# San Diego Regional Technology Project Funding Caveats for the Allocation of Funds

#### **License Plate Readers**

The readers will display regional markings and will be maintained by the San Diego Police Department at no cost to the grants and will be made available for regional use if requested.

## North Zone Public Safety GIS System

Coordination with ARJIS is required for ARJIS to be the repository for the data and to ensure integration of the data with GIS. CAD to CAD implementation will be considered should funding be available in FY06 grants. Agency is encouraged to re-apply when the application period opens. This project should also be coordinated with ARJIS to determine potential cost savings with the development of a generic XML.

### Regional Communications Trailer/Prime Mover

The vehicle and trailer will display regional markings and will be maintained by San Diego Fire-Rescue Department at no cost to the grants. Maintenance (repair and service) of the communications equipment will be borne by the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department.

#### ICC Radio Cache

Maintenance (repair and service) of the radios as well as the cost of replacement batteries will be borne by the Sheriff's Wireless Services Division at no cost to the grants.

#### **Mobile Communications Equipment**

Maintenance (repair and service) of the communications equipment will be borne by the Sheriff's Wireless Services Division at no cost to the grants.
