Authorization:

Medi-Cal 2020 waiver

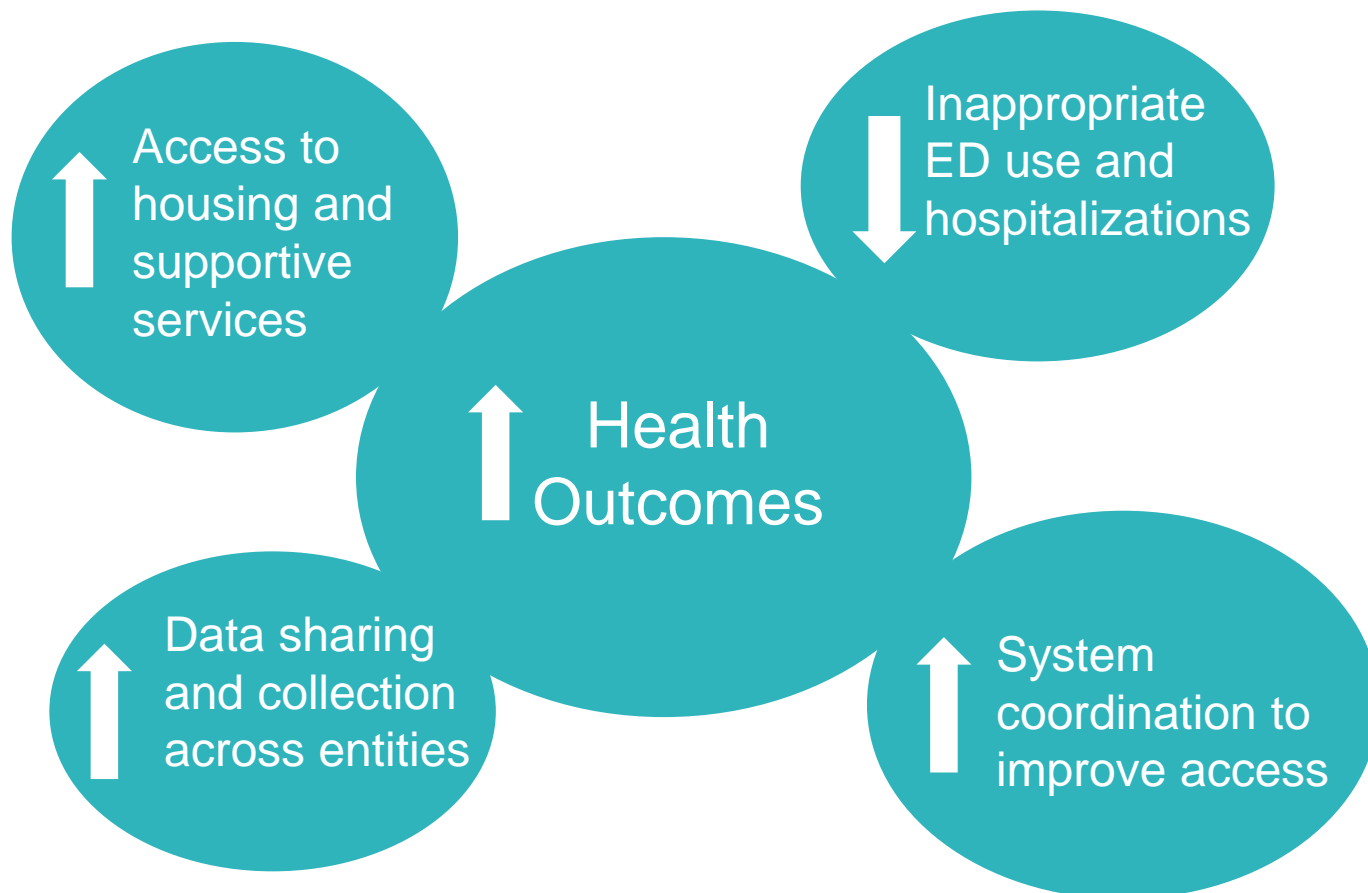
Funding:

Federal matching funds for counties to implement innovative projects for “high utilizers”

Primary Goal:

Test locally based initiatives that coordinate physical health, behavioral health, and social services across multiple entities for people that are high users of multiple systems and have poor outcomes

FUNDING

- Up to \$90m/year available **BUT**.....
 - Requires 1:1 local match of non-Medi-Cal funds
 - Local match must directly tie to interventions proposed
 - Cannot support services funded by Medi-Cal
 - Must be used for Medi-Cal beneficiaries
 - San Diego planning for approximately \$4-\$8m program
 - Reimbursement tied to achievement of deliverables





TARGET POPULATION

People who are **high utilizers** of health services AND are experiencing **homelessness, or are at-risk of homelessness** AND have one or more of the following:

Seriously
Mentally Ill

Substance
Use Disorder

Chronic Health
Condition



SERVICES

- Proactive, Assertive Outreach and Engagement
- System Navigation/Care Coordination
 - Social workers paired with peer support specialists
- Tenancy Supports
 - Becoming “housing ready”
 - Education on being a good tenant, etc.
- Technology
 - Using ConnectWellSD to help deliver services
 - Using Community Information Exchange to help identify systems the participant is engaged with
 - Using SD Health Connect to help flag for ED admissions, etc.



NEXT STEPS

July 1, 2016:	Proposals Due
October, 2016:	Funding Notification
January, 2017:	Project Implementation
December, 2020:	Funding Ends



REQUESTED ACTIONS

1. Authorize submission of a proposal to Department of Health Care Services in response to the Whole Person Care Pilot Funding Opportunity
2. If awarded, authorize the Director of the Health and Human Services Agency to negotiate a final agreement and accept funding
