## **ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER**

(Locally Reportable Diseases and Conditions for Providers and Laboratories)

Public Health Services department, of the County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency, is updating the existing list of locally reportable diseases to include Chagas disease. More information regarding Chagas is available from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention found here: <u>https://www.cdc.gov/parasites/chagas/index.html</u>.

California Code of Regulations, Title 17, Sections 2500 and 2505 requires the reporting of designated diseases and conditions by health care providers<sup>1</sup> and laboratories.<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to these sections of the California Code of Regulations and California Health and Safety Code section 120175, the Health Officer **ORDERS** the additional reporting of the following diseases and conditions in San Diego County:

Disease or Condition	Reporting Date
Chagas Disease (Trypanosoma cruzi infection)	Within 7 business days
Bartonella quintana	Within 7 business days
Clostridium sordellii	Within 7 business days
Necrotizing fasciitis	Within 7 business days
Vaping-associated pulmonary injury (VAPI), also known as e-	Within 7 business days
cigarette, or vaping, product use associated lung injury (EVALI)

This Health Officer Order shall remain in effect unless amended or rescinded by the Health Officer.
