# Appendix F: Sample Projects

This Appendix presents the Sample Projects.

## Sample Projects

Sample Projects serve as a conversation starter for communities to consider in their traditional top-10 CIP lists of community capital improvements. The proposed sample ATP projects were developed as a result of reviewing the planned Mobility Element network, planned County Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Projects, existing and buildout LTS, existing safety conditions and opportunities for improved connections or facilities.

**Table 5-1** summarizes sample ATP projects by community. The projects have been identified to illustrate a variety of toolbox features.

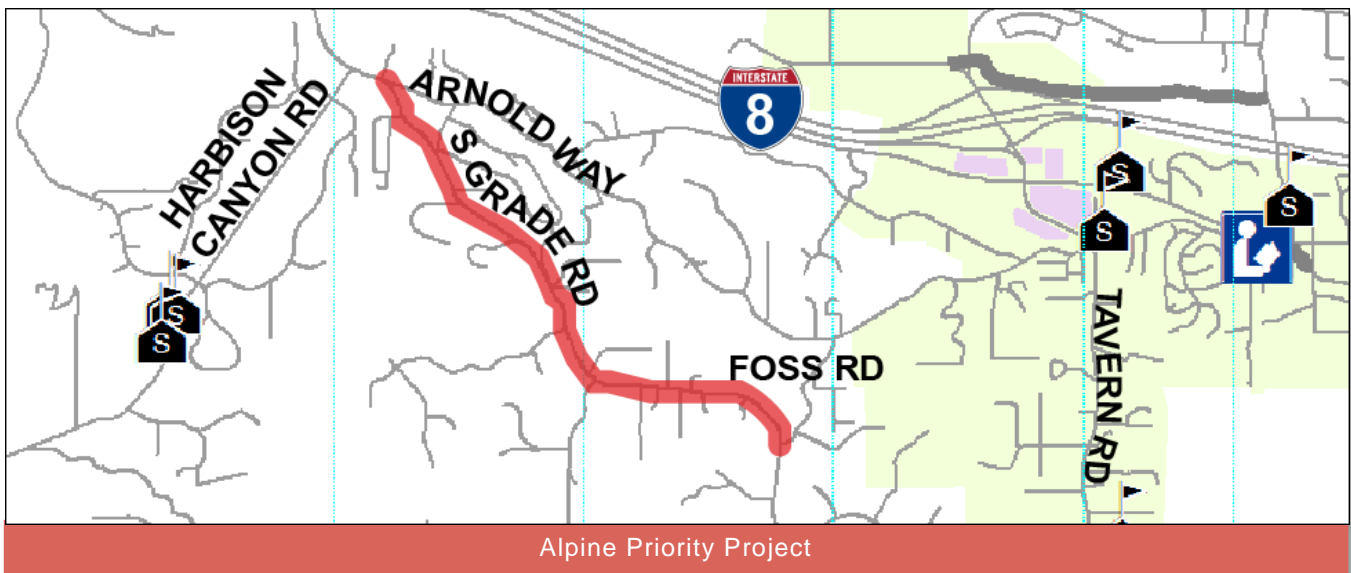

## Project Descriptions

### Alpine

#### *South Grade Rd: Arnold Way to Foss Rd*

Class II bike lanes are recommended on both sides of the road to provide improved bicycle access and connection between the Village area of Alpine and the schools on Harbison Canyon Road. The recommended bike lanes should be buffered, if right-of-way permits. Green paint is optional to draw attention to potential conflict areas, including curb cuts and driveways.



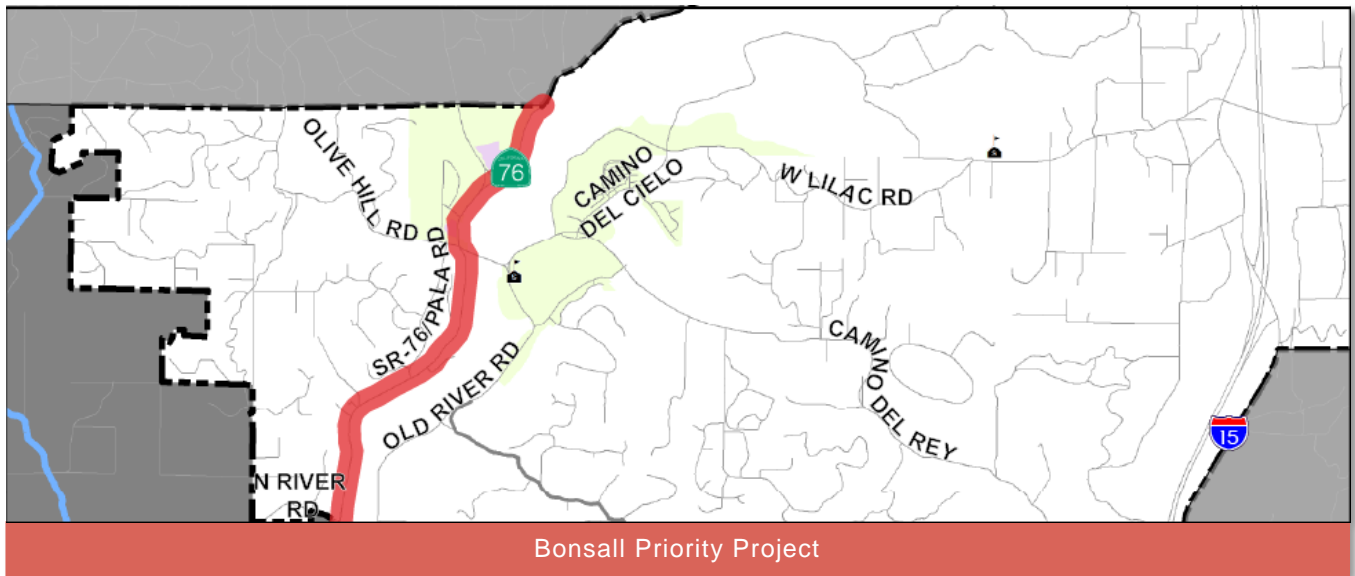
### Barona

For the purposes of the ATP, the communities of Barona and Ramona were consolidated. Refer to the *Ramona-Barona* project.

## Bonsall

### *Mission Ave/Mission Rd/SR-76: Bonsall Community Boundary to Northern Community Boundary*

Class II bike lanes are recommended on both sides of the roadway. This facility will provide bicycle access and improved connections to the village area and communities beyond.



