Project SARAH

Project SARAH is a support system for individuals experiencing intimate partner violence. We offer a safe, confidential setting for you to consider your options, work through a mix of feelings, and determine the best way forward for yourself and your family.

Project SARAH provides resource navigation and limited financial support to meet the basic needs of individuals experiencing intimate partner violence.

Eligibility:

- Adults 18 years old and up
- Presenting with safety concerns or limited resources for basic needs due to current abusive relationship or change in financial status due to the abuse.

Every night, JFS operates a Safe Parking Program for unsheltered San Diegans living out of their vehicles, many of whom are experiencing homelessness for the first time. With holistic services focused on basic needs assistance, employment, family wellness, school success, financial education, credit repair, and housing, our goal is to create a pathway out of homelessness while being a support to people where they are now.

The program operates seven nights per week at four secured lots at Balboa Avenue, Aero Drive, Mission Village Drive (open 24 hours), and Encinitas.
