Agenda item #2 - Approval of Minutes: Chair Custodio Suero entertained a motion to approve the January 3, 2025 regular Commission meeting minutes. # **Agenda Item #4 – Committee Reports:**

- a. Civic Engagement: VC Davis expressed the Committee's desire to reach out to the City Commission on the Status of Women and Girls. VC Davis is planning to attend a future City commission meeting, and invited others to attend as well.
- b. Policy Committee: VC Ogunsaju reported that logistically, the location and timing of

- the January 24th Committee were good. The action item for Committee members is to review the CEDAW ordinance. The next Committee meeting is scheduled for February 28th.
- c. Governance Committee: VC Gutierrez reported that the committee discussed and agreed on its areas of focus for 2025, which include documenting the Commission's operations procedures, exploring funding opportunities, and supporting recruitment efforts.
- d. Executive Board Committee: Chair Custodio Suero reported that she has been in touch with the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer for the County of San Diego in hopes of getting more traction on the CEDAW implementation.

# **Old Business**

# **Agenda Item #5 – Initiative Updates and Liaison Reports:**

- a. CEDAW Advisor: Chair Custodio Suero reported on the status of the baseline analysis, on behalf of CEDAW Advisor, Parisa Ijadi-Maghsoodi. It was recommended that all commissioners familiarize themselves with the CEDAW ordinance, especially section 3. (See attached report.)
- b. Women's Hall of Fame: Commissioner Vasquez shared that she reached out but was unsuccessful in connecting with the chair of the Women's Hall of Fame. Chair Custodio Suero connected with Laura Mitchell at the Women's Museum and was informed that the event is taking place in November.
- c. Association of California Commission for Women: Comm. Welty was finally able to connect with ACCW and will be attending the next meeting on February 20th.

#### **New Business**

# Agenda Item #6 – Guest Speaker:

Bettina Hausmann, President, United Nations Association (UNA), Southern California Division presented on the United Nations Commission on Women's (UN-CSW) convening in New York City in March, 2025. 2025 marks the 30th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action which centers on 12 areas of action to advance the rights of women and girls. The UN-CSW's goals align with CEDAW and the SD County Commission's charge as a stakeholder in its implementation. There are 11 chapters in the UNA Southern California division. The UN-CSW convening will be presented in a hybrid platform, with 8,000-9,000 attendees expected to participate globally. San Diego county has 20 delegates, including representatives from the San Diego County CSWG. A minimum of two days of attendance is required, and representatives are responsible for covering their own travel and accommodation costs. Commissioner Martinez will be attending as a representative of the SD County Commission on the Status of Women and Girls. Ms. Hausmann informed on how to access content virtually.

The NGO CSW Civil Society Forum runs parallel to the UN-CSW and provides a space for non-governmental organizations to engage, network and advocate for gender equality and the rights and empowerment of women and girls.

Agenda Item #7 - Vacancies/Appointments:

Chair Custodio Suero invited Kelly Jenkins-Pultz to introduce herself as an at-large candidate. Ms. Jenkins-Pultz's application will be voted on at the February Board of Supervisors meeting. Chair Custodio Suero tasked the Executive Committee with reviewing past and current applications and cross-referencing them with the current vacant positions. Names of potential candidates will be brought to the full Commission so that we can collectively agree on and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors to fill vacant at-large seats and encourage appointments as needed. Commissioners were reminded that at-large applications can be submitted to the Commission on a rolling basis. Additionally, we were advised to expect an appointee from Supervisor Lawson-Remer soon.

# Agenda Item #8 - Approve 2024 Annual Report to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors:

Vice Chairs Davis and Gutierrez made some corrections and revisions to the previous draft. Commissioners were expected to review the final draft report prior to the meeting. A motion from Vice Chair Ogunsaju to approve the report; was seconded by Commissioner Khan. The motion passed.

# <u>Agenda Item #9 - 1619 Celebration of Black Women Exhibition-March Women's History Month:</u>

Former Chair Leah Goodwin copied Chair Custodio Suero and Vice Chair Gutierrez on an email to Joshua Dunn, Community Representative from the County, requesting the display of a quilt and other works of art at the County Administration in partnership with the 1619 Celebration of Black Women as part of the County's Art Halls Art Walls Program, during Women's History Month in March. VC Gutierrez reached out to Ms. Goodwin to determine what support might be needed from the Commission but to date has not heard back.

# Agenda Item #10 - Kim Center for Social Balance LEAPS Initiative:

Commissioner Martinez briefly discussed the LEAPS initiative on workplace equity, how it aligns with the Commission's focus areas of research as well as the tenets of CEDAW, and the potential for collaborative opportunities with the Kim Center for Social Balance. Martinez will invite Dr. Hei-ock Kim, Founder and Director of the Kim Center, to present to the Commission at a future meeting.

- c. Vice Chair Gutierrez requested an update on the bylaws review process. County Counsel Murray did not have an update, and VC Gutierrez will follow up with Staff Assistant Garcia.
- d. Commissioner Davis thanked County staff who provide administrative support for Commission meetings. Commissioner Davis requested that someone take the lead on representing the Commission on the human trafficking task force. Commissioner Khan agreed to be the representative.
- e. Commissioner Khan announced that the Female Genital Mutilation Task Force of Southern California is hosting an international zero tolerance event.

# What experience or special knowledge can you bring to your area(s) of interest?

I have worked in the family violence field for the past six years in San Diego County. I received my bachelor's degree in Anthropology and Sociology with a minor in Gender and Sexuality Studies from Pacific University in Forest Grove, Oregon. During that time, I received the Mary Fehrs Award for Gender and Sexuality Studies for my research in sexual assault prevention on college campuses. I obtained my Master of Social Work from Boston University with an emphasis on program planning and organization development. I began my work with SBCS San Diego as a Domestic Violence Counselor and Case Manager in the Family Violence and Support Services Program. In that time, I obtained my certification as a Domestic Violence Counselor. With SBCS, I also took on roles on the Domestic Violence Response Team, which provided on-scene support to victims who had experienced violent crime, and the Alternatives to Detention team, which provided non-punitive alternatives to youth that had been arrested. My past experience includes program management and evaluation for YMCA San Diego's Behavioral and Mental Health Services department. Before joining IVAT as the Manager of Training and Continuing Education, I worked as a Program Manager for Nile Sisters Development Initiative, an organization that provides vocational training to immigrant and refugee women who are victims of crime. I am currently on the Board of Directors of Resounding Joy Inc., a non-profit that provides music therapy to individuals and families with challenges to their mental, physical, or emotional health.