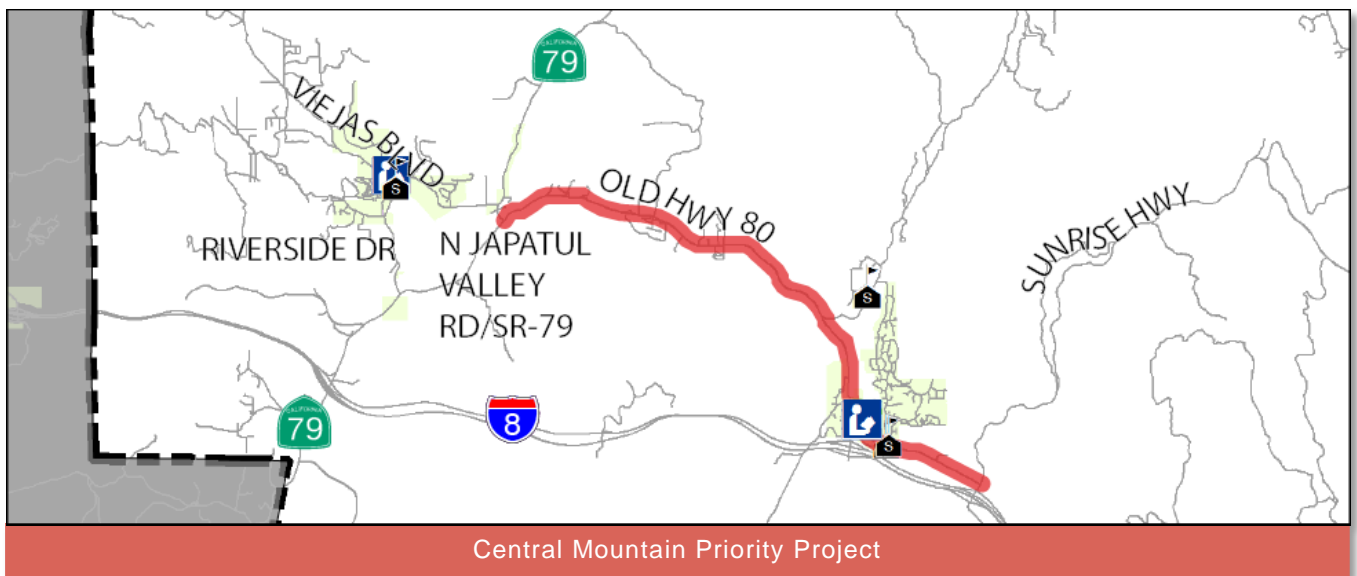
## Central Mountain

### *Old Highway 80: Sunrise Highway to SR-79*

The Pedestrian Gap Analysis identified the need for a sidewalk on the north/westbound side of Old Highway 80 from Pine Boulevard to Pine Valley Road. An additional DG pathway is recommended to connect the library, schools, and residential communities along the remainder of the segment. To connect facilities for people walking across intersections and across the roadway to attractors, Enhanced Pedestrian Crossings, such as RRFBs or HAWK Signals, are also suggested.

For bicycles, a Class II bike lane on both sides of the roadway is recommended. Protected intersections are suggested to comprehensively connect the bike lanes through major intersections, particularly where higher volumes of turning movements by bicyclists and motorists are made.

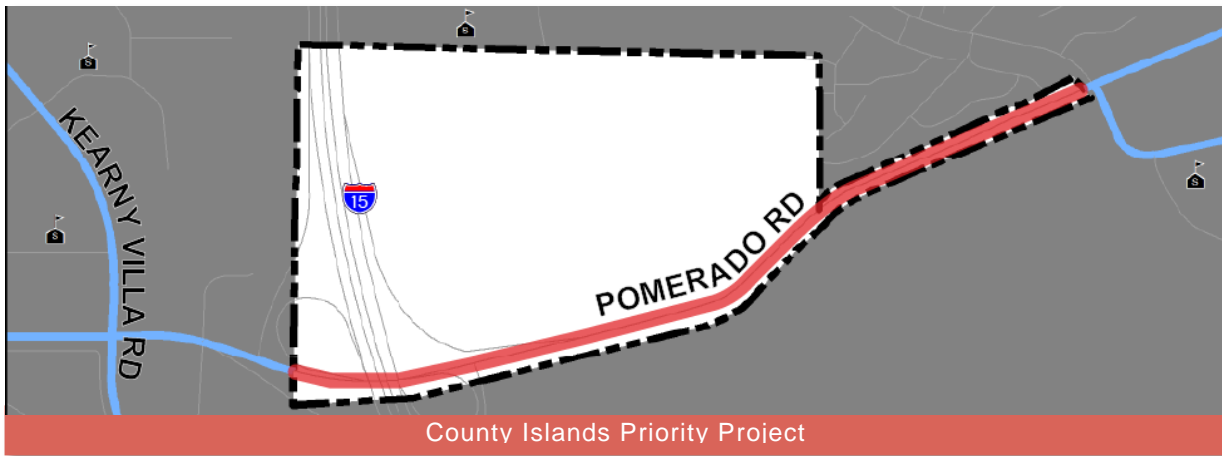
Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Programs and related funding opportunities are recommended for the schools along and in proximity to this project.



## County Islands

### *Pomerado Rd: Between Community Boundaries*

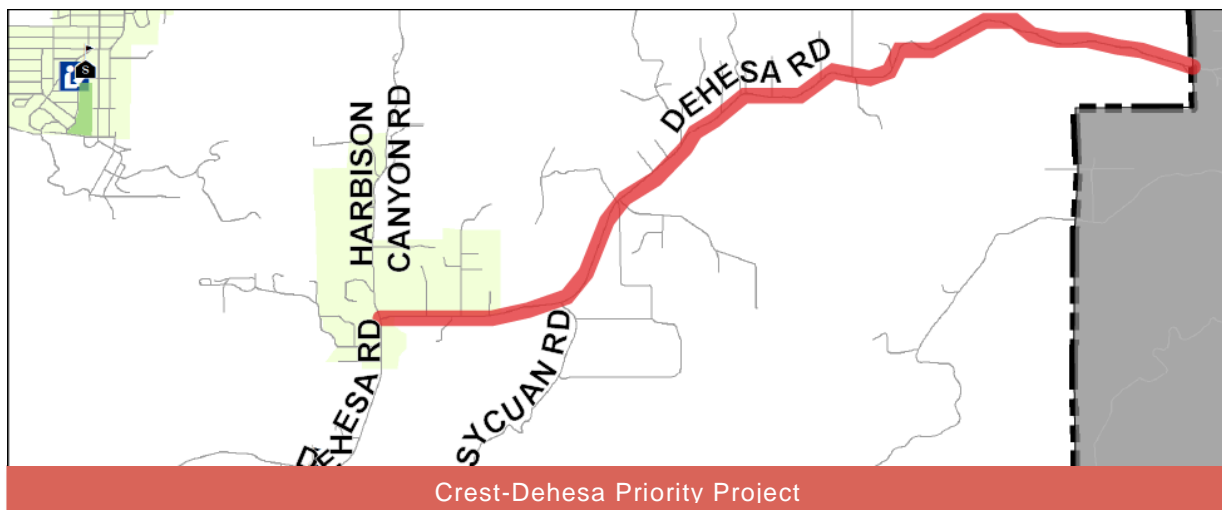
To provide a low stress and “All Ages and Abilities” bicycling facility, a two-way Class I multi-use pathway is recommended along the roadway segment. Protected intersection treatments are also suggested at large intersections along the project segment to facilitate improved crossings for people walking and biking.



## Crest-Dehesa

### *Dehesa Rd: Harbison Canyon Rd to Crest-Dehesa Community Boundary*

Class II Bike Lanes on both sides of the roadway are recommended to provide bicycle facilities along the corridor. Protected roundabout or intersection treatments are should be considered at the Dehesa Road and Harbison Canyon Road intersection to improve crossing conditions and access for all users.



