## CONSOLIDATED APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2023



#### WHAT IS IT?

- The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023, is a \$1.7 trillion omnibus spending bill funding the U.S. Federal Government for the 2023 FY
- The bill was passed by Congress and signed into law by President Biden on December 29, 2022
- The bill contained provisions that cut funding for Pandemic provisions that have provided enhanced benefits and services to both the Medicaid and SNAP programs during the COVID-19 Pandemic
- Eliminating these provisions will directly impact all Medi-Cal and CalFresh recipients in California

# CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY COVERAGE (CEC)



#### WHAT IS CEC?

- CEC requirements preserved Medi-Cal coverage for beneficiaries
  throughout the Pandemic by maintaining coverage, regardless of eligibility
- Currently, over 1 million residents in San Diego County receive Medi-Cal
- The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 de-links the CEC requirement from the Federal Public Health Emergency, which ended on May 11, 2023
- CEC requirements ended on March 31, 2023
- Unwinding of CEC requirement began on April 1, 2023

## MEDI-CAL ANNUAL REDETERMINATIONS



#### RESUMPTION OF ANNUAL REDETERMINATIONS

- Counties began processing Medi-Cal Annual Redeterminations in April, for the benefit month of June
- Not all beneficiaries will be required to complete a packet
- Medi-Cal packets will be mailed in yellow envelopes through June 2024
- Redeterminations will be processed with an effective date of July 1, 2023
  until all renewals are completed over the next year
- Changes in eligibility, including "adverse" changes (share of cost, reduction of benefits, etc.) and discontinuances began on July 1, 2023

- DHCS has launched a marketing campaign to spread the word about Medi-Cal Annual Redeterminations through June 2024
- DHCS has launched the <u>www.KeepMediCalCoverage.org</u> website with resources for beneficiaries
- New Access Customer Service Center IVR option added for Medi-Cal Annual Redeterminations
- San Diego County is also be conducting outreach to inform beneficiaries to update their address and contact information with the County and also inform them of their upcoming Annual Redetermination when due
