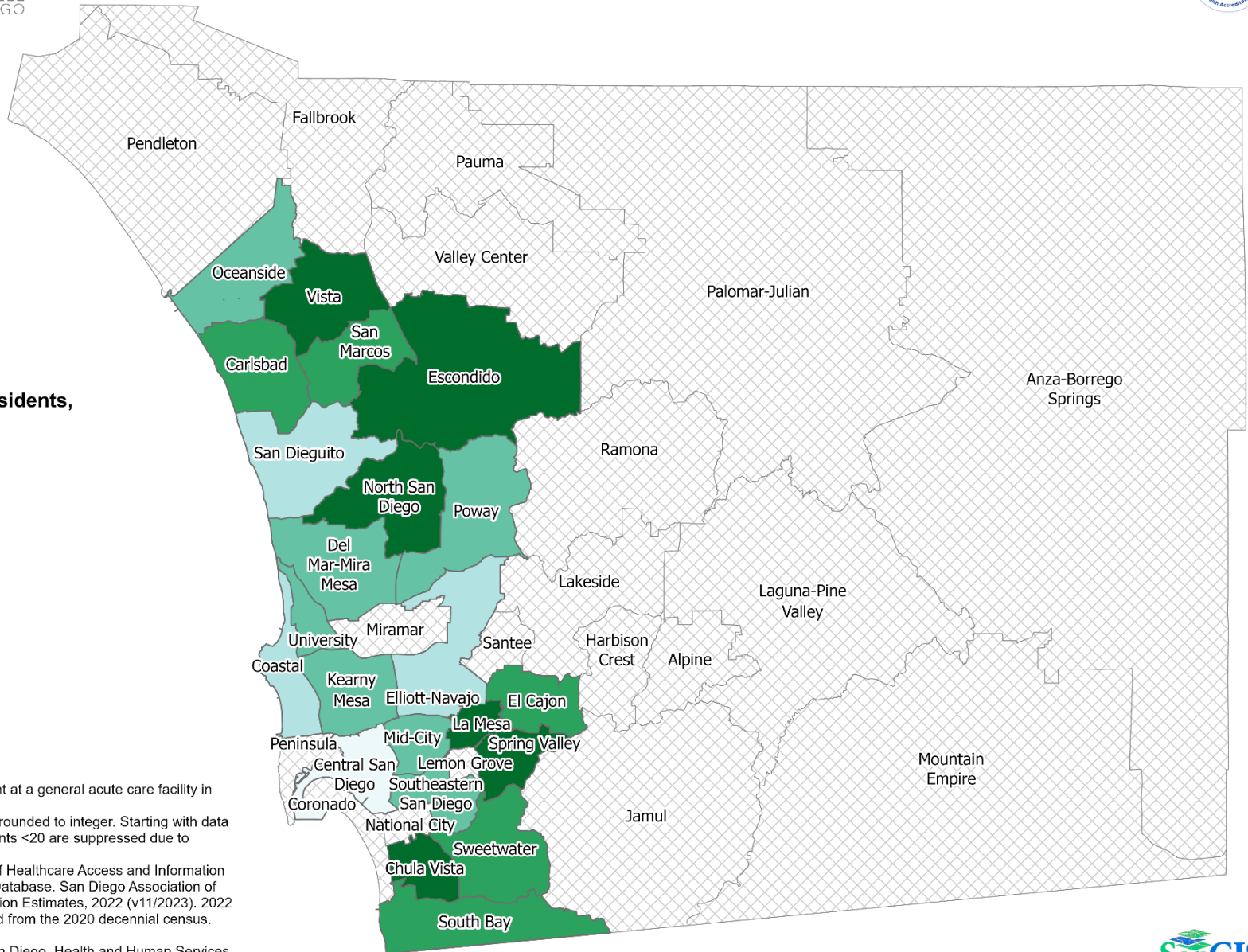
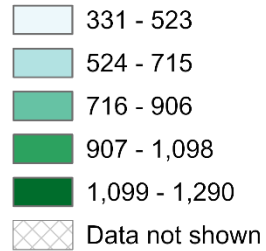


Hospitalization Rates Among Residents, Ages 80+* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



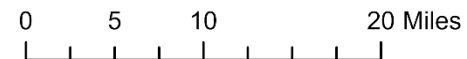

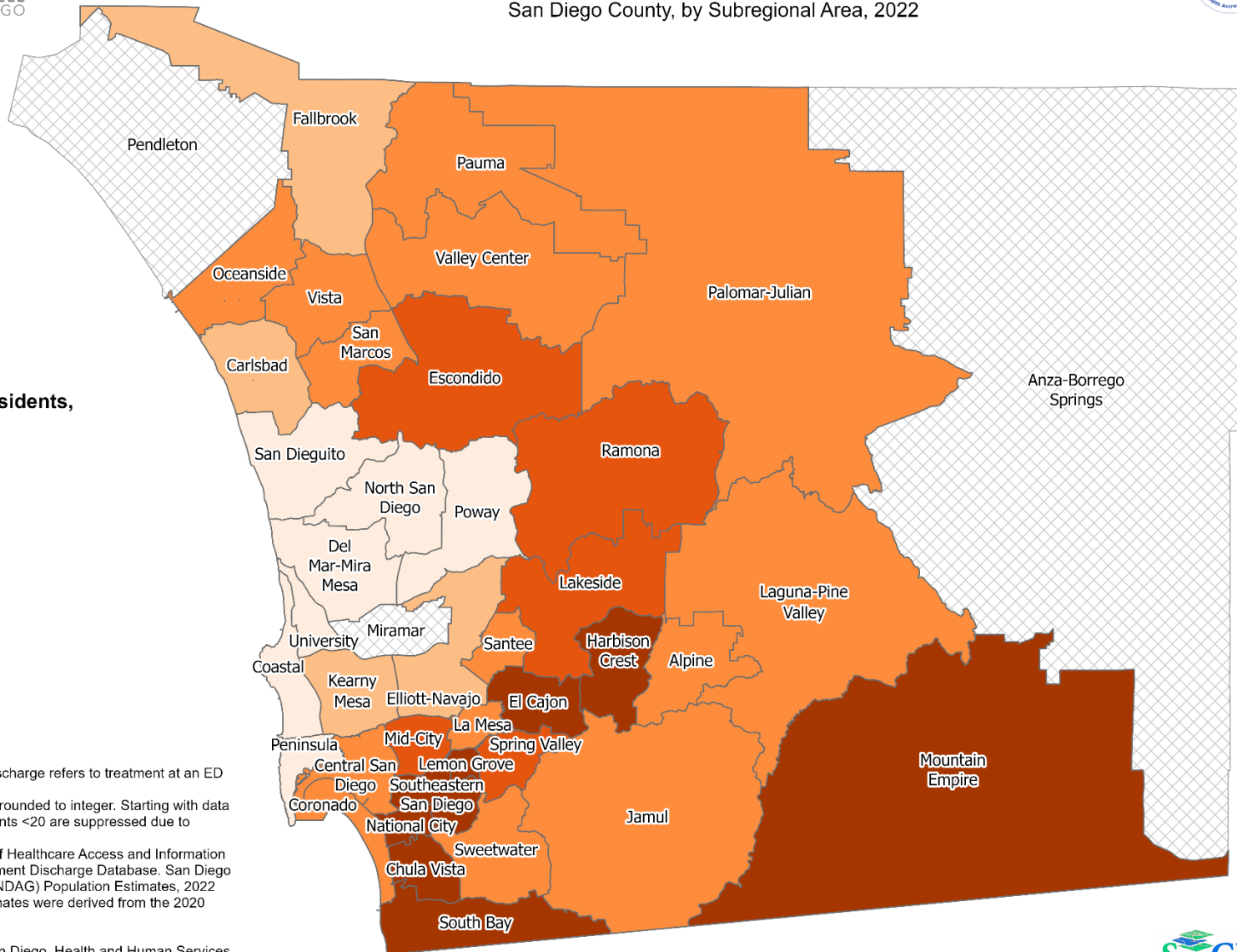
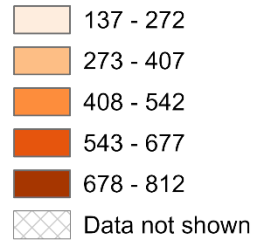


