### PERINATAL EQUITY INITIATIVE BACKGROUND




- 2018 The County of San Diego received Perinatal Equity Initiative funding





# PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGN OUTCOMES OCTOBER 2019 THROUGH DECEMBER 2021



### Black Legacy Now Public Awareness Campaign

- Launched Black Legacy Now campaign September 14, 2020
- Developed Black Legacy Now website and social media platforms
- Held press conference for the campaign on January 28, 2021
- Created social media digital advertisements, posts, and responses
- Gained over 13 million views on Black Legacy Now social media posts and ads from September 2020 -May 2021

# IMPLICIT BIAS TRAINING OUTCOMES JANUARY 2021 THROUGH DECEMBER 2022



### **Implicit Bias Training**

- Established physician subcommittee to inform training curriculum
- 114 healthcare providers and medical staff completed an asynchronous training
- 144 healthcare providers and medical staff completed a facilitated training
- 100% of those completing the facilitated training indicated they had made changes to their practice as a result of the training





# FATHERHOOD PILOT INTERVENTION OUTCOMES AUGUST 2020 THROUGH JULY 2021



#### **Fatherhood Pilot Intervention**

 Trained and certified to implement the 24/7® Dad evidenced-based fatherhood curricula.



Hanify and Zion, Chollas View

- Established a bi-directional referral system with the Black Infant Health Program.
- Formed a fatherhood collaborative with local fathering/parenting community agencies to share and leverage resources.
- Supported 15 fathers during Pilot Fatherhood Intervention from October 2020 July 2021.

# COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD OUTCOMES MARCH 2019 - PRESENT



### **Community Advisory Board**

- Determined intervention strategies
- Provided direction in the development of the Black Legacy Now media campaign
- Established subcommittees to guide and inform PEI program services
- Maintained 167 CAB members; with 80 active key stakeholders

Implemented PEI interventions during COVID-19 pandemic

Reduced and limited staff due to supporting COVID – 19 response activities
