## **Key Points:**


- Flexible shifts are available
- Volunteers will be offered the opportunity to be vaccinated
- Volunteers are requested to commit to a minimum of two shifts per month
- Training and supervision will be provided
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be provided
- Registration and coverage through the CA Disaster Service Worker Volunteer Program
  - Provides worker's compensation coverage and limited immunity from liability when you are officially deployed
- Vaccinations occur in a variety of locations and may have limited accommodations
- UPDATE: FEMA IS-100 and IS-700 are no longer required for vaccinators at this time


- 1. Register with the **CA Disaster Healthcare Volunteer (DHV) system** at https://www.healthcarevolunteers.ca.gov/.
