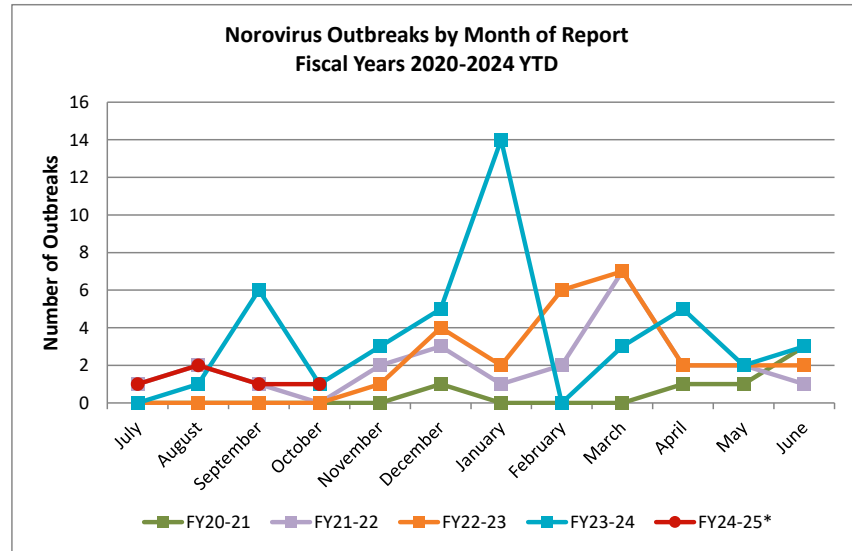
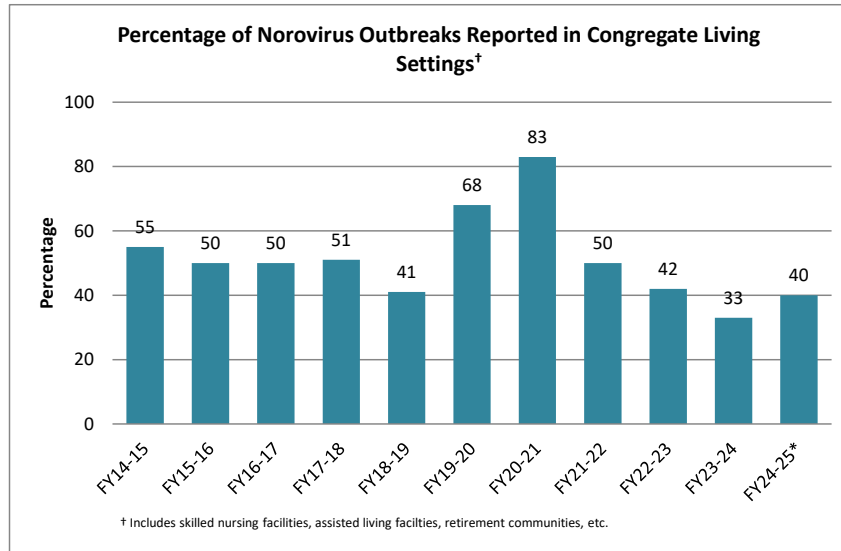
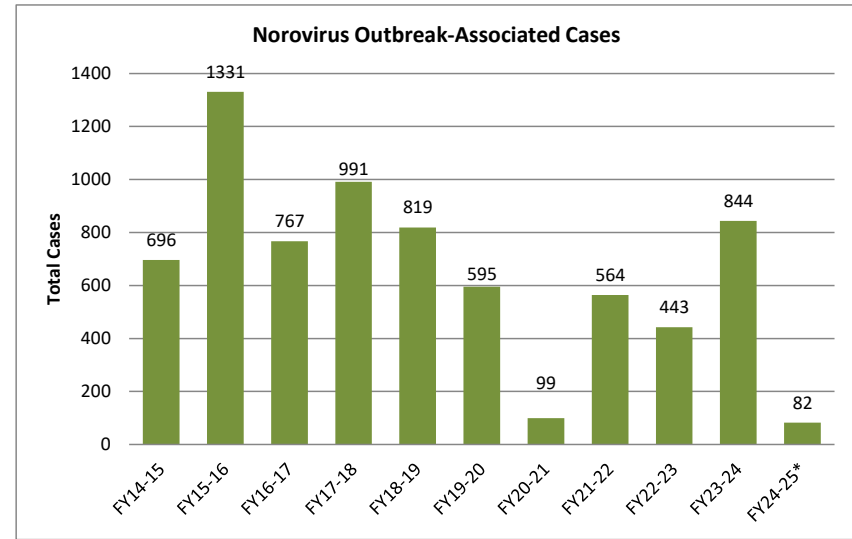
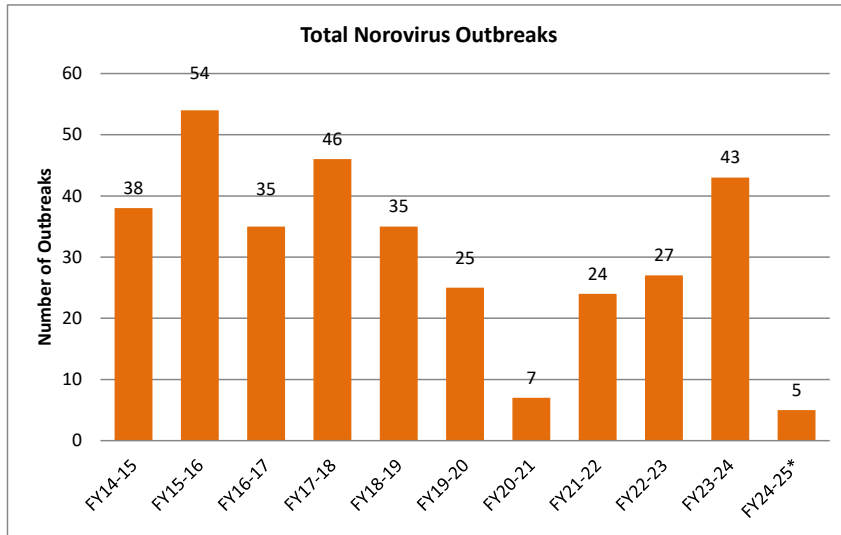


Norovirus Outbreaks Reported to the Epidemiology Unit, County of San Diego, Fiscal Years 2014-2024

Notes:

Outbreaks are grouped by year based on the date they were registered.

Includes outbreaks with confirmed, probable, and suspect etiology of norovirus. A confirmed norovirus outbreak requires that at least two cases are laboratory-confirmed; a probable norovirus outbreak requires one laboratory confirmed case; in a suspect norovirus outbreak, at least 50% of cases report vomiting, average incubation is 24-48 hours, and average duration of illness is 12-60 hours.

FY 2024-25 data are not final and may not include recently reported outbreaks that, although likely caused by norovirus, have not yet been classified as such.
