 Cervical cancer is the #1 type of HPV-related cancer in females under 20 years old.

 The most common HPV-related cancer in males is throat cancer.

 HPV can cause cancers and genital warts in both boys and girls.

 HPV is so contagious that without the Gardasil 9 vaccine, nearly 100% of people would contract the virus.

 Vaccination against HPV could prevent more than 90% of cancers caused by HPV from ever developing.

 A person who has HPV may not know they have the virus and can pass it to others even if they are not showing symptoms.

 Most people who have it are not aware of their status. In some cases, there are no symptoms.
