



County of San Diego Sexual Health Clinics

Sexual Health Clinics provide **confidential** testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs). *There is a \$40 fee that covers the cost of all services provided and includes any follow-up visits within 30 days of your exam. The fee may be waived if you are unable to pay.*

Services Provided:

- STI testing—Confidential **HIV testing is available** with each STI exam.
- STI treatment
- Vaccinations
- Hepatitis testing and vaccinations are available and given according to national guidelines.

Naloxone (Narcan) is available for FREE at all County clinics to respond to an opioid overdose—Just ask!

Clinic Locations and Hours*

Walk-In Clinics: All County Sexual Health Clinics are walk-in clinics only and do not schedule appointments in advance. Each clinic registers as many people as the clinic can accommodate and stops accepting patients when capacity is reached.

Please walk in and register for your visit as early in the day as possible.