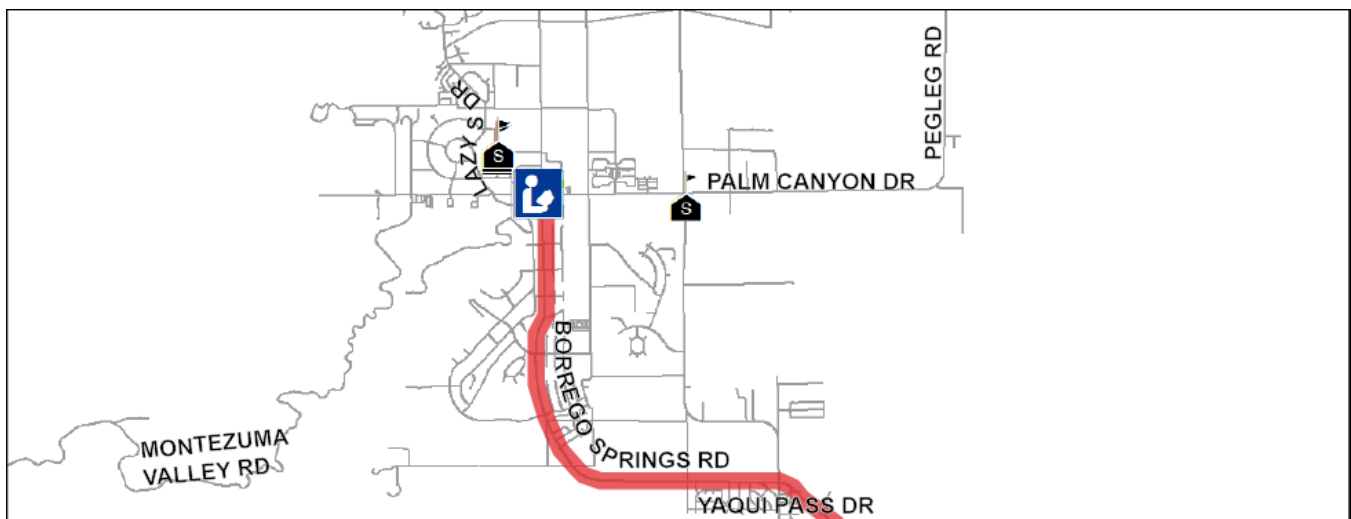


## Desert

### *Borrego Springs Rd: Yaqui Pass Rd to Palm Canyon Dr*

It is recommended that the existing roundabout at the intersection at Borrego Springs Road and Palm Canyon Drive be converted into a protected roundabout to facilitate bicyclist and pedestrian access through the intersection. 1-way Class IV cycle tracks are suggested along the segment to provide an “All Ages and Abilities” bicycle facility in the area.

Recommended pedestrian improvements include the installation of sidewalks or DG pathways to connect attractors like schools and commercial uses for short distances. The schools near or along Borrego Springs Road are encouraged to implement SRTS programs to improve access for students biking and walking to school.

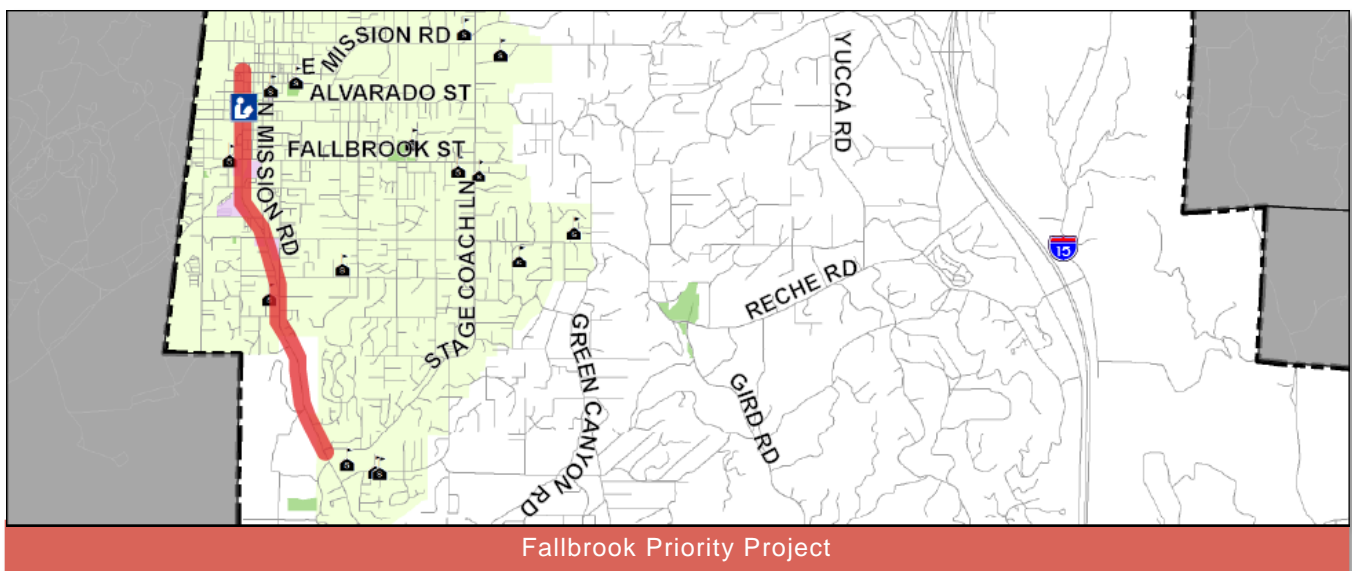
## Fallbrook

### *S Mission Rd: E Mission to S Stage Coach Ln*

The project along South Mission Road runs through the heart of the Fallbrook community and presents an opportunity for a Complete Street overhaul that is recommended to include:

- A protected intersection at S. Mission/Stage Coach;
- Sidewalks, as identified in the PGA;
- Sidewalks or DG pathways with Green Street features and landscaping, where feasible; and
- 1-way Class IV Cycle Tracks to provide an “All Ages and Abilities” bicycle facility in the area.

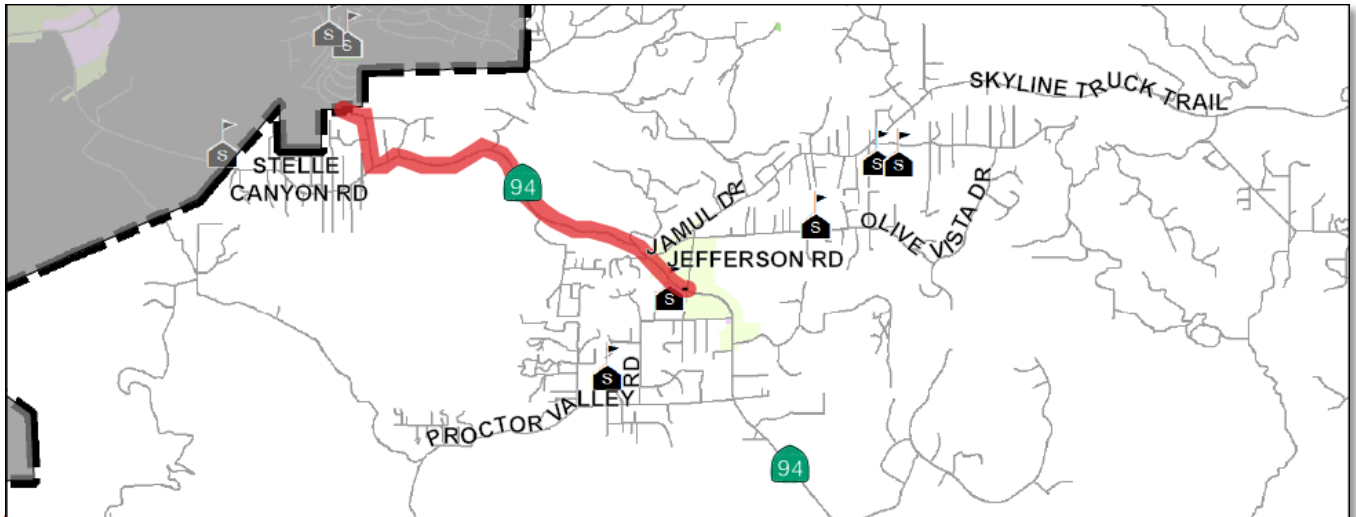
This project overlaps with a planned CIP project, which includes the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of South Mission Road and Pepper Tree Lane. It is suggested that these ATP recommended improvements be incorporated into the CIP project, wherever feasible.



## Jamul-Dulzura

### *SR-94: Northern Community Boundary to Jefferson Rd*

1-way Class IV cycle tracks are recommended along SR-94/Campo Road to provide an “All Ages and Abilities” bicycle facility in the area with connections to Spring Valley.



