#### **BACKGROUND**





Racial and Ethnic Approaches to Community Health (REACH) (CDC-RFA-DPA-23-0014)

- **Funding goal:** To improve health, prevent chronic diseases, and reduce health disparities among racial and ethnic populations with the highest risk of chronic disease.
- Population: African-American/Black and Hispanic/Latino populations within the County's Central and South Regions.
- Funding period: September 30, 2023 through September 29, 2028 (5-year cycle)
- Funding source: Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, National Center for Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion.
- Award Amount: \$7.5 million
