- 1. Meeting called to order at 9:34 by Chair, Vino Pajanor.
- 2. The May 8, 2024 Meeting Minutes were approved, with all Board Members present voting yes.

- 3. Public Comments:
 - No public comment
- 4. Presentation Item: State Budgets Impact Overview: Jeannie Hufford, Deputy Director, Self-Sufficiency Services, Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA). Ms. Hufford provided an overview of the State Budget deficit that projects a \$44.9B deficit from the May Revision and its \$61.2M impact to Self-Sufficiency Services programs. The Medi-Cal Administration with a proposed reduction of \$3.5M, the CalFresh Administration with a \$5.1M reduction and the CalWORKs Administration will be greatly impacted, with a \$21.3M reduction and further eliminations.
- 5. **Information Item:** Review Legislative Advocacy Bills that Support SSAB Strategic Priorities: Assmaa Elayyat, Deputy Director, Self-Sufficiency Services, Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA). Ms. Elayyat shared an updated draft letter of support to the Board of Supervisor regarding SB 2241, which the Members present at the previous meeting voted yes to move forward with advocating. She also shared a message from Dr. Eric McDonald, Interim Agency Director for the Health and Human Services Agency, regarding the presentation of the CAO's Recommended Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-25 to the Board of Supervisors and what it means for the Agency if the Governor's current proposal stands.
- 6. Information Item: Update on Medi-Cal Renewals, PHE Lift for Public Assistance Programs, Waivers, Enrollment, Service Delivery, Data: Assmaa Elayyat, Deputy Director, Self-Sufficiency Services, Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA). Ms. Elayyat provided an update on the County's Opt-in for additional BenefitsCal features, including Interview Nudge, General Relief application, EBT/BIC replacement, VITA, Disaster CalFresh (when DCF is active), Click to Chat and Call Me. She also shared updates on CalFresh, Medi-Cal and CalWORKs programs flexibilities and waivers, as well as Google Ad samples for EBT Skimming and Scamming reminders. Ms. Elayyat also provided updates on a variety of monthly reports.



Dear Chairwoman Vargas,

I am writing to you on behalf of the Social Services Advisory Board (SSAB). Over the last year, San Diego County's Health and Human Services Agency, Self-Sufficiency Services, has been committed to identifying and reducing barriers facing applicants and recipients of public safety net programs. Through this process, the Eligibility Task Force was established and worked with several community partners and a County contracted consultant to identify and implement on-going solutions for barriers that applicants and recipients experience.

Part of those recommendations prioritized by the Eligibility Task Force include expanding communication pathways by encouraging both applicants and recipients and the County to communicate via methods that are most preferred by customers. Senate Bill (SB) 2241 proposes codifying the ability for customers and the County to communicate via different methods, including phone, in-person, by mail, or by electronic means including, but not limited to, secured e-mail, thus allowing customers better opportunities to correspond with the County and reduce unnecessary barriers. The bill would further protect customer confidentiality by requiring State or County agencies that receive information through unsecure channels to inform the customer of a privacy concern and provide reasonable alternative methods for resubmitting the information. Historically, communication methods or pathways have been limited under State policy or law, thus the passage of this bill would help greatly reduce communication barriers faced by customers while ensuring adherence to confidentiality guidelines and requirements.

Given the recent budget cuts and anticipated additional cuts in county administrative funding for Social Services programs, the additional flexibilities proposed in this bill with customer correspondence can help mitigate some of the forecasted increase for demand in service over the coming years.

For the reasons indicated above, we request San Diego County actively support SB 2241. As Chair of the SSAB, I am writing to recommend that the San Diego Board of Supervisors actively support this request.

Monthly Self-Sufficiency Services Performance Dashboard (FY 23/24)