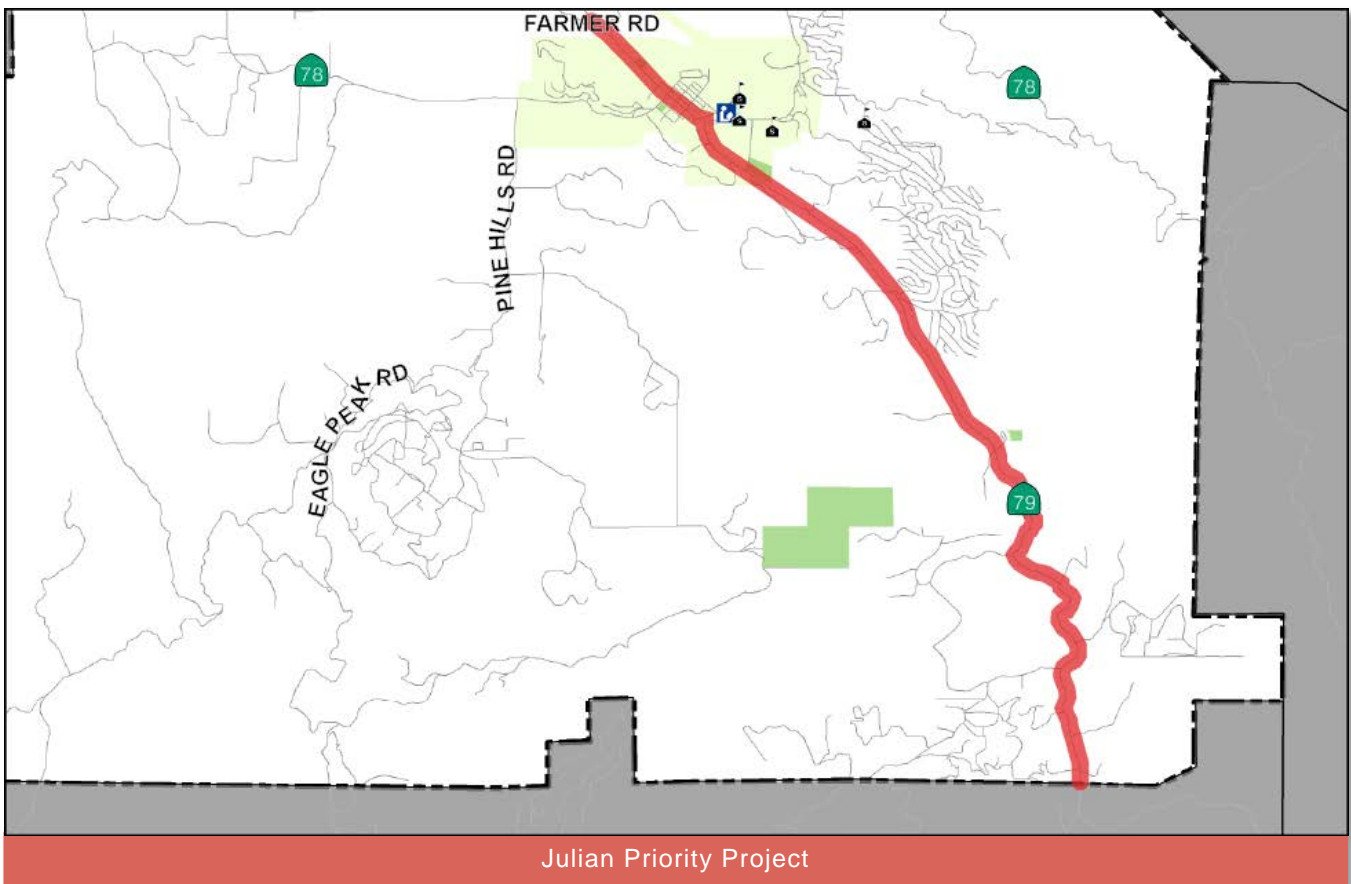

## Julian

### *SR-78/SR-79: Farmer Rd to Southern Community Boundary*

A Class II bike lane is recommended along SR-79 from Pine Hills Road to the Julian Community Boundary to provide separate facility for regional bike travel. A Class IV cycle track from Banner Road to and along Main Street is recommended to provide a separated facility for people biking within the downtown area of Julian. Additional bicycle parking and/or a bike corral is recommended in the village area of Julian (Main Street West of SR-78). Bike parking facilities should be considered along red-curb areas to avoid loss of on-street parking.

In accordance with the recommendations of the PGA, pedestrian ramps to improve ADA access should also be installed in the Julian village area.



## Lakeside/ Pepper Drive

### *Bradley Ave: Between Community Boundaries (2 segments)*

A CIP project consisting of the undergrounding of existing facilities and the removal of utility poles is planned for this project segment.

To maximize planned improvements as part of the CIP, it is recommended that 1-way Class IV cycle tracks are installed on both sides of Bradley Avenue within the unincorporated County boundaries. Protected intersections are also suggested to provide comprehensive multi-modal access to cross the roadway and improve connections to local attractors.

As identified in the PGA, the installation of sidewalks is recommended to provide pedestrian connections between local attractors, the Lakeside community, and the City of El Cajon.

Finally the integration of Green Street elements are suggested along Bradley Avenue to increase vegetation and provide runoff management while improving the pedestrian and bicycle environments. The vegetation and BMPs can serve as a buffer between vehicles and people biking and walking.



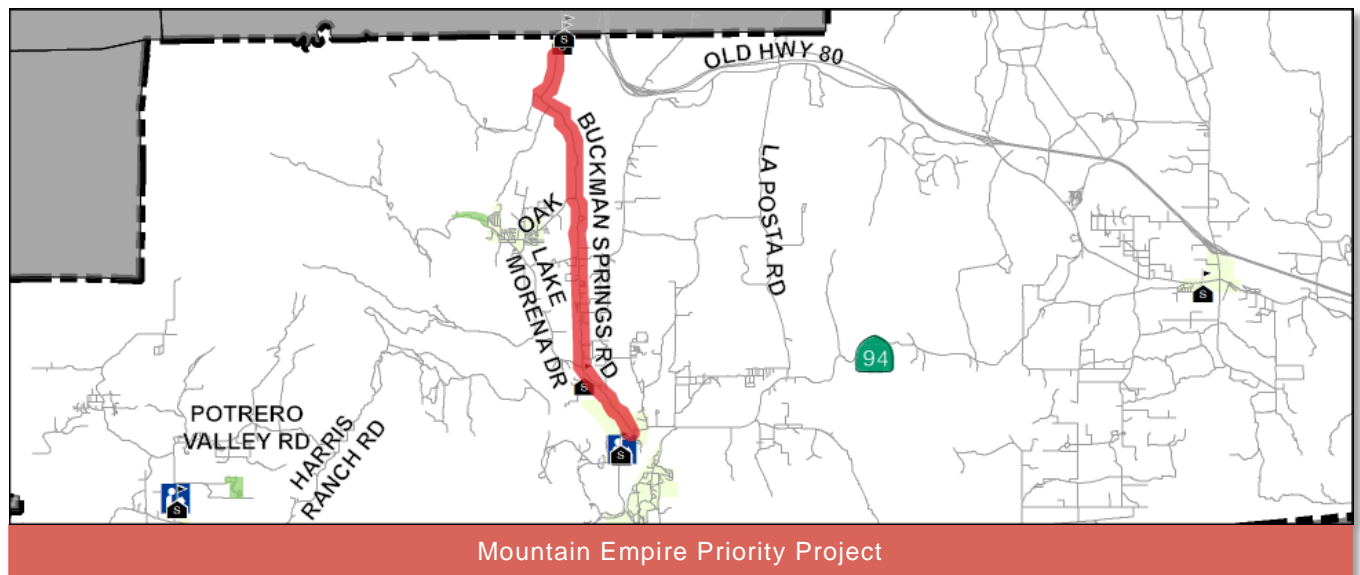

## Mountain Empire

### *Buckman Springs Rd: Northern Community Boundary to SR-94*

Class II bike lanes on both sides of the roadway are recommended to provide a connection between multiple schools and public uses, including a library. Where feasible and appropriate, protected intersection treatments are suggested to provide comprehensive access and turning abilities through intersections. Such connections are especially important near the schools.

