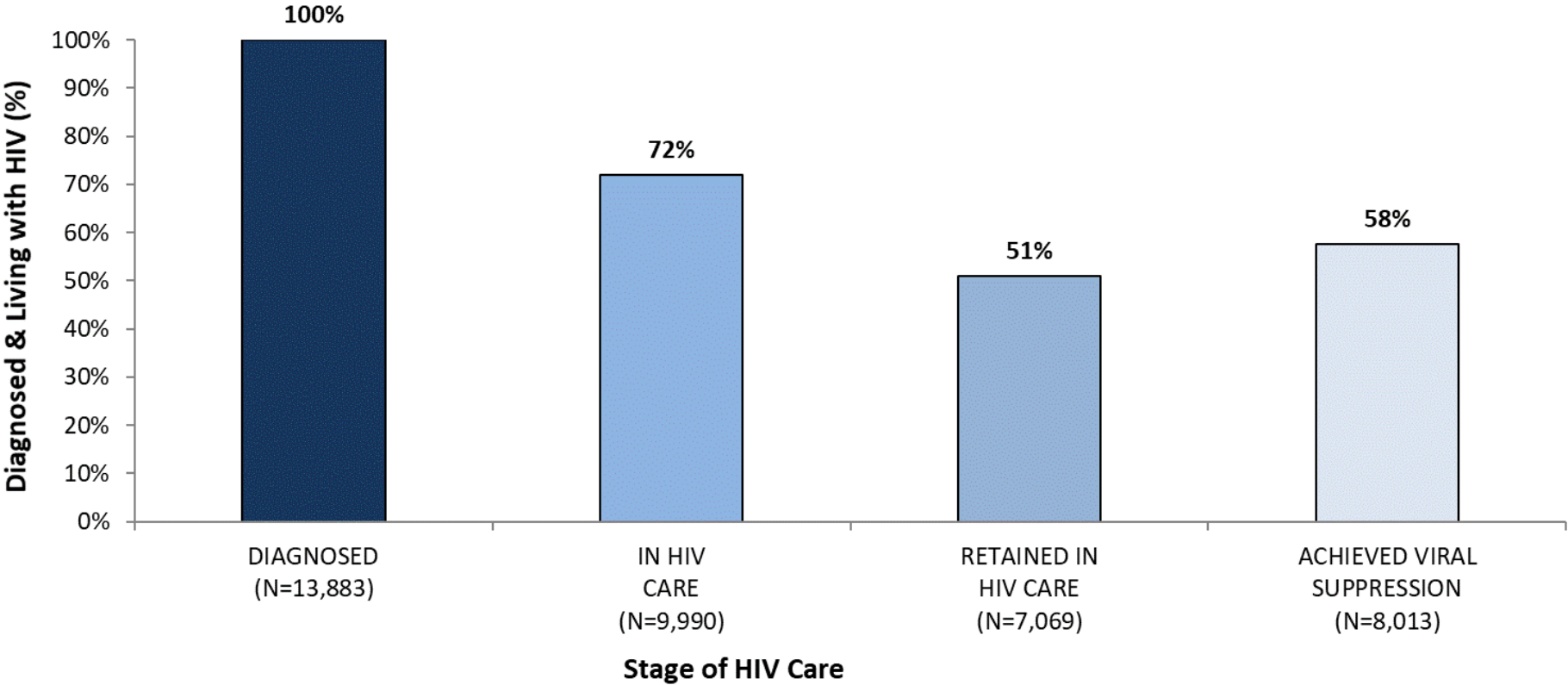

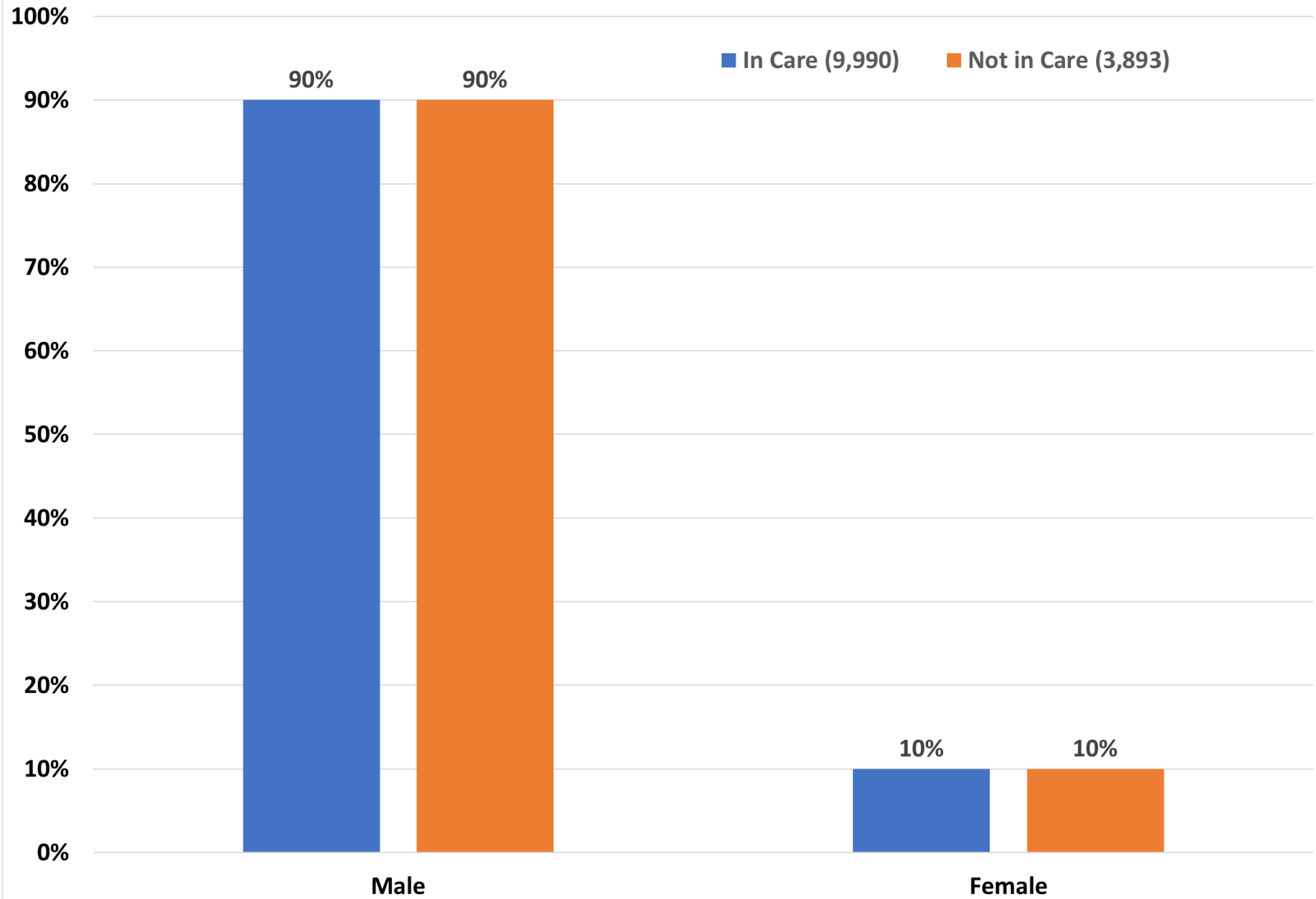


- Data from 2019

- In care