Total Emergency Department Discharge Rates* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



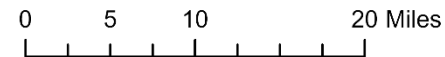

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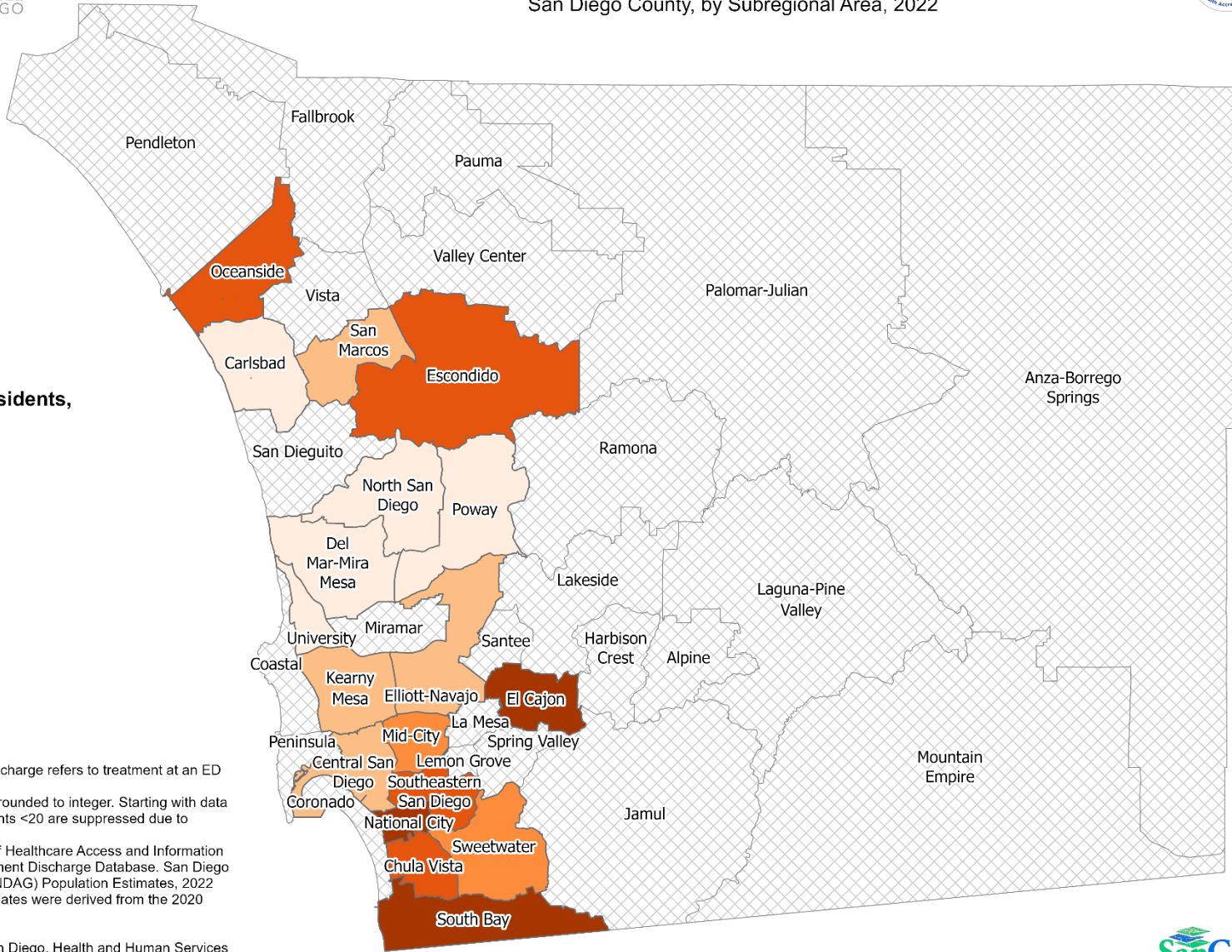
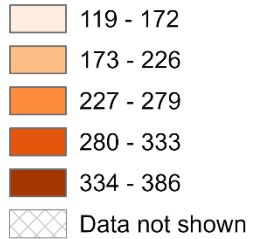


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Asian/Pacific Islander Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



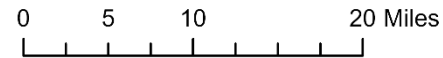

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Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Black Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



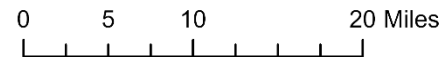
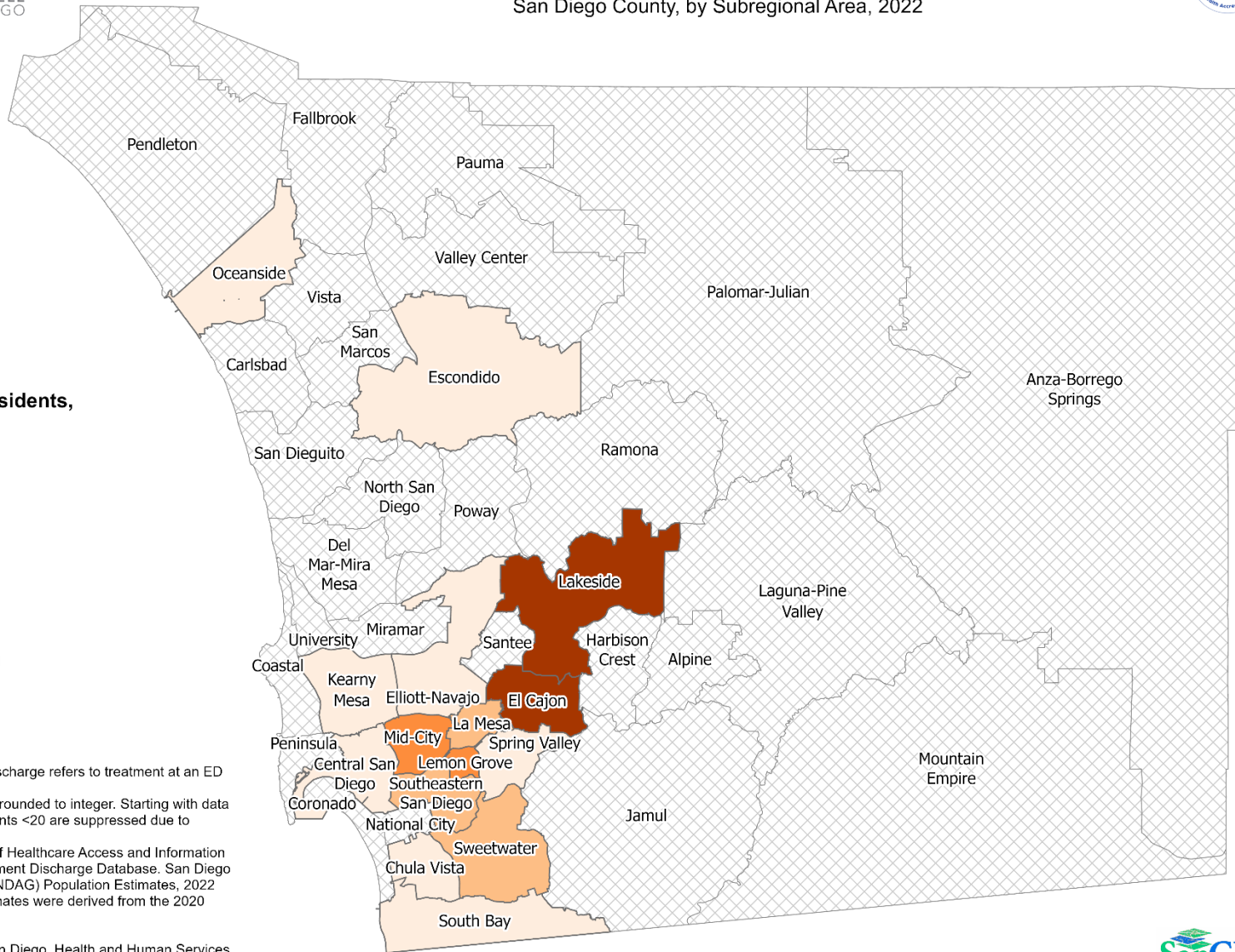

