 - 1. County of San Diego Actions Member Reports and Updates
 - Quarterly Community Planning/Sponsor Group Chair Meeting Chair attended the Microsoft Teams meeting online on September 18. The topics covered at this meeting were shared with the group members
 - Partnership to move the region to ZERO Carbon The county is proposing a 3prong approach: zero emissions, reduction of super pollutants, carbon capture though tech and nature.
 - Climate Action Plan Renewable Energy Zoning County is focused on roof top solar, grid scale industrial zones near electric substations, battery storage on large grid roof tops, parking lots. Battery type not specified but proper waste management will be part of the process. Will have to return to the Board of Supervisors with the Plan
 - Housing, Safety and Environmental Justice Element General Plan Update (John)Not there
 - Clearing, Grading and Water Course Ordinance (JoEllen and Mark)Storm
 drainage was being explored by Jo Ellen and County Hydro Engineer. It was
 suggested the cost would be a minimum of a million dollars for corrective
 measures
 - Capital Improvement Riverside Bridge (Mark) The changes to the bridge would be a "Capital Improvement Project" to modify the bridge and improve it with a pathway for pedestrians

- Forest Management Meeting with Senator Brian Jones's District Director,
 Andrew Hays (Mark)Kerry and Mark met with Andrew Hays to discuss the management of Rancho Cuyamaca State Park and to gain the assistance of State Senator Brian Jones in Fuel Reduction as a means of wildfire prevention. Cal Fire "Fire Boss" training in only one site, Sacramento, was also discussed
- SANDAG EIR Review / SANDAG Draft Digital Broadband Equity (Kerry)Lots of activity, letters, emails from the County and other planning groups was shared. The main issues of taxation without benefit in the SANDAG Vehicle Miles Traveled tax was the focus of all the groups. Kerry to comment on the Draft 2021 Regional Plan for SANDAG