 - ≥ 1 care visit in 2019
- Number available for analysis=13,883

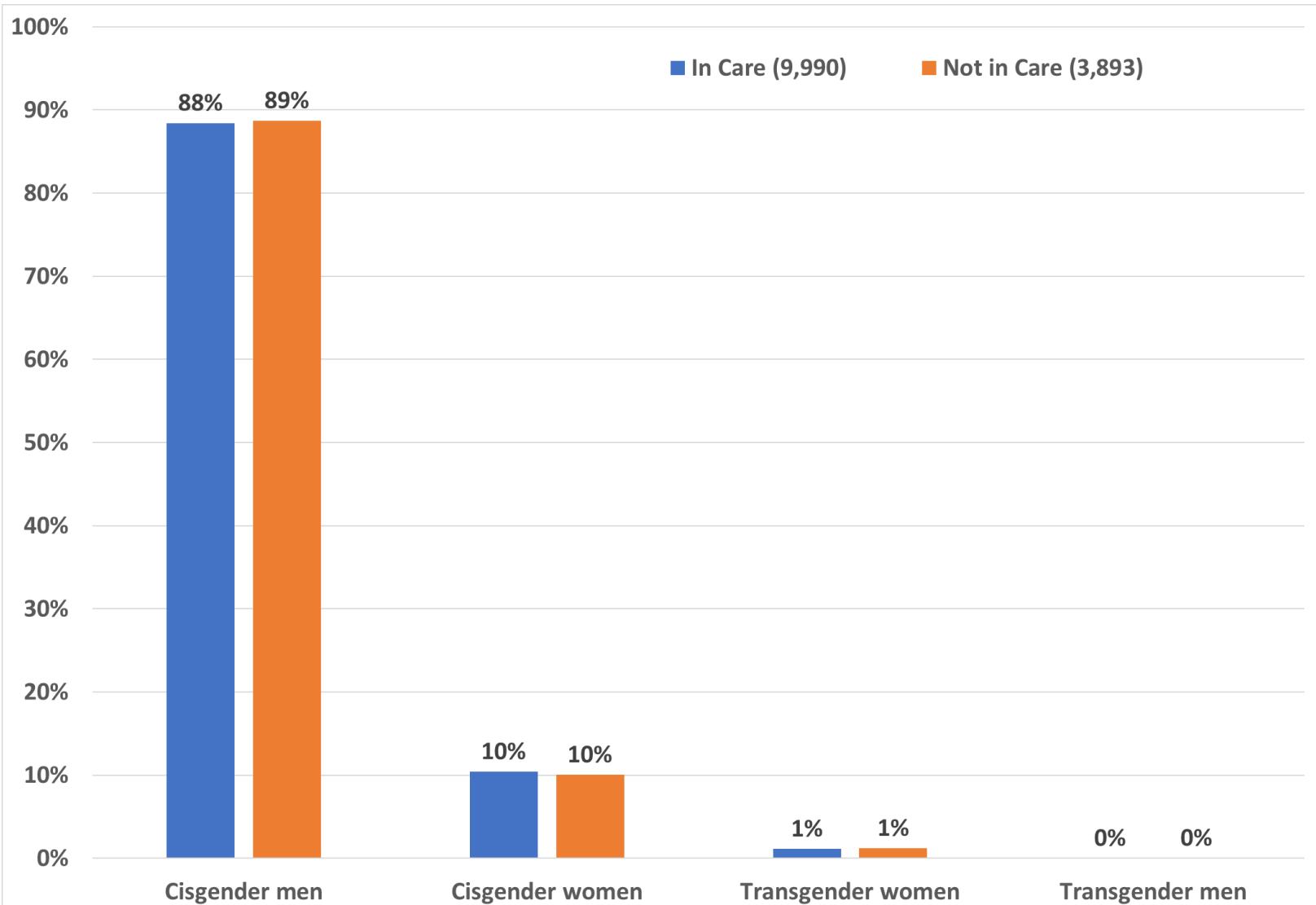
ALL PREVALENT CASES