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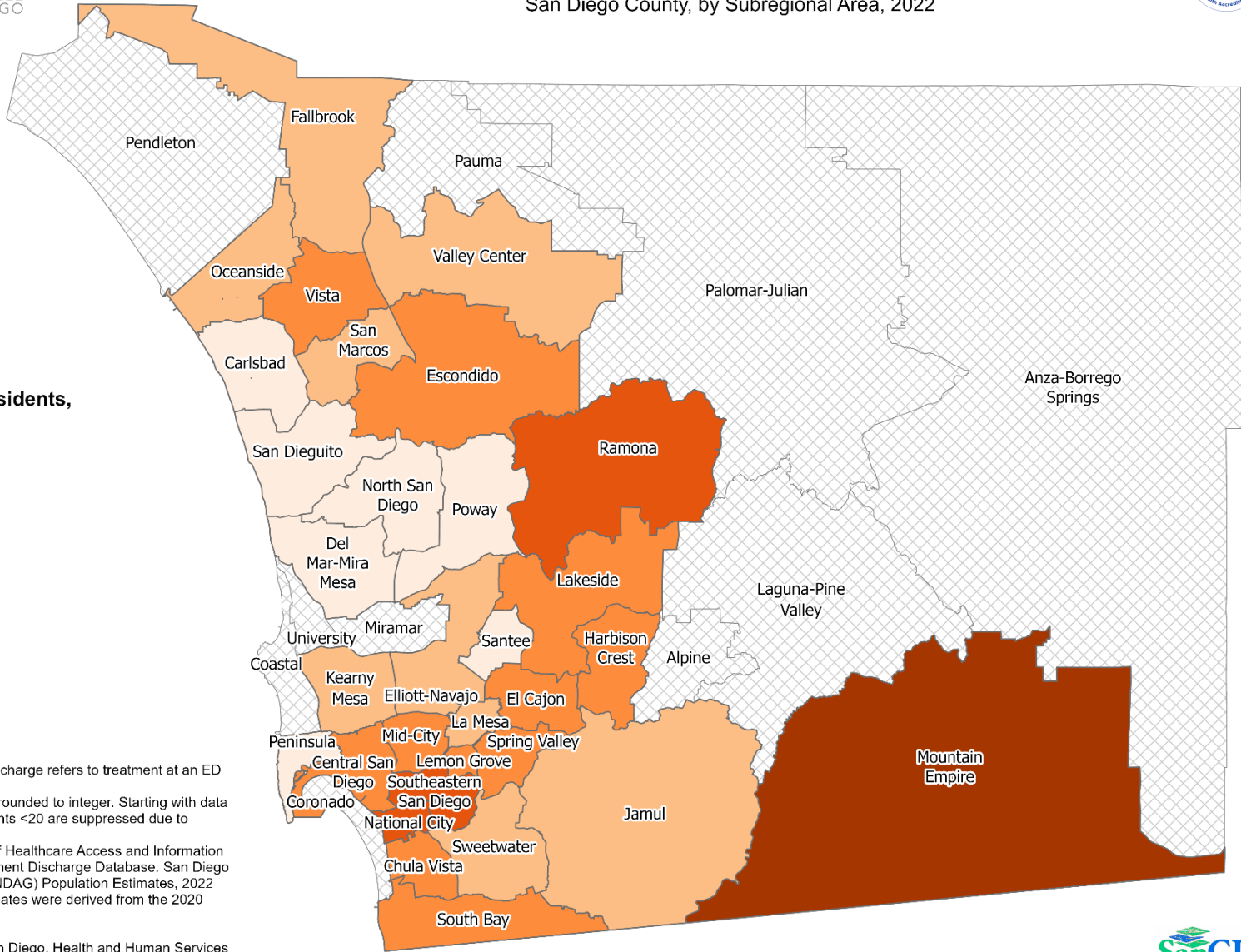
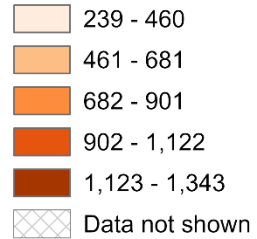


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Hispanic Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



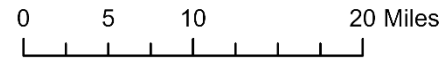

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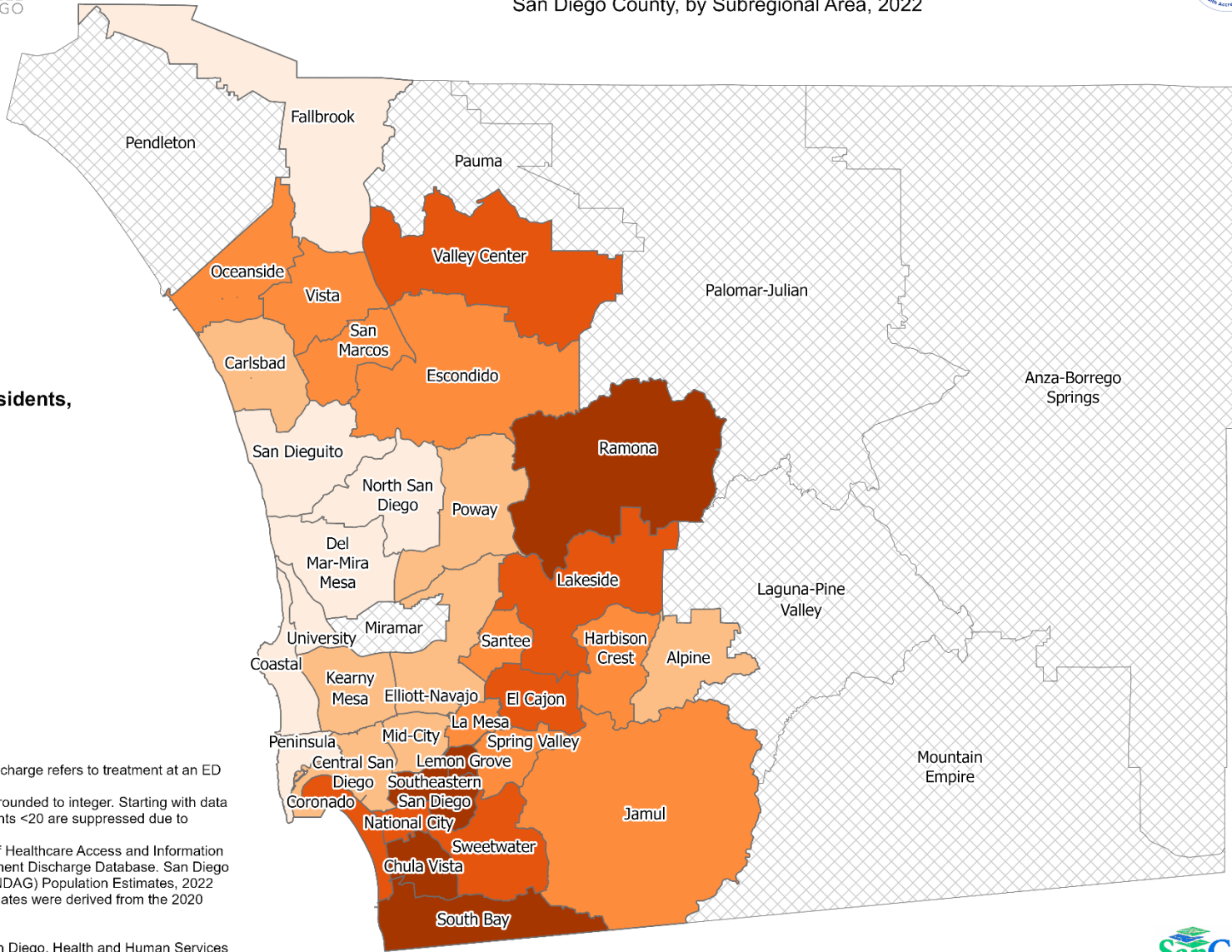
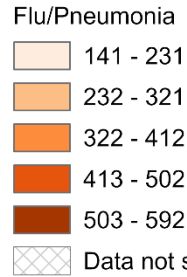




Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among White Residents* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022

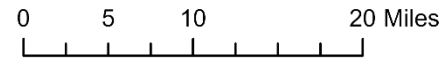

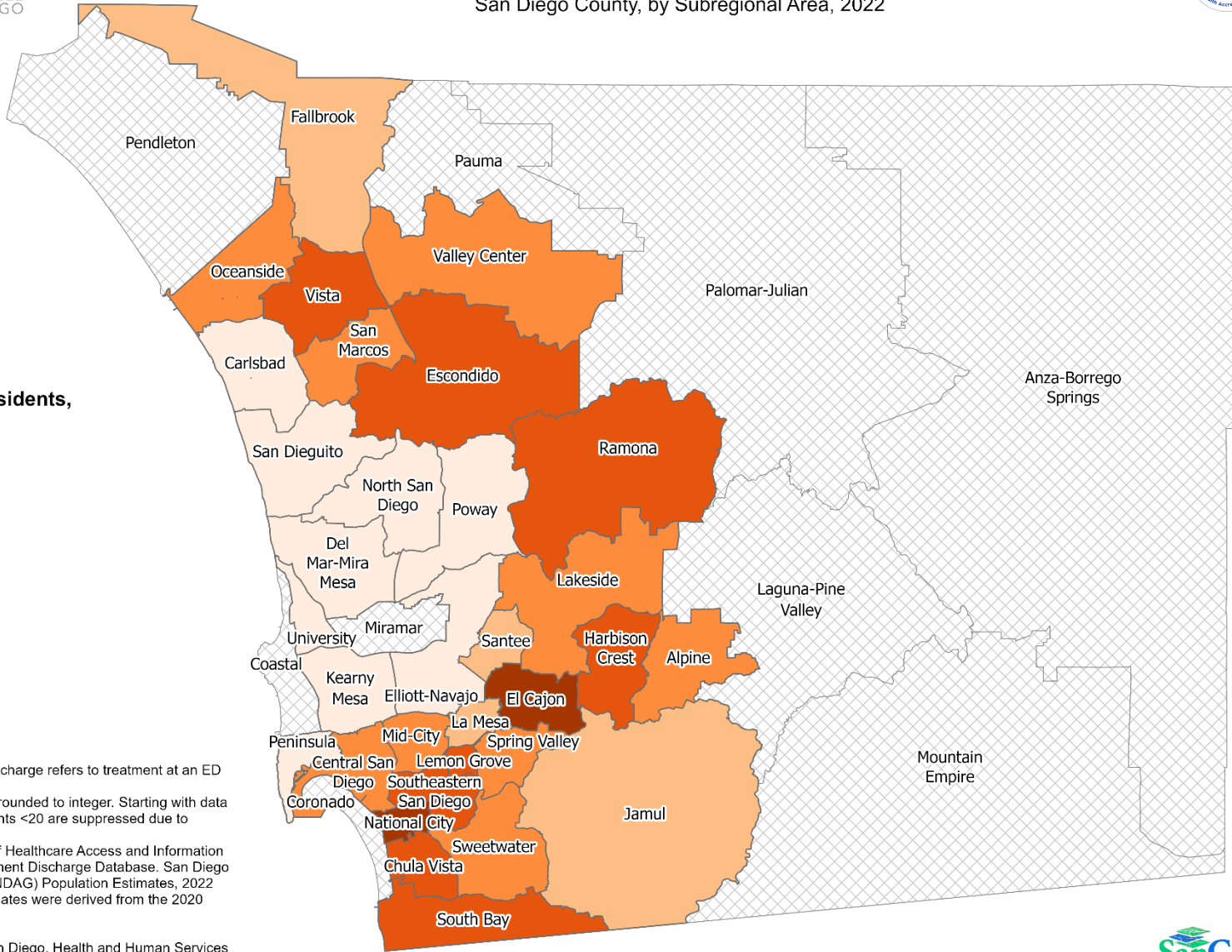
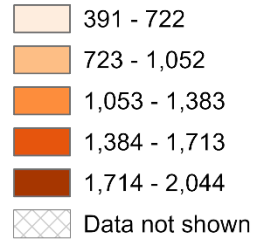


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 0-9* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



