Never share personal information with unknown individuals and/or organizations. Personal information includes:

- Social Security Number
- Bank information
- EBT card number
- EBT card Personal Identification Number (PIN)

Tips for Protecting your PIN:

- Don't write down your PIN
- Your PIN is to be kept secret
- Don't use your PIN when others are watching
- Delete text messages requesting your PIN and/or card number
- Change PIN frequently
- Try to shop and/or bank at different locations
- Never enter your PIN on a downloaded smart phone app