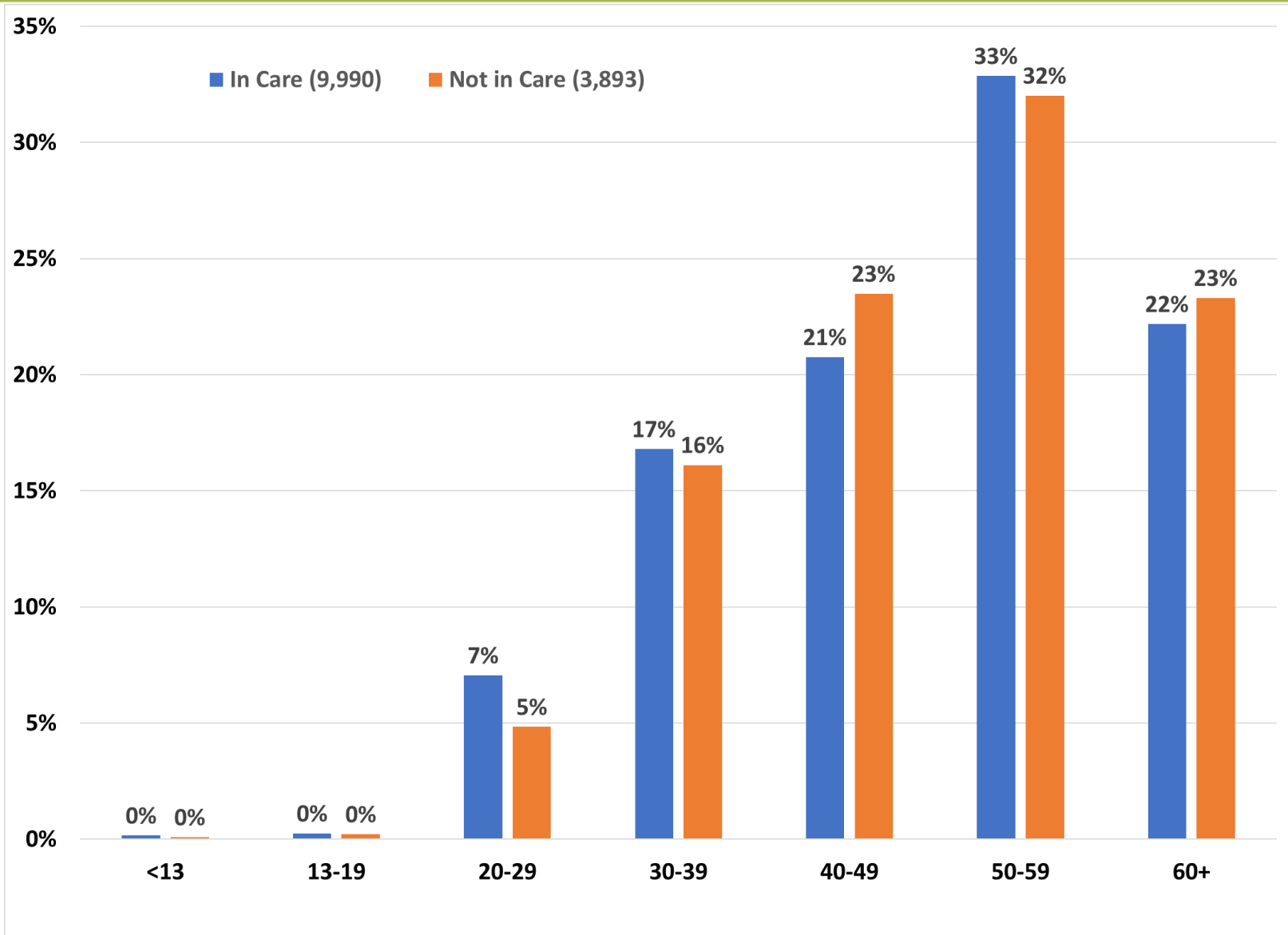
SEX AT BIRTH



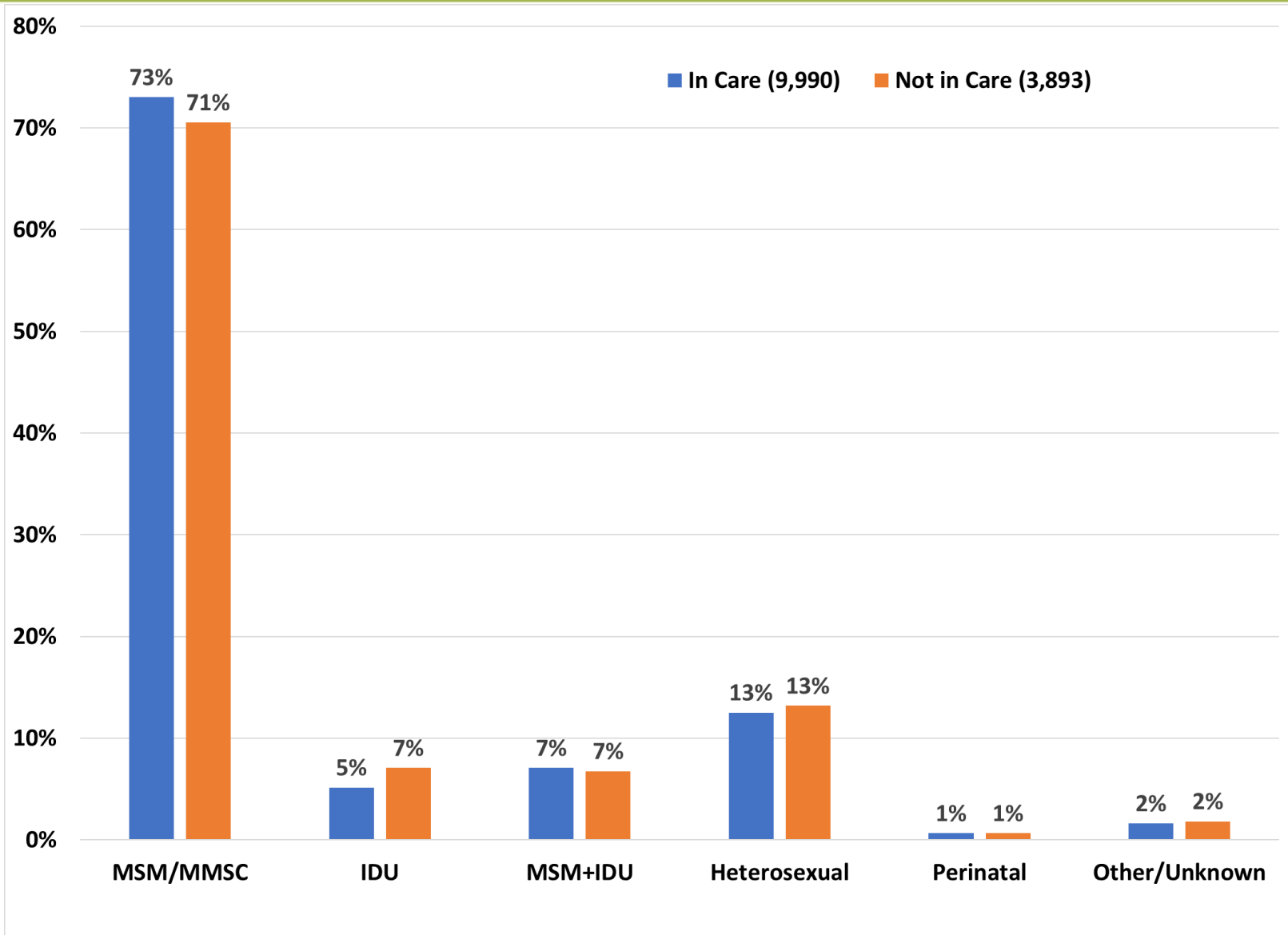
GENDER



