## **UDC Budget Proposal**

**Option 1** - Increase UDC Budget by \$178,500 by increasing County OES, State Homeland Security Grant (SHSP), and Member (18 Cities) shares. The increase in Member shares of \$59,500, would be split between Jurisdictions using the established formula & cover GEM costs.

## **FY21 SHSP Reallocation**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- Starting in FY11 SHSP, a competitive Reallocation process was implemented.
- For FY20 SHSP, a total of \$100,372 was returned to our region
   & funded:
  - Cellular Gateway Network for (1) Mobile Command Vehicle,
  - (44) Regional Cellphone Boosters for Enhanced Communications,
  - (4) P25 Compatible Public Safety Radios, and
  - Upgrades to Command Vehicle Communication Equipment.
- The anticipated funds available for Reallocation for FY21 SHSP is \$90k.



## PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Proposed projects have a <u>three-month</u> completion timeframe (October 21, 2023 to January 21, 2024).
- 2. Projects must not require EHP, Aviation, or Watercraft approvals.
- 3. Projects must not require new Sole Sourcing pre-approvals for Project Expenditures that are over \$250,000.

\*Requested projects that have a sole source pre-approval in place for the FY21 SHSP will be accepted.
