



CalWORKs Housing Support Program (HSP)

The CalWORKs Housing Support Program provides assistance and support services to help families toward housing stability.

To be eligible to the program you must be:

- Receiving CalWORKs benefits
- Currently homeless or at risk of becoming homeless:
 - No permanent place to sleep at night
 - Staying in a shelter
 - Camping or staying in parks or other public places
 - Have received an eviction notice and/or have past due rent
 - Staying in a hotel/motel but cannot continue to do so
 - Staying with friends or relatives but cannot continue to do so

If you are eligible, some of the services provided may include, but are not limited to:

- Assistance to find a safe, affordable and permanent housing
- Contacting landlords to explain how the program works
- Assistance with required application or credit check fees
- Rental assistance including payment of past due rent, security deposit and last month's rent, rental subsidies
- Assistance for gas, electric and other essential move-in costs
- A housing support case manager to help you develop a plan for long term housing stability
