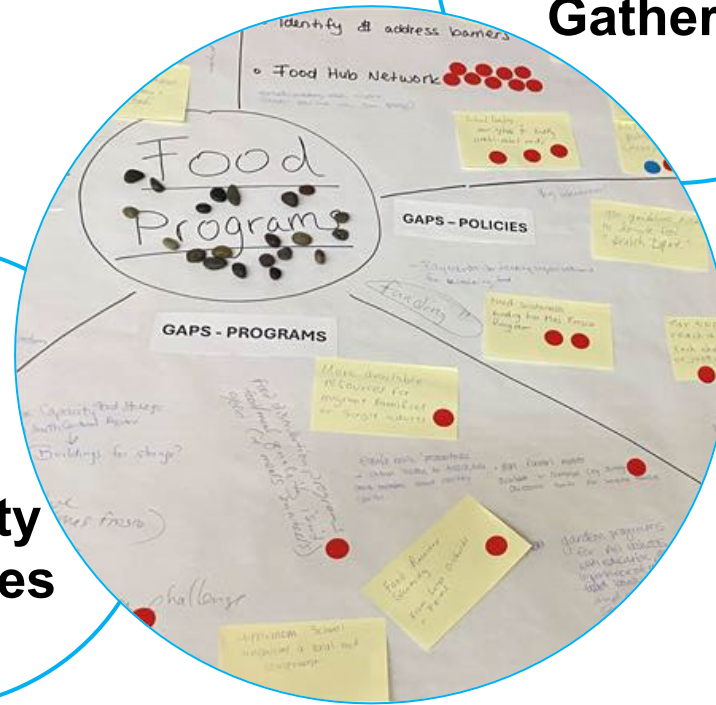
- **Convene a regional summit** of stakeholders, service providers, community leaders, local farmers, and other governmental agencies.
