





Health Advisory: Second Measles Case in San Diego County for 2024

Key Messages

- An adult with an unclear vaccination status who has returned from overseas travel has developed laboratory confirmed measles not linked to the 1st case in 2024.
- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recently issued a <u>Health Advisory</u> to inform clinicians of an increase in global and U.S. measles cases.
- Measles should be considered when individuals present with an acute febrile illness and maculopapular rash.
- All patients with fever and rash should be screened at the point of entry to a healthcare facility. Providers
 should immediately institute airborne precautions on patients suspected of measles to prevent healthcare
 associated exposures.
- Providers should immediately report any suspect measles case to the County Immunization Program. Do not wait for laboratory confirmation.





Health Advisory Update #2: Candida auris in San Diego County

Key Messages

- Candida auris (C. auris) has been identified in San Diego County (SDC), since March 2020, with increasing reports since September 2021.
- California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has updated the <u>guidance for surveillance and screening</u> among high-risk populations.
- The County of San Diego reminds that rigorous adherence to infection control measures, including the routine use of Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registered disinfectant effective against *C. auris* are critical for mitigation.
- Confirmed or suspected C. auris cases, identified in SDC, should be reported to Epidemiology Unit during business hours, Monday to Friday 8AM-5PM, within one working day of identification. Also, isolates should be saved for potential confirmatory testing and/or further characterization.




Respiratory Virus Update


Apply to Receive Portable Air Cleaners!

- Deadline to apply is 5/3/24