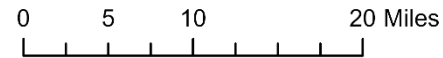

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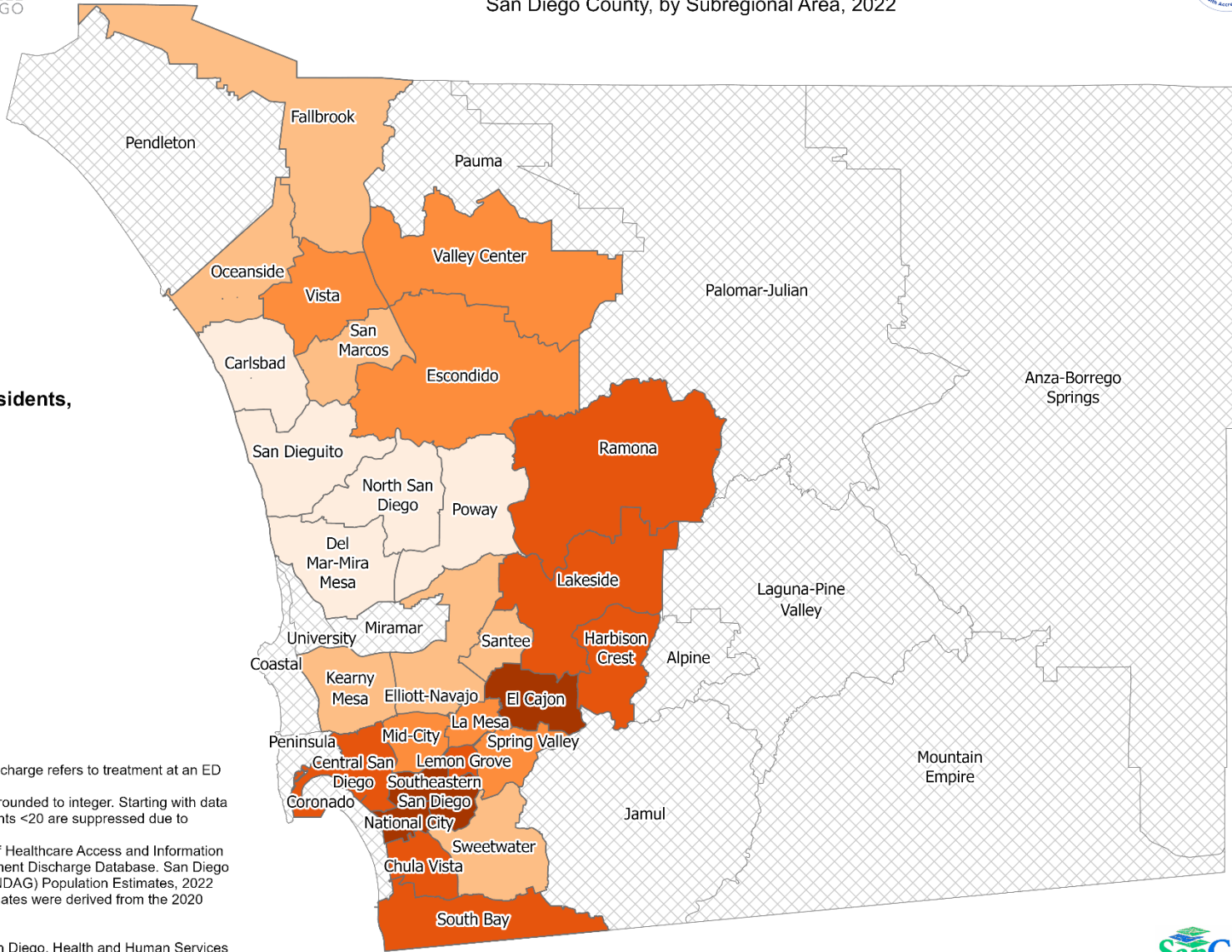
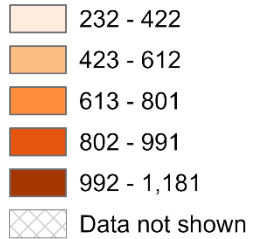


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 10-19* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



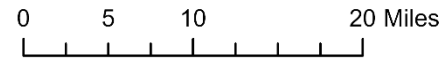

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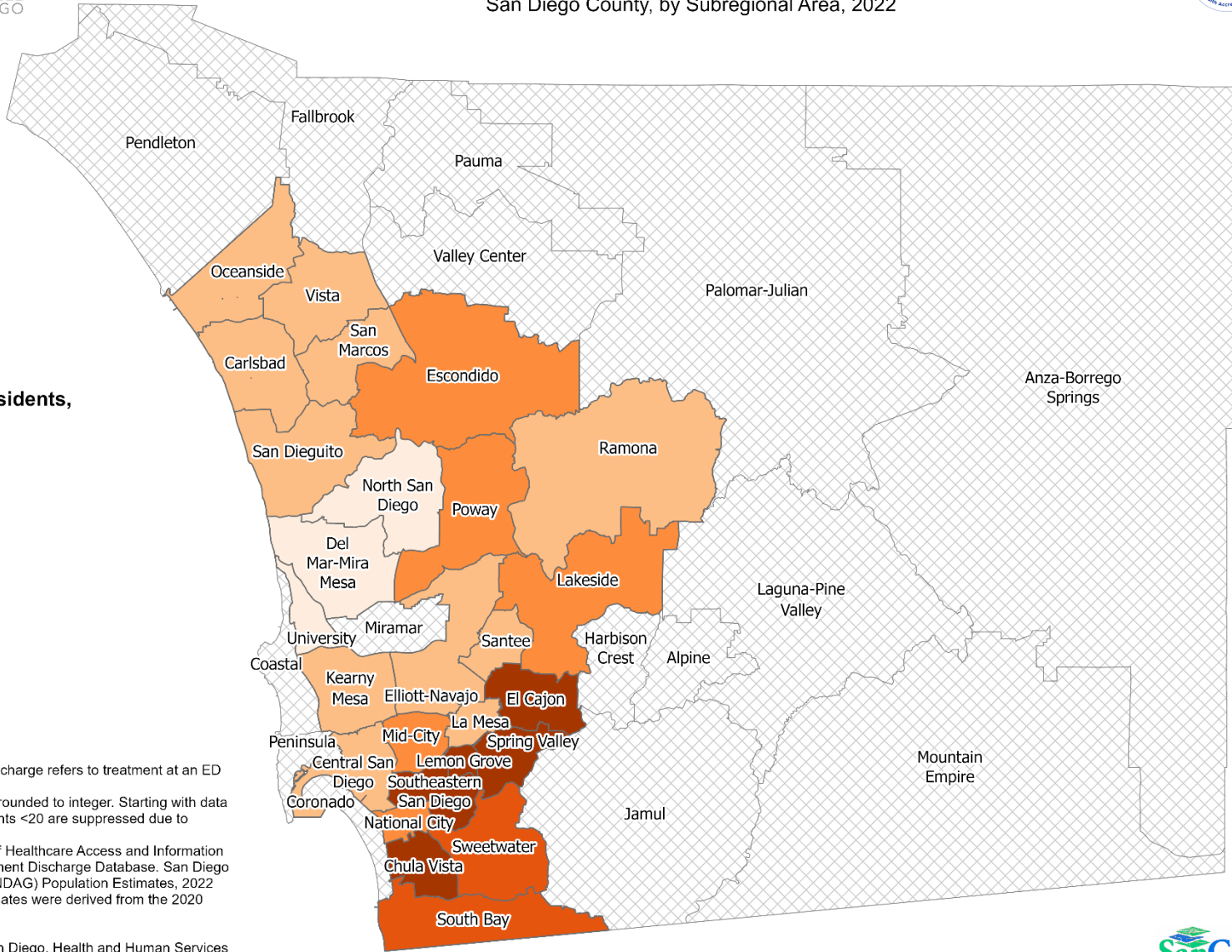
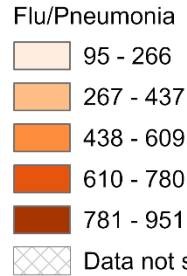




Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 20-29* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022

