TRAINING OVERVIEW

The purpose of this course is to provide San Diego County **Genasys EVAC Users** with the basic knowledge required to perform their duties including all basic system operations and settings, such as creating and publishing zone status changes, adding both arrival points (shelters) and traffic control points (road closures), splitting and merging of zones, printing a PDF single zone map, running a fire simulation and overall monitoring of the public facing Genasys Protect community website.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of this course, the new User should be able to:

- Log in and navigate the EVAC System freely.
- Create, update, and publish zone status changes.
- Create, update, and publish Arrival Points (shelters) and Traffic Control Points (road closures).
- Confirm zone status changes in Genasys Protect and Tablet Command.
- Split and Merge zone boundaries.
- Print PDF maps of an individual zone.
- Create a fire simulation.