Sidewalks or DG pathways are recommended along Buckman Springs Road to provide access to Campo Elementary School, Mountain Empire High School and other attractors. Traffic calming measures such as mid-block crossings (including RRFBs or HAWK Signals) or raised crosswalks are suggested to provide improved and emphasized crossing access between schools, residential areas, and bus stops. Schools in the area are encouraged to implement a SRTS Program to improve educational awareness and pursue opportunities towards funding

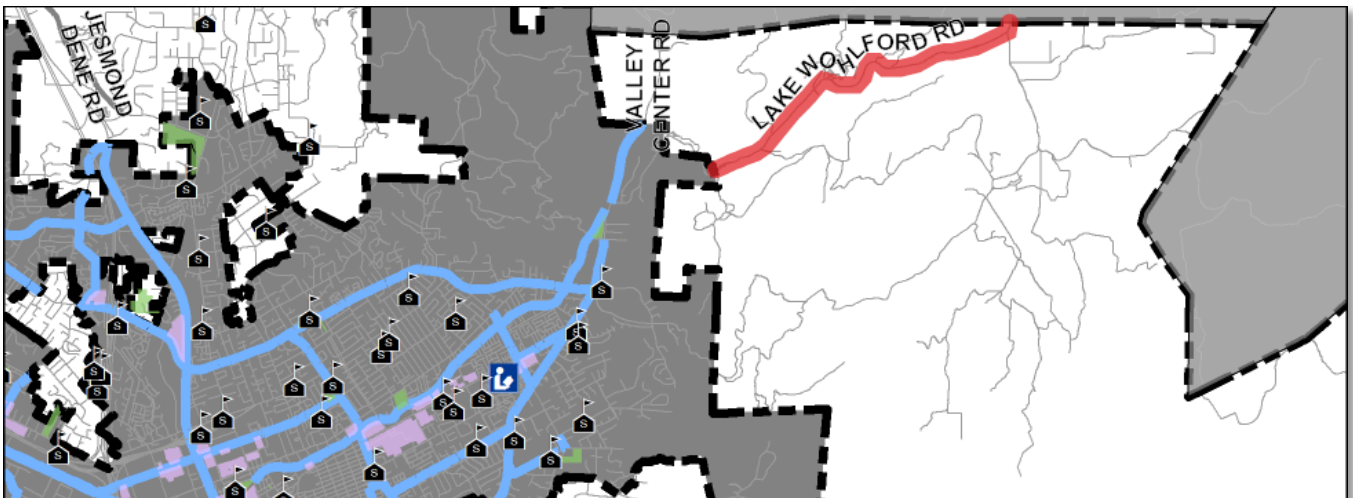


improvements.

## North County Metro

### *Lake Wohlford Rd: Between Community Boundaries*

Class II bike lanes are recommended on both sides of Lake Wohlford Road to provide regional access to Lake Wohlford and between adjacent cities and communities. Protected intersections are recommended for consideration along the route to provide improved access to the bike lanes and improve crossing conditions for all users.



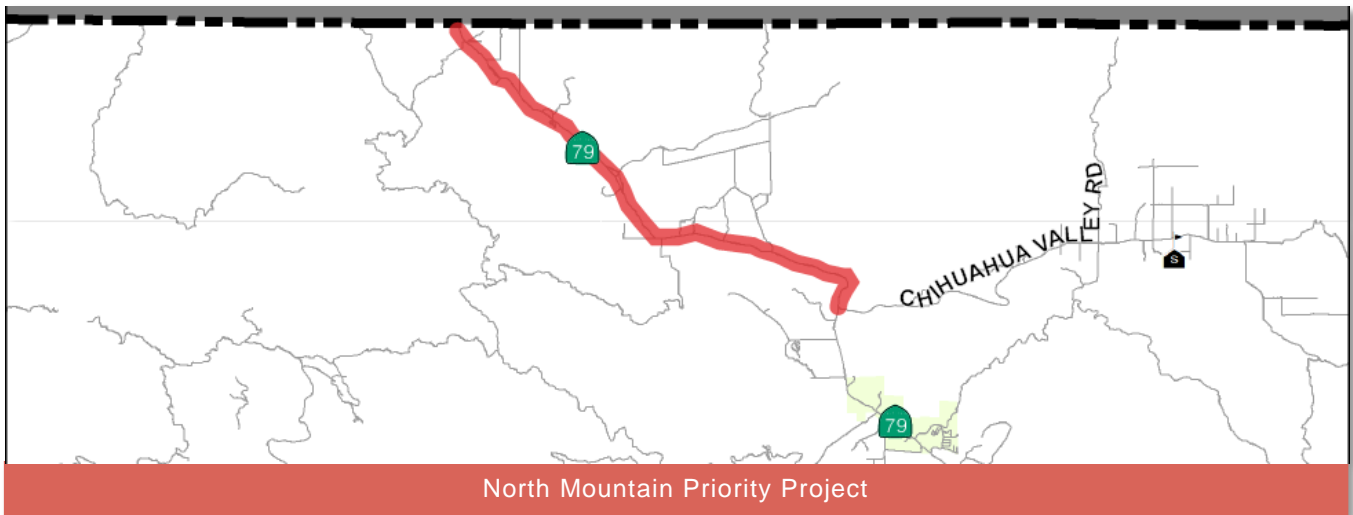
North County Metro Priority Project

## North Mountain

### SR-79:

#### *Chihuahua Valley Rd to Northern Community Boundary*

Class II bike lanes on both sides of the road are recommended to provide a regional biking facility that connects the North Mountain community to Riverside County.

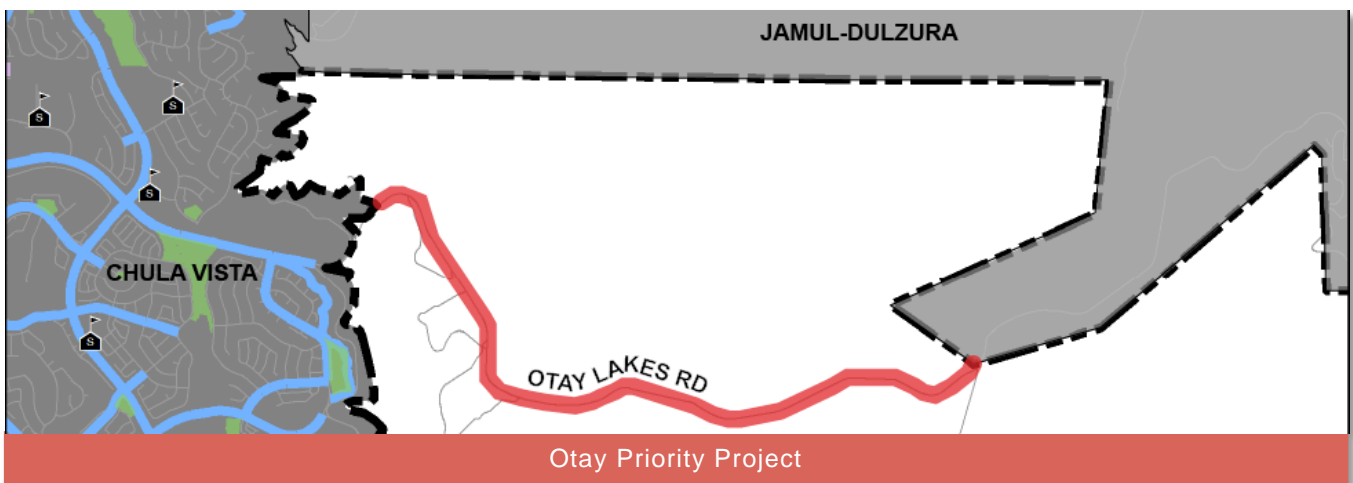


## Otay

### *Otay Lakes Rd:*

#### *Wueste Rd to Otay Mountain Truck Trail*

Class II bike lanes on both sides of the roadway are recommended to provide regional access between Chula Vista and the communities of Otay and Jamul-Dulzura.



