SMAA REVENUE AGREEMENT

We are requesting HSAB to approve the School-Based Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (SMAA) Revenue Agreement in the amount of \$20 million from the State of California, Department of Health Care Services for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020.





SMAA REVENUE FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS IS ESTIMATED AT UP TO \$20 MILLION FOR THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT

- \$5 million for Fiscal Year 2017-18
- > \$7 million for Fiscal Year 2018-19
- \$8 million for Fiscal Year 2019-20



Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) is designed to assist Local Government Agencies (LGAs) and community providers in recouping costs expended to enroll clients in Medi-Cal and to ensure those persons can access Medi-Cal funded services.




SMAA is for School Districts.



- The SMAA program reimburses school districts for the Federal share of certain costs for administering the Medi-Cal program.
- School districts are reimbursed 93% of the revenue recovered.
- The County maintains 7% as an administrative fee

CHALLENGES

SMAA participation by school districts has decreased which has decreased the annual revenue.



MITIGATIONS

On-going efforts to create and implement active campaigns to recruit the participation of additional school districts by leveraging the financial benefits of the SMAA program.
