Lindsay Riedel Reuther is a lifelong advocate for gender equality and the eradication of gender-based violence. She brings over a decade of professional experience to her role as Commissioner for the Commission on the Status of Women and Girls in San Diego County. Previously, Lindsay worked in health communications for the County of San Diego, leading health information campaigns for the Maternal, Child, and Family Health Services branch. Before that, she worked as a Manager at the Center for Community Solutions, a leading provider of sexual assault and intimate partner violence support services. Additionally, she served as an Assistant Director at the Women's Center at California State University San Marcos, managing programs focused on the empowerment, education, and advancement of students who identified as women.



In the political sphere, Lindsay has extensive experience as a campaign manager and political strategist, having managed and/or contributed to multiple campaigns at the local and state levels. She currently serves as Partnerships & Marketing Director at Evinco Strategies, a women-run political consulting firm.

Outside of her professional endeavors, she has contributed academic research and writing on the role of gender in political protest movements, served on the Public Policy Committee for the California Partnership to End Domestic Violence, and volunteered for organizations like Women Give San Diego, the National Organization for Women, and the Women's Information Network, all of which share common goal of empowering women and promoting equality. Lindsay graduated with a Master's Degree in Public Policy and Women's Studies from George Washington University, along with a double major in Women's Studies and Social Sciences from Cal State San Marcos.
