 Approval of previous meeting minutes (1/23/24): Cheryl/Rachelle. Unanimous.
Public comment on items not on the agenda (3 minutes max per speaker) David Stone expressed concern with paving on Pine Street. (commented at end of agenda)

5. 7th Street traffic speed concern: Several residents spoke to the subcommittee expressing concerns about speed of traffic. It is posted 25 mph but residents report traffic often moving much faster. Various remedies were suggested.

Tina Conrad - Concerned about traffic in the vicinity of I St & Telford on 7th Street. Paul Jarrett - Blind spots on the 7th Street hill. Worried about being rear-ended when stopping to turn into his driveway. Pulling out is difficult & unsafe due to speed of traffic. Jess Good - Paul Jarrett read a prepared statement on their behalf.

Mr. Norman - Concerned about speed of traffic

Gayla Hager - Concerned about speed of traffic

M. Gillmore - Neighborhood feel is lost. Suggested rumble strips & flashing lights. Dave Hager - Stated that the residential speed limit is 25 mph, both state & federal. **Motion: Concerns be reported to the county for review and implementation of safety measures as appropriate. The subcommittee also would like concerns reported to law enforcement for extra attention. C. Wegner/J. Cahak. Unanimous.** 

6. San Vicente Road lane delineation. Center line is difficult to see.