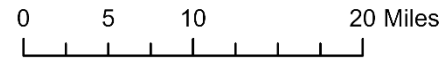

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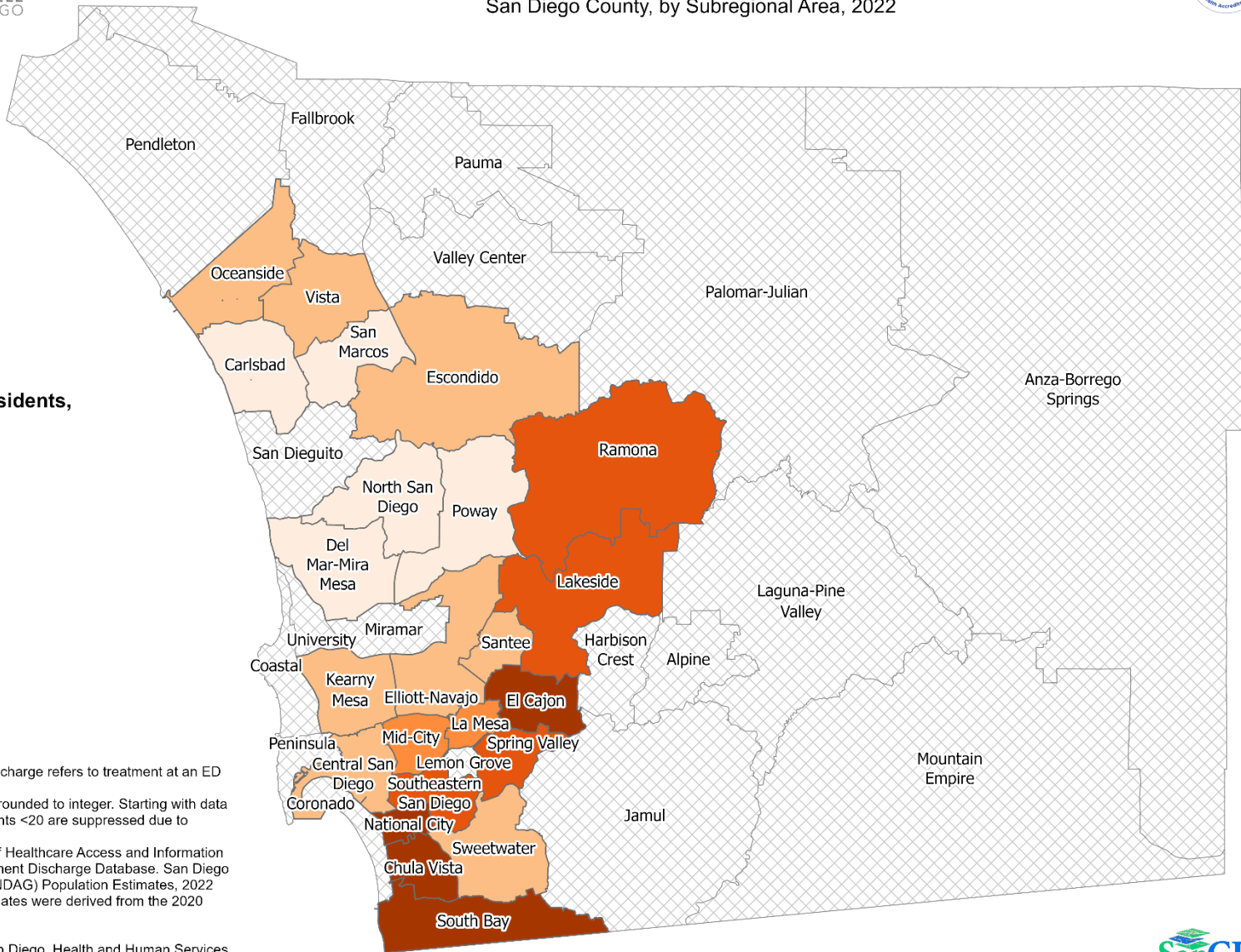


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 30-39* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



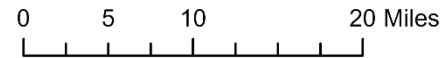

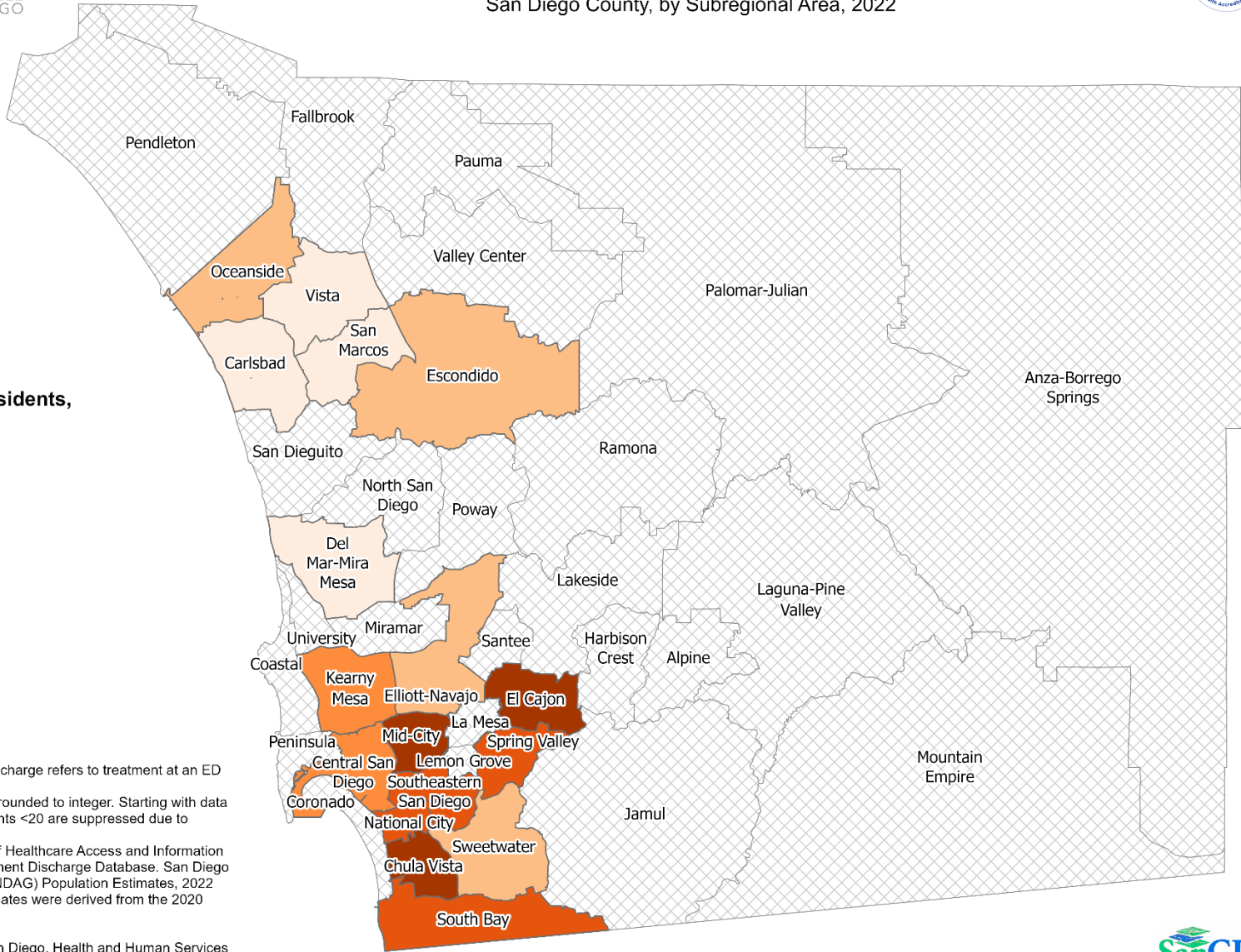


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 40-49* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



