• **Kathleen Lippit** expressed her objections to the new proposed Social Equity Cannabis regulations that the BOS is considering. Kathleen felt that the survey had flawed methodology and bias.

5. PUBLIC RECORDS: New Online County of San Diego Request Center (PRRC)

Keith Van Wagner, County Staff, gave a brief introduction to the goals and the functioning of the new online County Records Center. He asserts it is our basic right to inspect records and records are presumed public with some exceptions. For instance, you cannot request a record of yourself. The Record Center includes everything the County of San Diego owns. They are trying to centralize the system. In making a request, be as descriptive as possible. **Darla Kasmedo** asked about FAQ's and whether they would spell out the necessary details to the public accessing the site.

6. MUP-10-013W1 – Cell Site: Barrett Junction (3CA00642)

The Notice from the County states: "The applicant requests a Major Use Permit Modification (MUP Modification) to continue operating and maintaining and existing wireless telecommunication facility."

Kevin May said that in January 11, 2022 our group approved this project for 2 towers but only one has been built. The Applicant is asking for a 15-year extension on Notice of Exemptions (NOE) pursuant to CEQA. **Kevin** noted that nothing has changed in the use of

this permit. The location is up on a hill. It will go in front of the Planning Commission this month. There is nothing to vote on unless we have a comment. There were no comments or objections.

8. <u>Jamul Casino Hotel and Entertainment Center Expansion Project</u>

Concerning the traffic signage for the cement trucks crossing SR-94, **Kevin May** said the trailers and signs were up and then taken down. **Kevin** talked to Tyler at Caltrans and they were put up without a permit. They need to decide what they need for notification. **Michael Casinelli** asked if he had contacted Supervisor Anderson's office as it is a safety issue. **Kevin** said they need a permit for the trucks to cross but not for the trucks themselves.

9. "Jamul Indian Village Land Transfer Act" H.R. 6443, Bill sponsored by Rep. Darrel E. Issa (R-CA-48)

Kevin May said HR 6443 Bill has passed the House with "suspension of the rules" and passed by voice vote on April 9, 2024. On April 10, the Bill was "received in the Senate and read twice and referred to the <u>Committee on Indian Affairs.</u>" Our group can follow up with a letter to the Chair of the committee.

Ed Mollen moved that we send a letter to the Senate Indian Affairs Committee.

Motion passed unanimously.

Kevin moved we should also write a letter to Senator Alex Padilla.

Motion passed unanimously.

Kevin moved that we form a group of members to meet with the Senators staff.

Motion passed unanimously.

Michael Casinelli, Courtney Etynre, Kevin May and Preston Brown volunteered to meet with Staff members.

Kevin May read from an update letter from the County on VMT's.

"On March 1, 2023, the board received a report on VMT mitigation options and provided direction to continue coordination with outside agencies and jurisdictions, to

estimate costs to project applicants, to solicit stake holder input, and to receive additional Board direction before the VMT mitigation program is fully developed."

"A VMT mitigation program will play a role in determining where development efforts are focused in the unincorporated area such as near jobs and transit to reduce travel and greenhouse gas emissions, consistent with intent of Senate Bill (SB) 743 balanced with considerations regarding development feasibility."

On May 22, 2024 staff will provide an update to the BOS on the progress of this program.