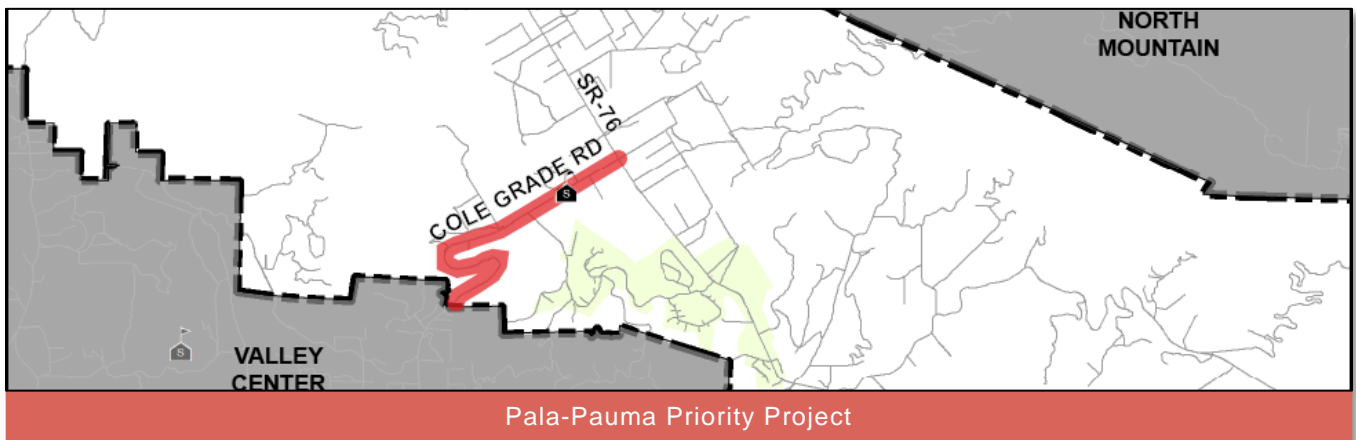


## Pala-Pauma

### *Cole Grade Road: SR-76 to Southern Community Boundary*

A CIP project is planned along Cole Grade Road. This project includes the construction of a bridge to eliminate the dip at San Luis Rey River. Where possible, this project should be coordinated with the installation of the following bicycling and walking improvements.

A complete street approach with Class II bike lanes and DG pathways or sidewalks is recommended along this segment. The bike lanes are recommended along both sides of the road to provide regional biking access. Pedestrian facilities are recommended to provide improved access to local schools.



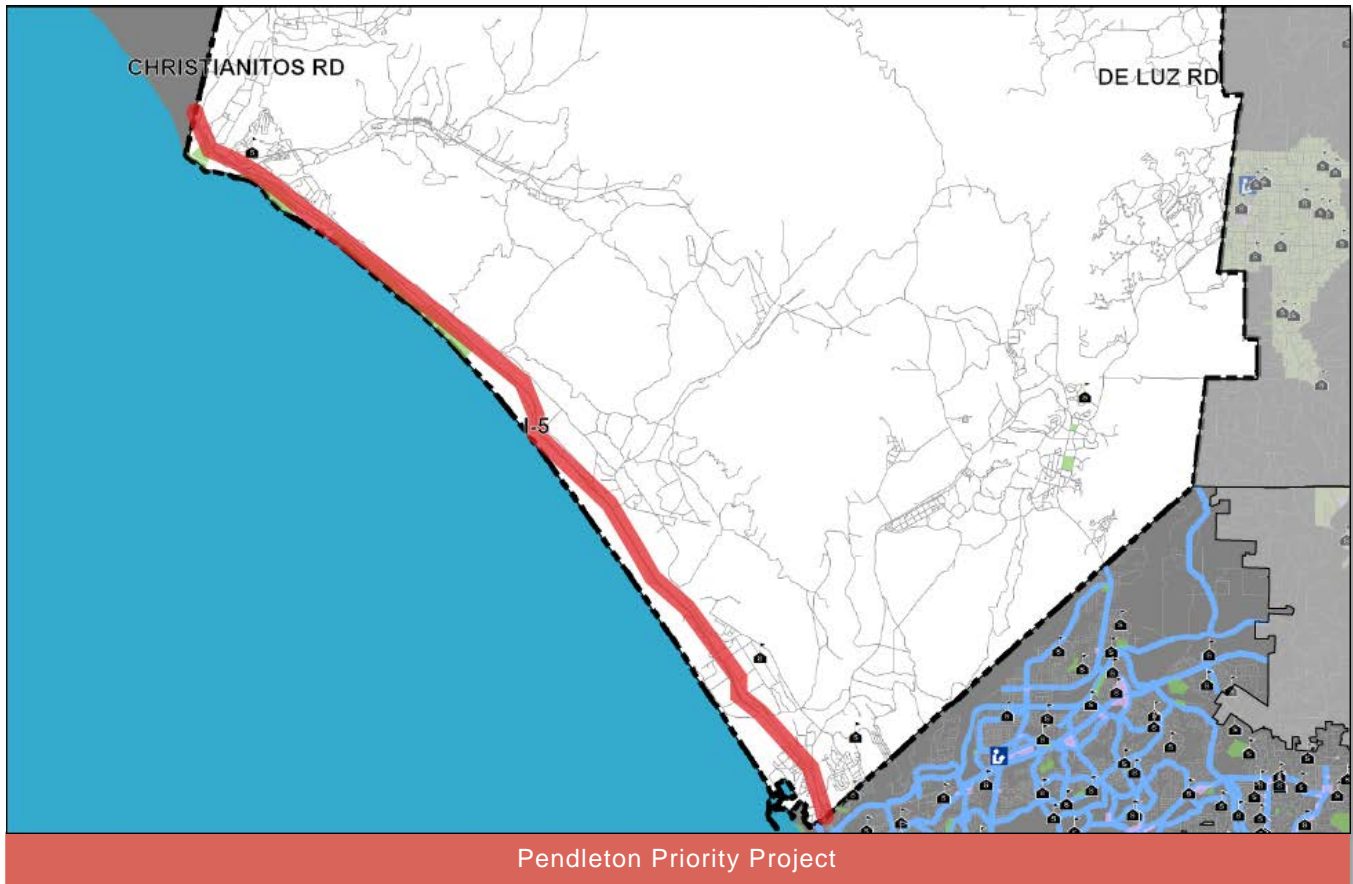
## Pendleton-De Luz

### *I-5 Coast Corridor:*

#### *From San Clemente/Orange County to Oceanside*

This is the only ATP project that is not along a Mobility Element Road. This project was chosen due to its regional significance and inclusion in the SANDAG Regional Bicycle Plan as a connection between San Diego County and Orange County.

A Class I pathway is recommended along the west side of I-5 to provide uninterrupted bicycling access between Oceanside and San Clemente. This project will require collaboration between the County, Caltrans and Camp Pendleton.