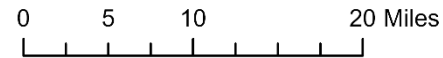

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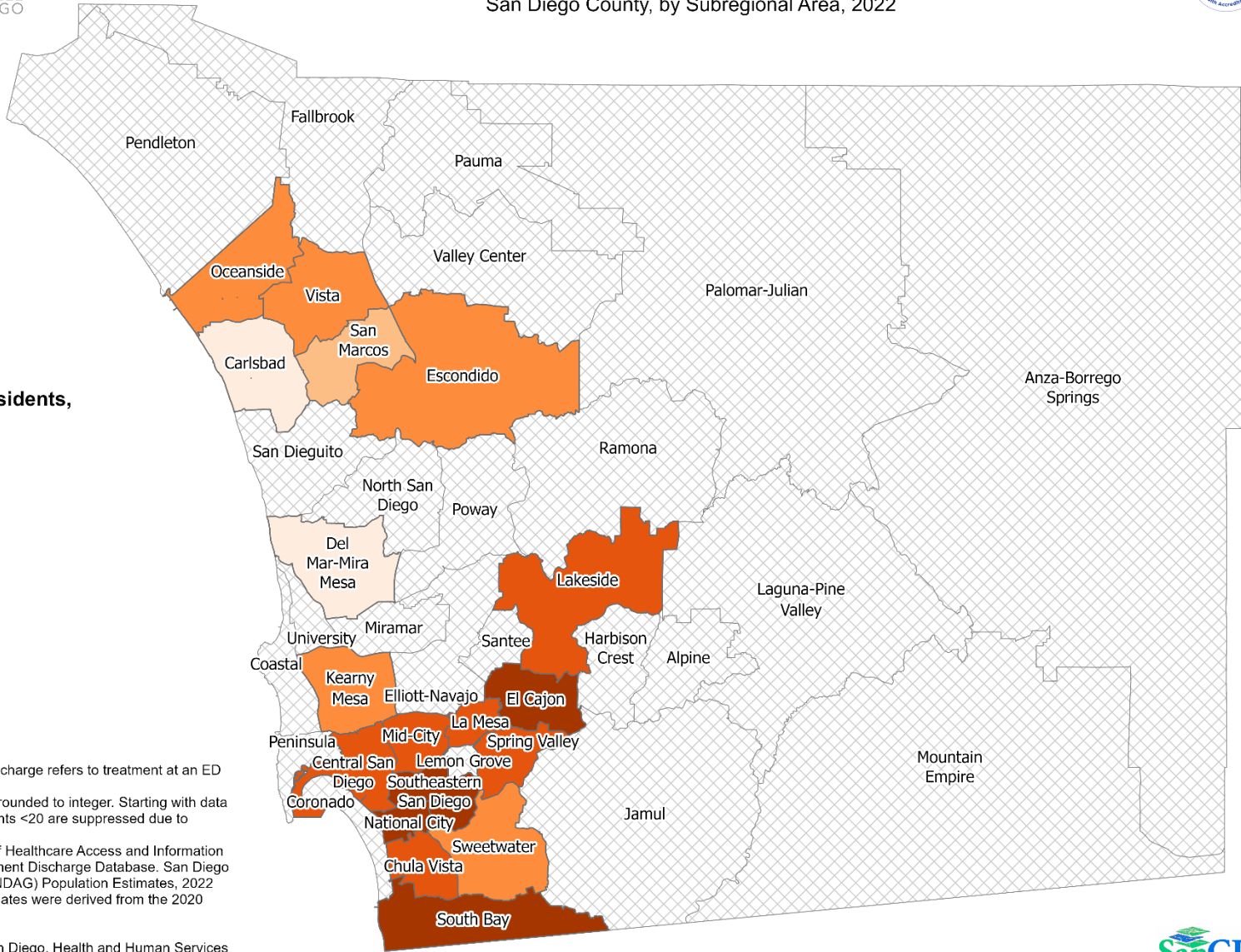
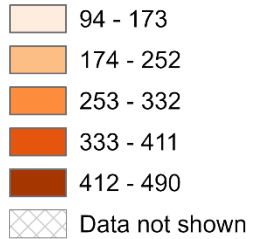


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 50-59* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



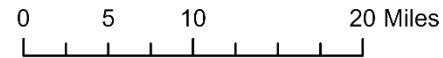

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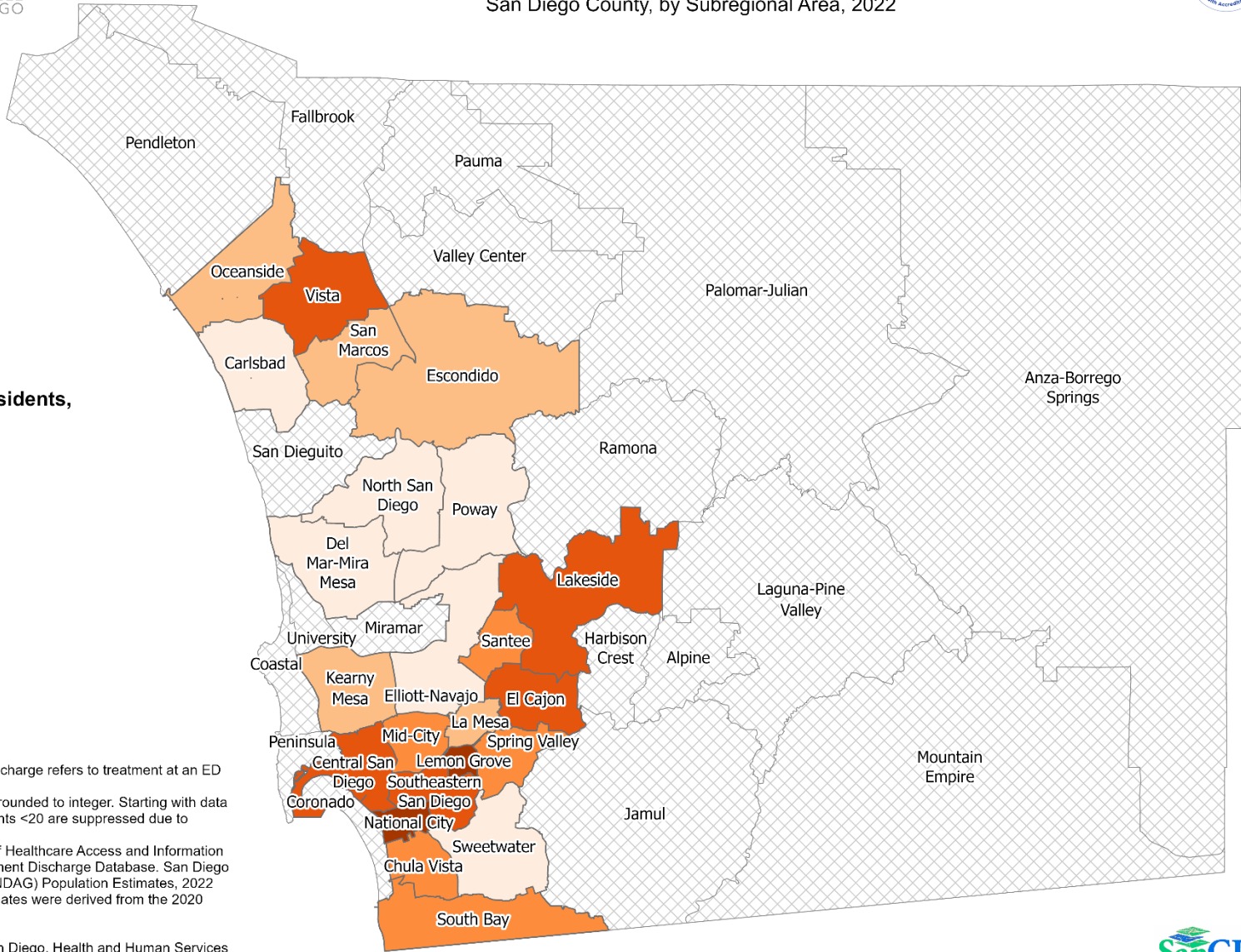
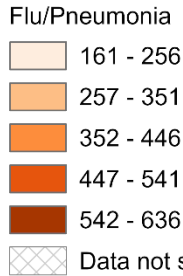




Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 60-69* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022

