• On March 1, 2016, the Board of Supervisors adopted the local Getting to Zero initiative, a comprehensive and ambitious plan to end the HIV epidemic by 2026.

Ending the HIV Epidemic:


 Federal initiative started in 2020 with the goal of reducing new HIV infections in the U.S. by 90% by 2030.

Recommendations





- 1. Waive Board Policy B-29, Fees, Grants, Revenue Contracts Department Responsibility for Cost Recovery, which requires prior approval of revenue agreement applications and full-cost recovery of grants.
- 2. Authorize the acceptance of \$1,250,000 in *A Status Neutral Approach to Improve HIV Prevention and Health Outcomes for Racial and Ethnic Minorities Implementation Sites* grant funds from the Health Resources and Services Administration for the period of September 1, 2023 to August 31, 2026

Recommendations





- 3. Authorize the acceptance of \$600,000 in *Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis and Post-Exposure Prophylaxis Initiation and Retention Initiative* grant funds from the California Department of Public Health for the period of July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2027
- 4. Authorize the acceptance of a no-cost agreement from the California Department of Public Health for the period of January 1, 2024 through May 31, 2024, for an anticipated amount of up to \$1 million
- 5. Authorize the Director, Department of Purchasing and Contracting, to amend contracts 556170, 556172, 563284, 556175, 556154, 556172, 556212, and 556211 to extend the contract term for fourteen months through Feb. 28, 2025.

Recommendations





- 6. Issue Competitive Solicitations for Outpatient Ambulatory Health Services, Oral Health and Psychiatric Services
- 7. Authorize the Interim Agency Director, Health and Human Services Agency to apply for any additional funding opportunity announcements, if available, to address the prevention, testing, care and treatment needs of those impacted by HIV.
