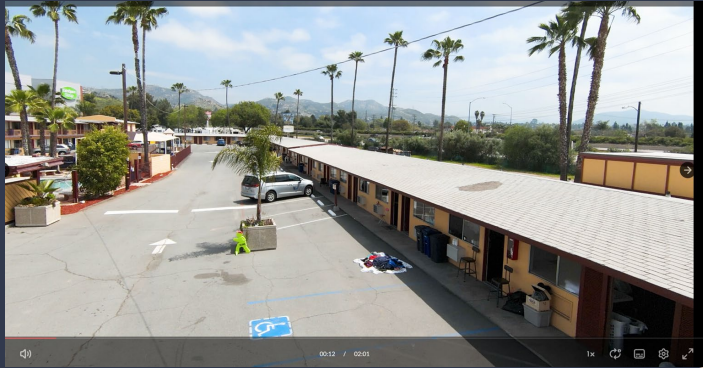

- Case Management 1 x a week
- Resource Center (computer / resources)
- Individual room for family
- Dorm style for singles
- 3 opportunities for meals a day
- Hygiene/clothes
- Bus Pass