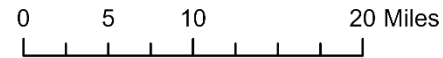

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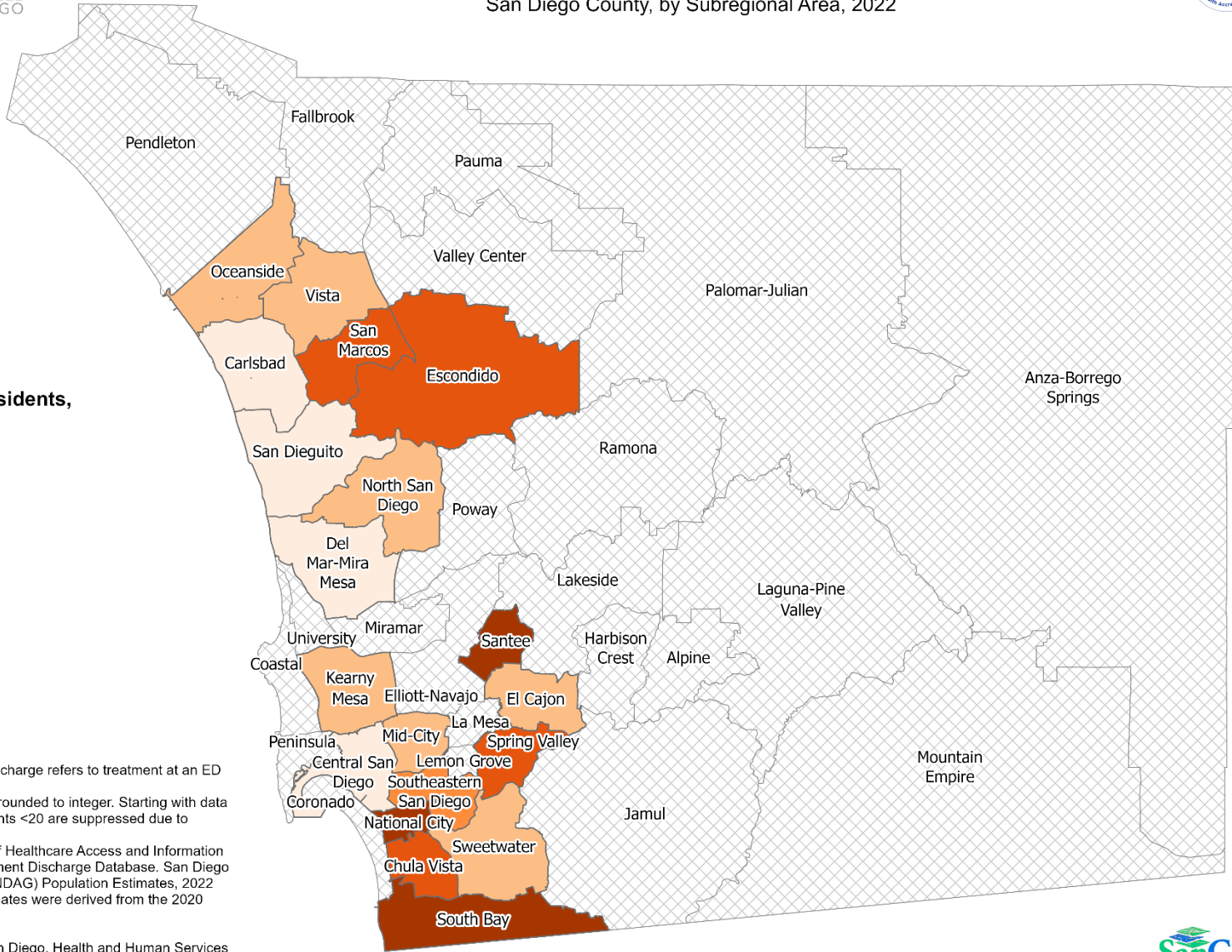
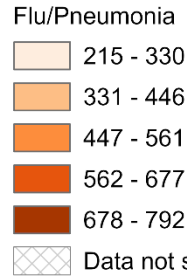




Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 70-79* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022

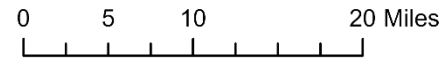

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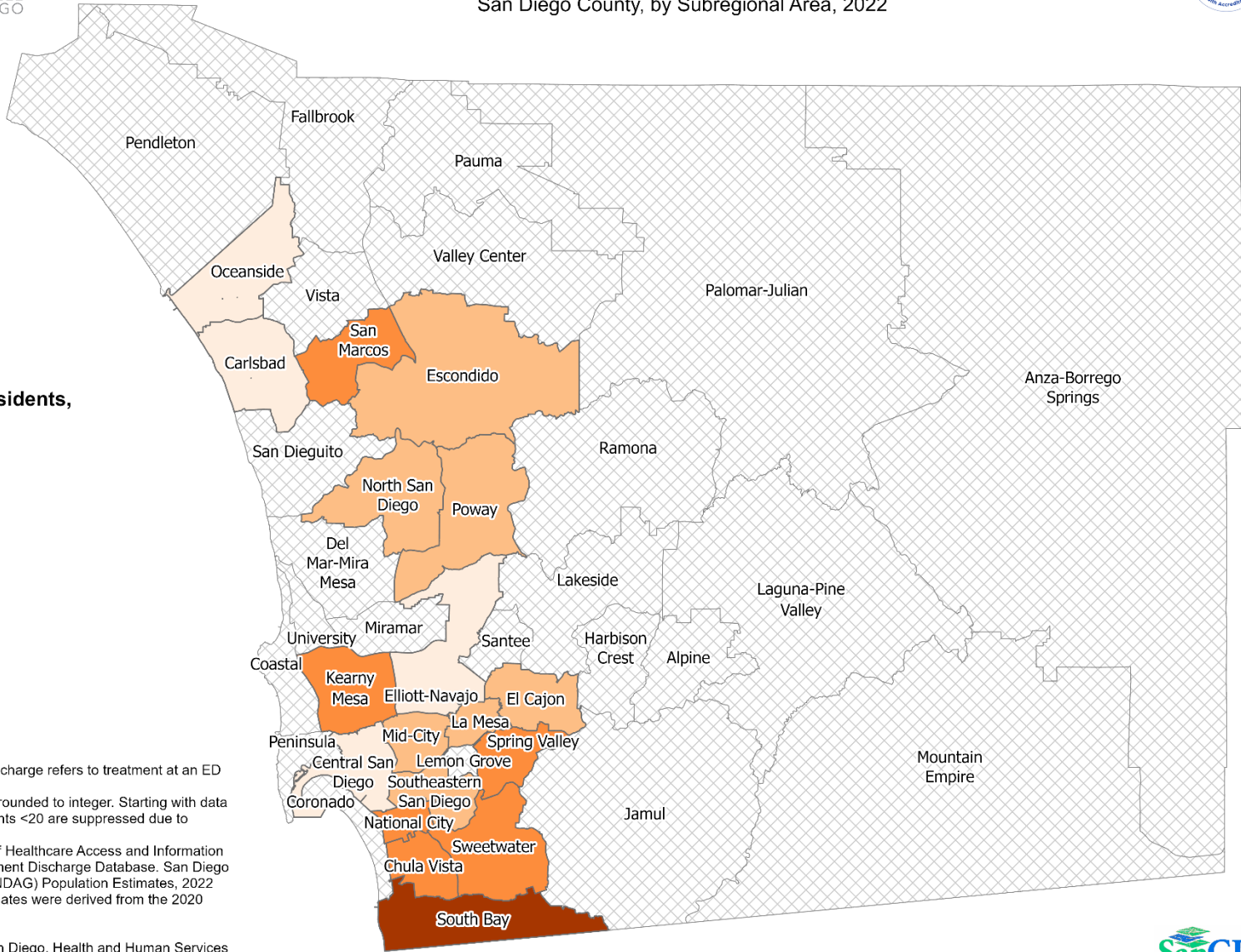
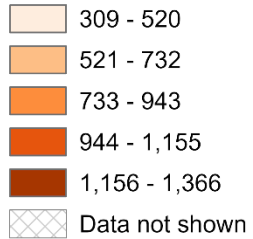


Emergency Department Discharge Rates Among Residents, Ages 80+* San Diego County, by Subregional Area, 2022



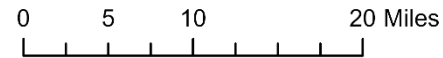
