EVAC, PROTECT & ALERT/GEM EXPLAINED

"EVAC" Evacuation & Repopulation Management Software

Identify the area (zone) under impact using EVAC, Protect, or Map Book

- Message Formation – determine the status level and desired response
- Agency Coordination

"PROTECT" Mobile app/website for the Public

- Community awareness site where the public can get information directly from local authorities

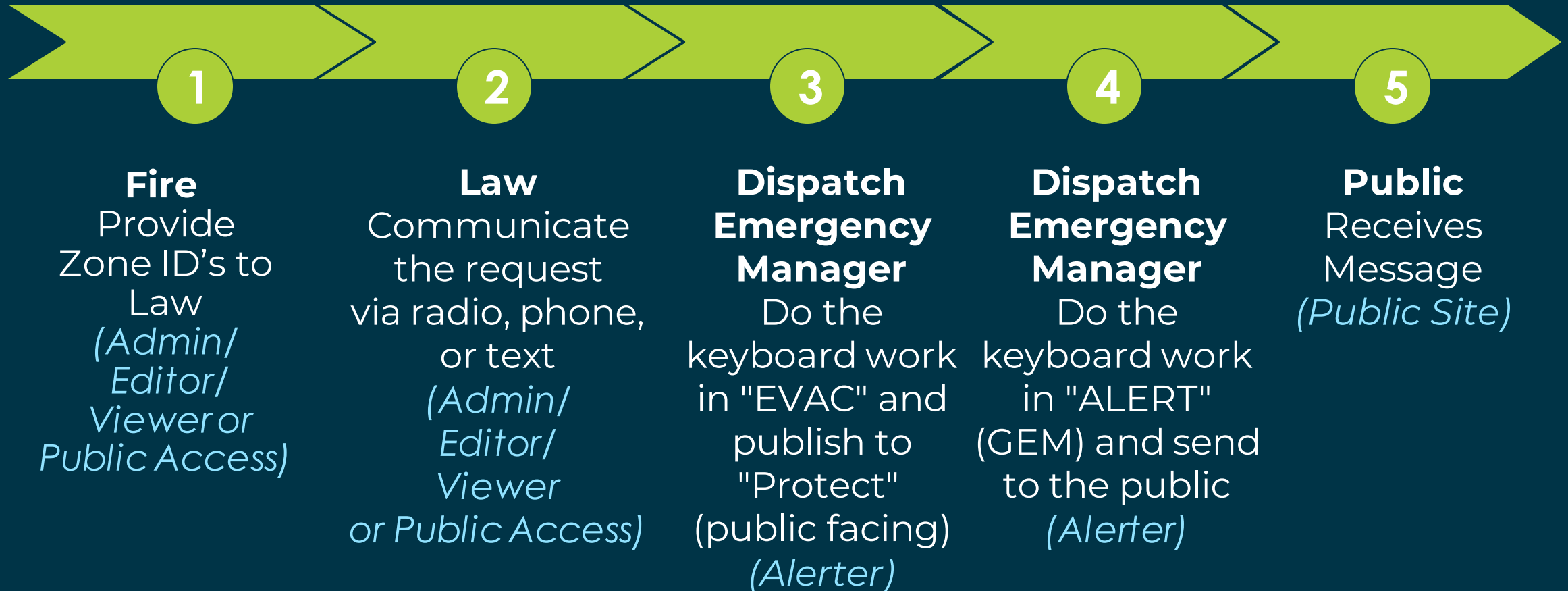
"ALERT" Alert San Diego Public Alerting System (GEM)

- Delivery to Public via WEA/IPAWS, SMS, email, voice, mobile app



WORKFLOW CoSD

Status called in from the field and keyboard work done in EOC or Dispatch in "EVAC"
Evacuation & Repopulation Management Software and "Alert" Alert & Warning Software

"EVAC" Evacuation & Repopulation Management Software

User Roles

ADMIN
-Add/remove users
-Assign user roles
Edit zone data

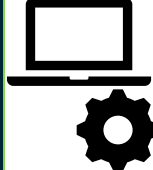


System Admins serve as the gatekeepers to the county system during implementation and beyond.

Requests for access to zone data from outside entities will be referred to the primary admin.



EDITOR
-Edit zone data
-Change internal zone status




Editors are stakeholders with permission to change zone data and make "internal only" zone status changes.

Editors serve an important role in developing evacuation pre-plans and in finalizing zone boundaries.




ALERTER
-Change zone status & push to the public



An admin or editor can also have "Alerter" privileges. This role is what allows a user to make status changes community visible.

Viewer
Can see what's in the system but can't make changes

REFERENCE MATERIALS: CoSD EVAC Field Card

PRIMARY FOCUS - INCIDENT SPECIFIC TRAINING

- **Change Zone Status** – Push Internal Only
(Not to public)
- **Change Zone Status** – Push to Public
- **Add Road Closure and Traffic Control Points** – Toggle On/Off
- **Add Arrival Points** and Toggle On/Off
- **Use Zones as target area in "ALERT" (GEM)** - Send to public *Comms Only in Training Mode*

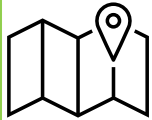

ZONE BOUNDARY ACCESS Map Books



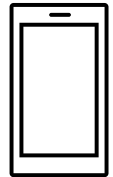
- CoSD Map Books will be provided for patrol vehicles

- Tablet Command

- Included in Map Books
- Can be included in PDF Pre-Plans

Consistent Messaging



- Templated messages for the reason box (available in ALERT/GEM)
- Create and distribute workflow process
