Action Items:

1. Proposed rate increase in San Diego County Sanitation District Sewer Rates. Hearing affects existing lots in Map 566 - . April 12, 2017 in Rm. 308. Discussion of the fact that no new EDUs (Equivalent Dwelling Units) can be created, but the 30 existing unused EDUs can be developed or transferred.
2. Park Land Development Ordinance (PLDO) funds. . No one present to discuss this issue. Valley Center wants to change format so 10% can be used for maintenance (currently only development). Pat will write a letter on this.
3. Climate Action Plan (CAP) Hard to meet goal of 80% reduction of green house gases by 2030. The North County Multiple Species Conservation currently being developed is considering 60% reduction. East County plan is next, and Julian should be involved.
4. Road improvements: a) 1910 Second Street No progress at this time, sight distance bad, check possible alternatives. B) County is going resurface Blue Jay to Eagle Peak but not Eagle Peak Rd. Leave on agenda. Put road maintenance on agenda again.
5. Forest Conservation initiative Lands CPA. Currently seems inactive. Leave on agenda.
6. Possibly inviting Joel Anderson, Senator, California 38th District. Leave on agenda.
7. Comprehensive Renewable Energy Plan. Leave on agenda.
8. Ground Water Policy and ground water information. Chair passed out County Water Conservation Residential Density Controls sheet with minimum parcel size based on mean annual precipitation (Clerk of B. of S. Document 195172)
9. Santa Ysabel Nature Center. JCPS discussed proposed plan. Motion by Dackermann, second by Krawiec. To write and encourage minimum damage to meadow. Passed 7 to 0.