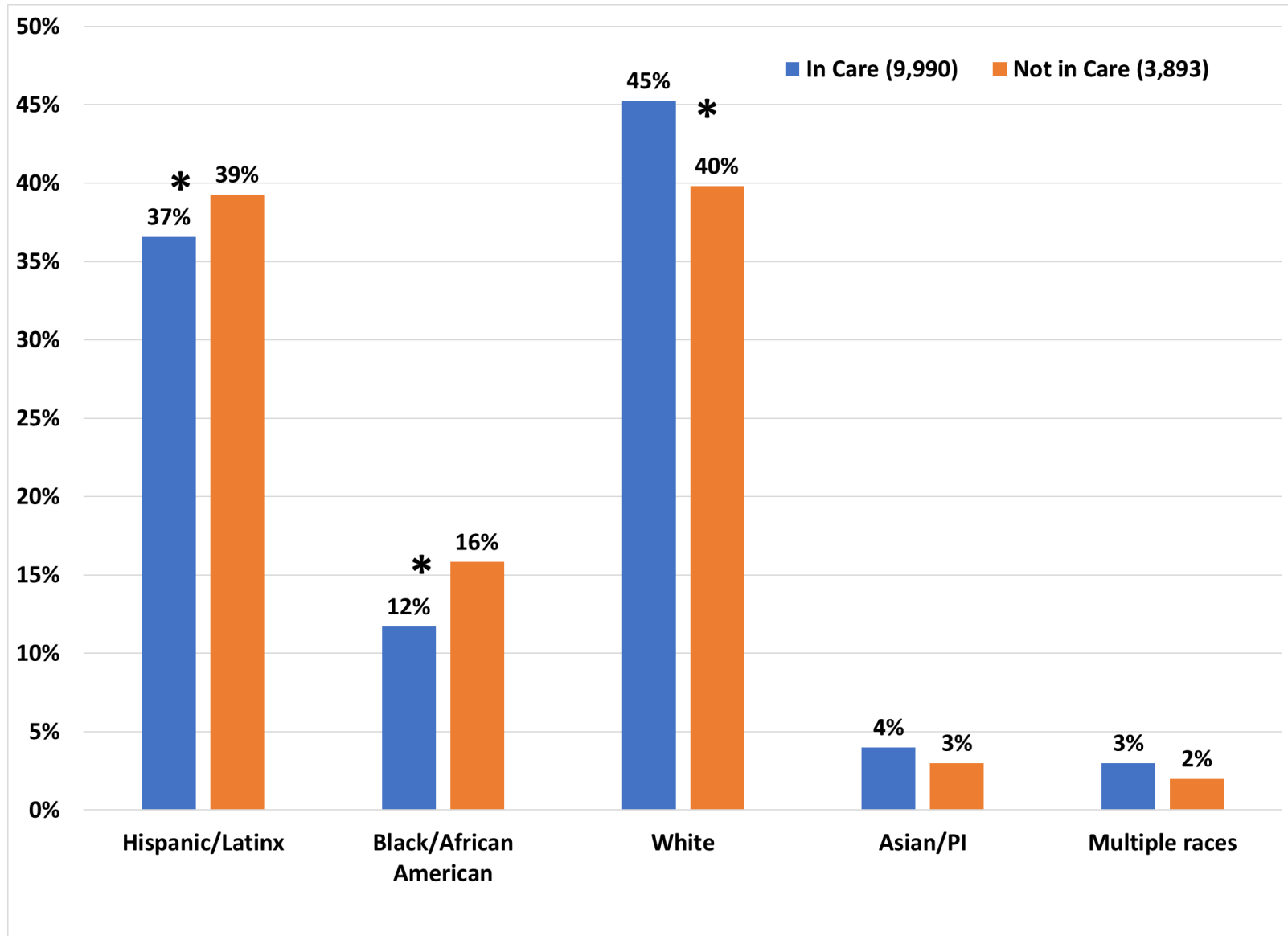
AGE GROUP IN 2019



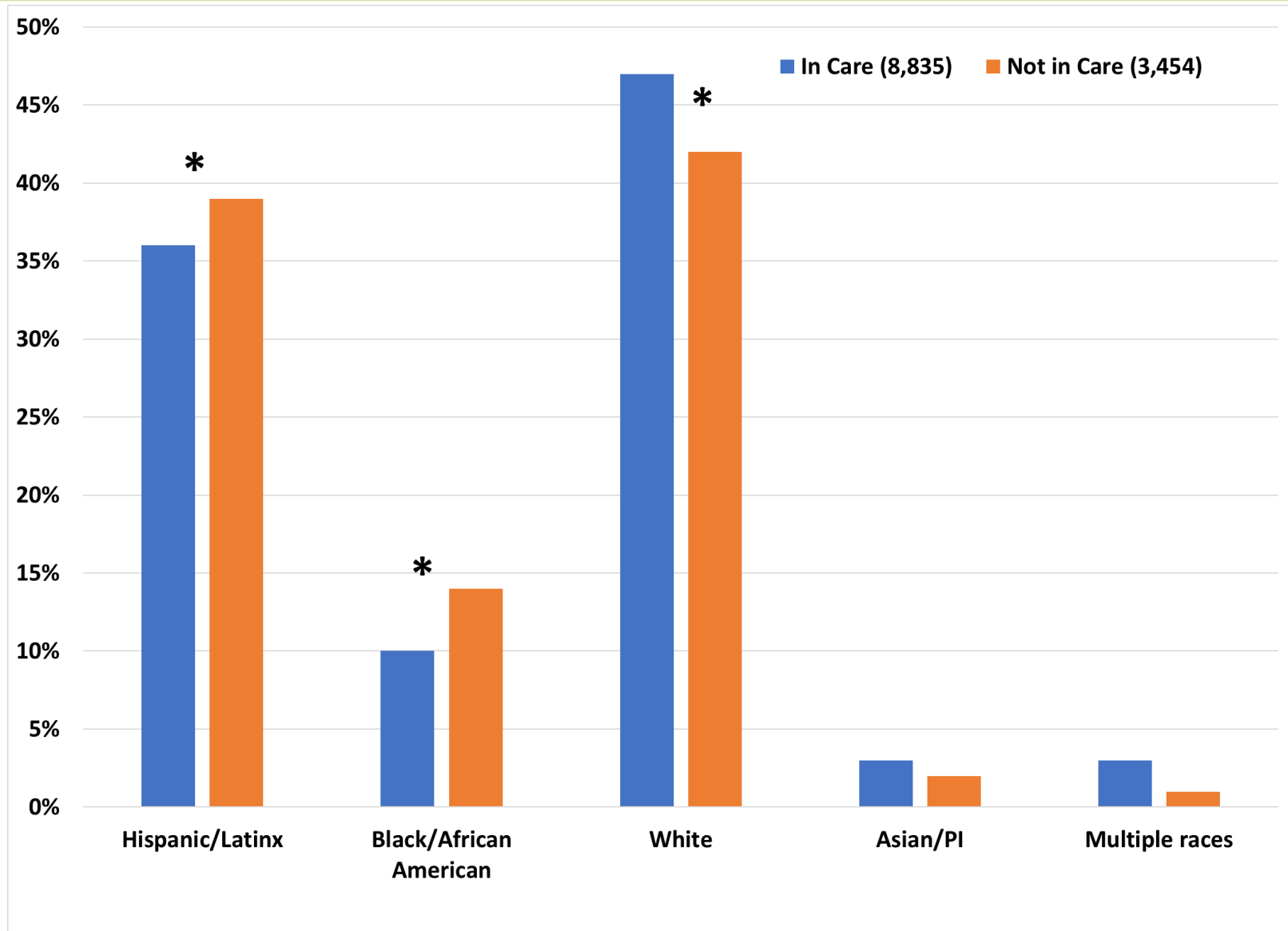
TRANSMISSION CATEGORY