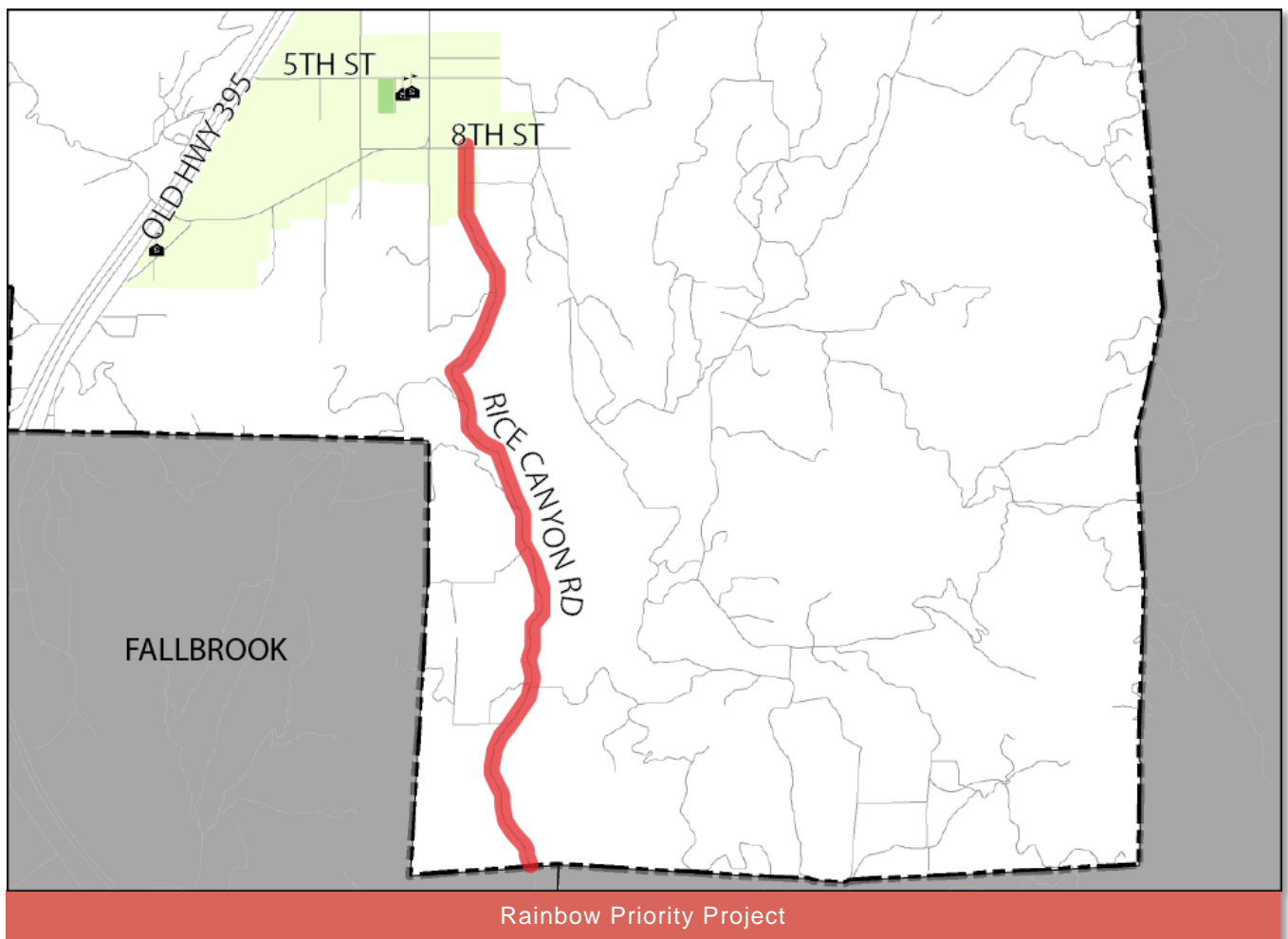
## Rainbow

### *Rice Canyon Curve - Southern Community Boundary to 8th St*

This project overlaps a CIP project, which includes the improvement of a curve located approximately 0.9 mile south of 8th Street. It is encouraged that the recommended improvement below be coordinated or overlapped with the construction of the planned CIP improvements.

The project improvements include:

- The installation of Class II bike lanes on both sides of the road to provide regional bicycling access; and
- The installation of a DG pathway for people walking and for access between residential areas and local schools



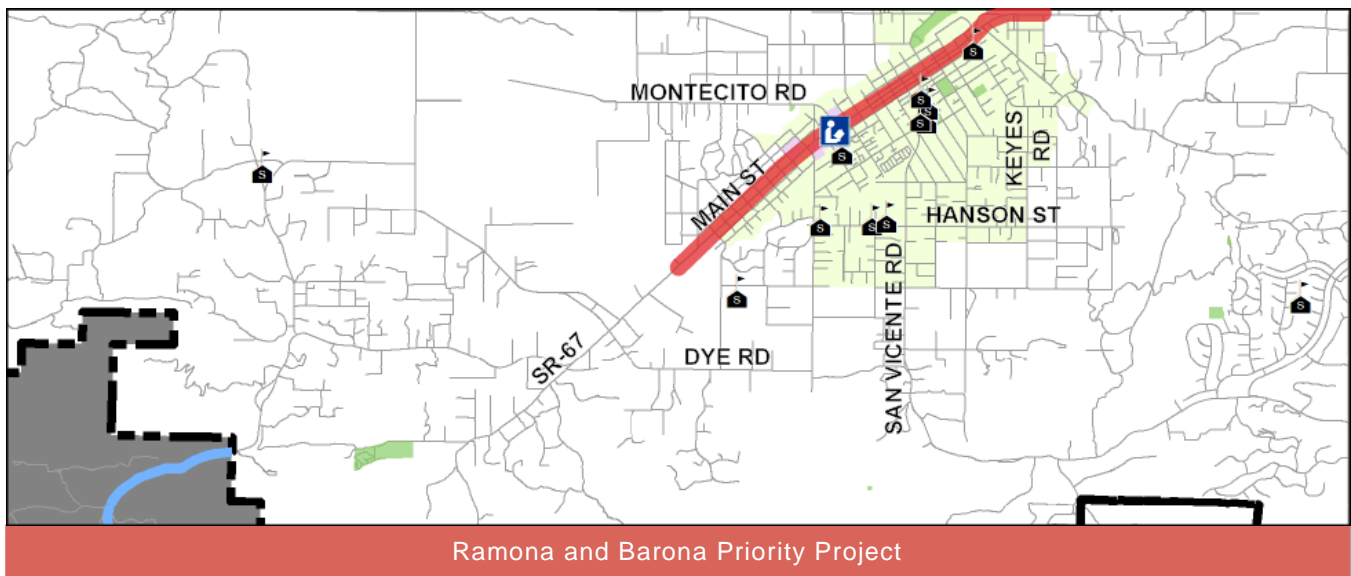
## Ramona and Barona

### *Main St: Sawday to Amigos Rd*

A Green Street transformation along Main St and through the heart of the Ramona community is recommended, including areas for planting and landscaping to lower the urban heat island effect and improve the pedestrian and bicycling environments.

1-way Class IV cycle tracks on both sides of the road with on-street parking separation are recommended. In addition, end-of-trip bicycle facilities, like bike corrals, are suggested to provide a space for people to lock their bike while frequenting businesses and other attractors and provide additional buffer between vehicles and pedestrians. Protected intersections should be considered at select locations to provide separate facilities for all modes while navigating the intersection.

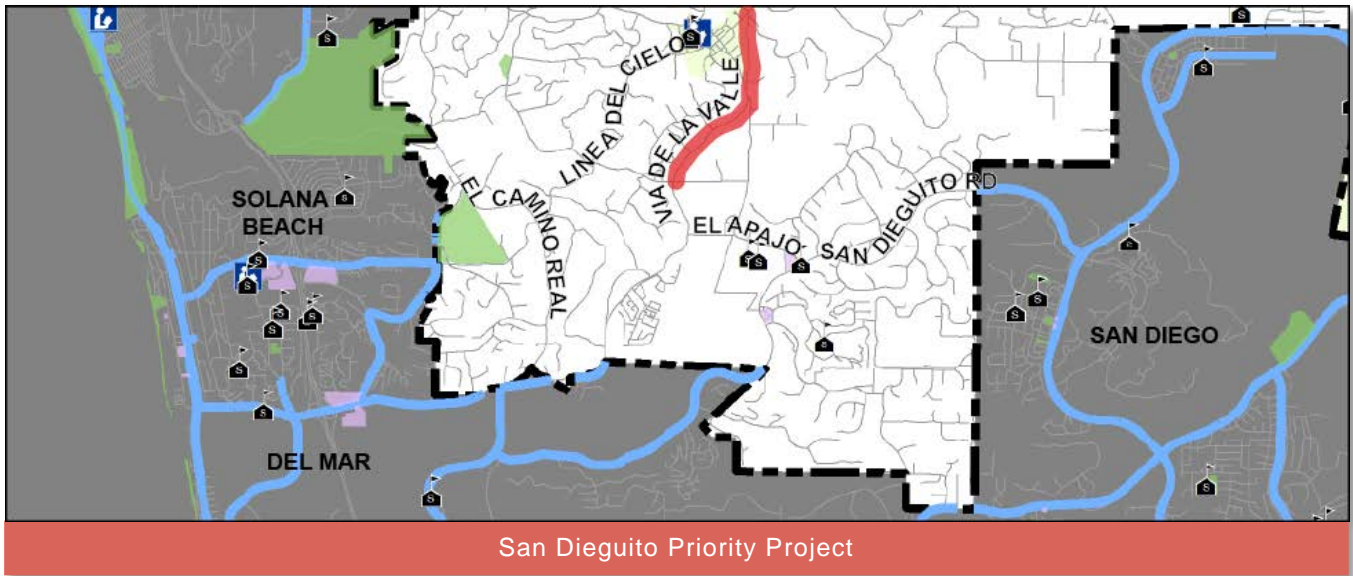
Pedestrian amenities within the parkway zone, such as benches, art, or signage, may be incorporated into the project design to improve the pedestrian environment. Improvements and supplemental amenities should be sensitive to the community character. Mid-block crossings (with RRFBs, HAWK signals or traffic signals, where warranted) are also recommended to improve pedestrian access and visibility.