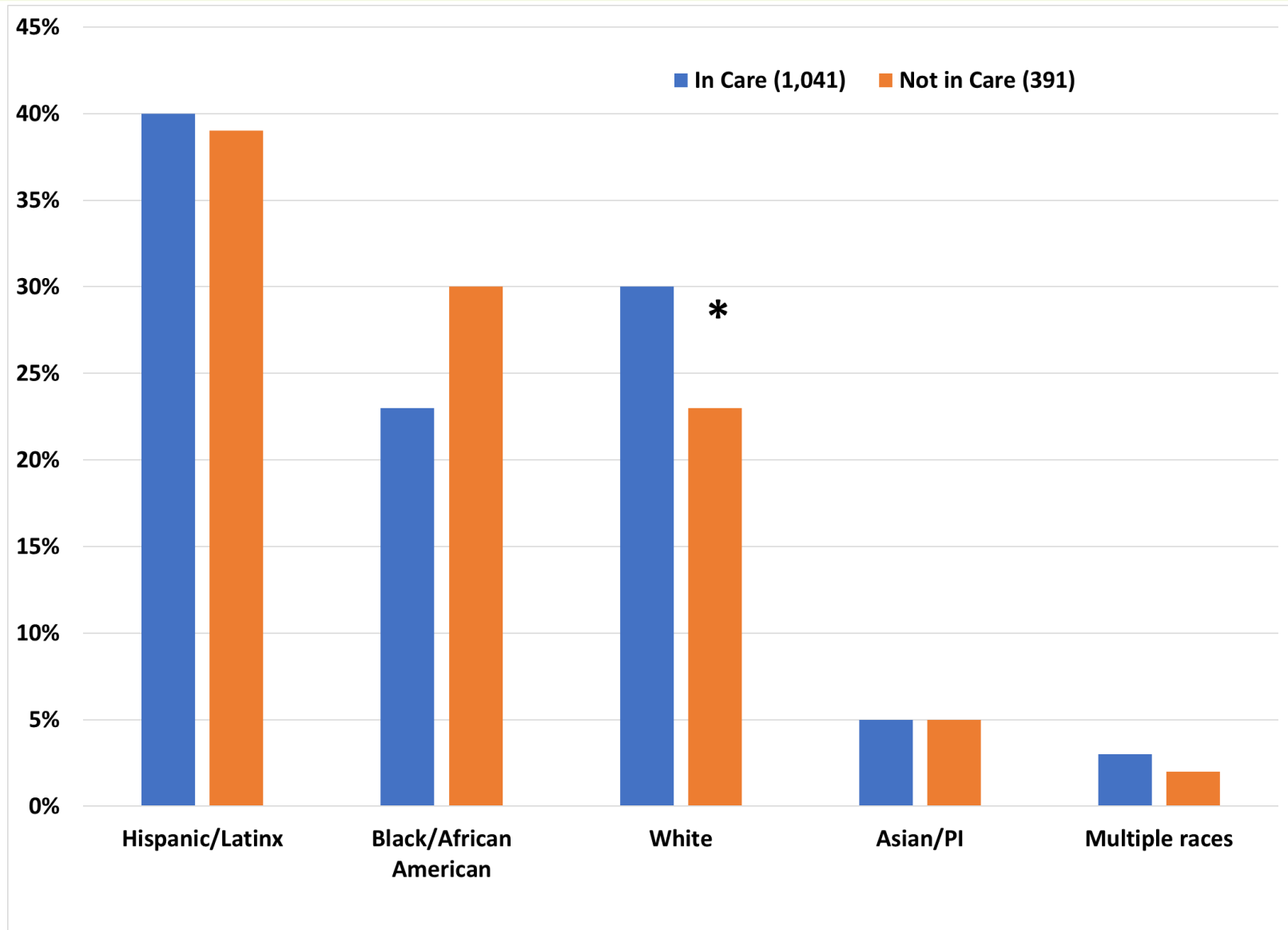
RACE/ETHNICITY



RACE/ETHNICITY - MALES

- In care and Not in care similar in
 - Sex
 - Gender
 - Age distribution
 - Transmission category
- Race/Ethnicity significantly different
 - Hispanic Latinx and Black/African American
 - More likely to be out of care
 - White
 - Less likely to out of care
 - Same in males only
 - Females only – only whites significantly different
- Bias towards Not in care
 - Incomplete information
 - May have left area