## San Dieguito

### *Via de la Valle: Paseo Delicias to Via De Santa Fe*

Class II bike lanes on both sides of the roadway are recommended to provide bicycle access to the heart of Rancho Santa Fe. Consideration of a protected intersection at La Granada and Paseo Delicias is recommended to accommodate protected turning movements for all users.



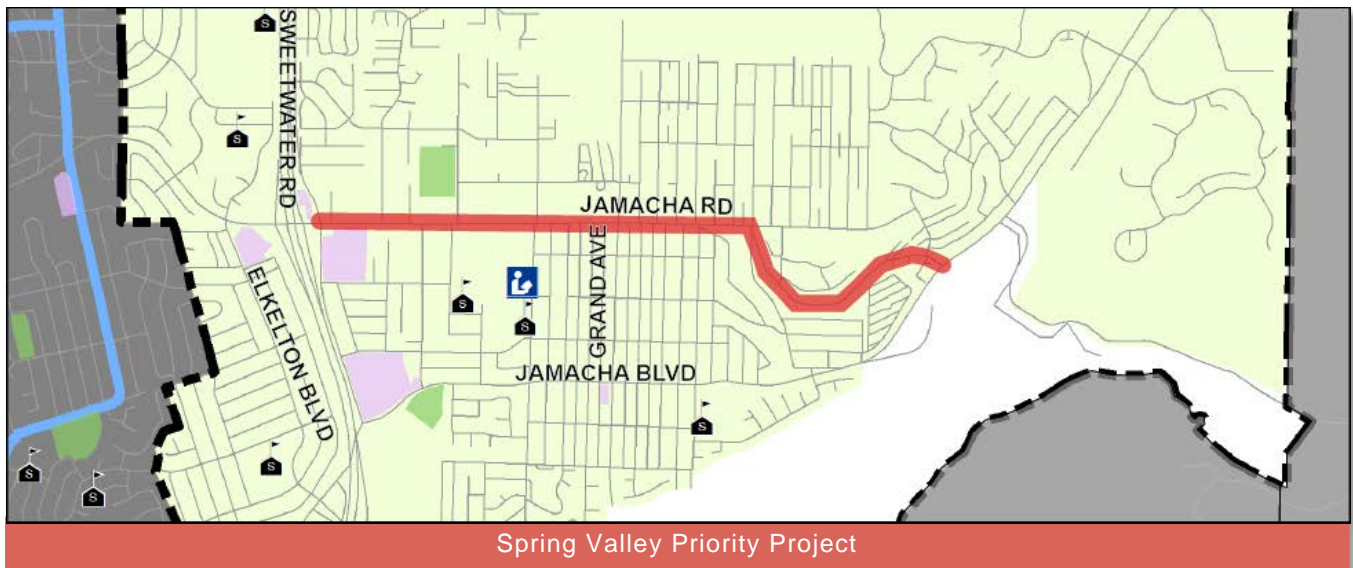
## Spring Valley

### *Jamacha Rd: Sweetwater Rd to Jamacha Blvd*

A Green Street transformation along Jamacha Road and through the heart of the Spring Valley community is recommended, including areas for planting and landscaping to lower the urban heat island effect and improve the pedestrian and bicycling environments.

As a part of the green street, 1-way Class IV cycle tracks are recommended for both sides of Jamacha Road. The cycle tracks will feature separation by parked cars. This type of separation minimizes the cost of providing a separated bikeway. End-of-trip bicycle facilities such as bike corrals are recommended to provide a space for people to lock their bike while frequenting businesses and other attractors and provide an additional buffer for pedestrians. Protected intersections are recommended to provide “All Ages and Abilities” crossings to and from the cycle track facility, where warranted.

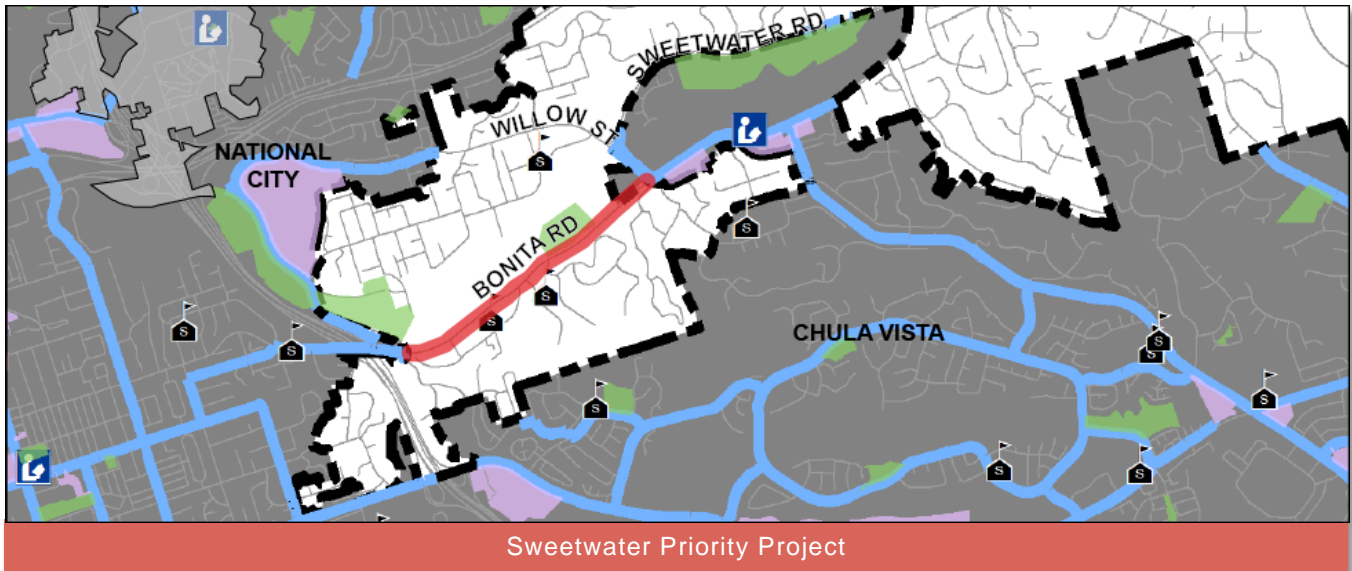
Considerations for mid-block crossings should be evaluated to improve pedestrian access to the opposite side of the street, particularly along long blocks of roadways.



## Sweetwater

### *Bonita Rd - Plaza Bonita Rd to Willow St*

This project includes the installation a Class IV cycle track to provide an 'All Ages and Abilities' facility to connect the cities of National City and Chula Vista with the community of Bonita. Protected intersection treatments should be considered at large intersections along the project to facilitate safe crossing for all users.

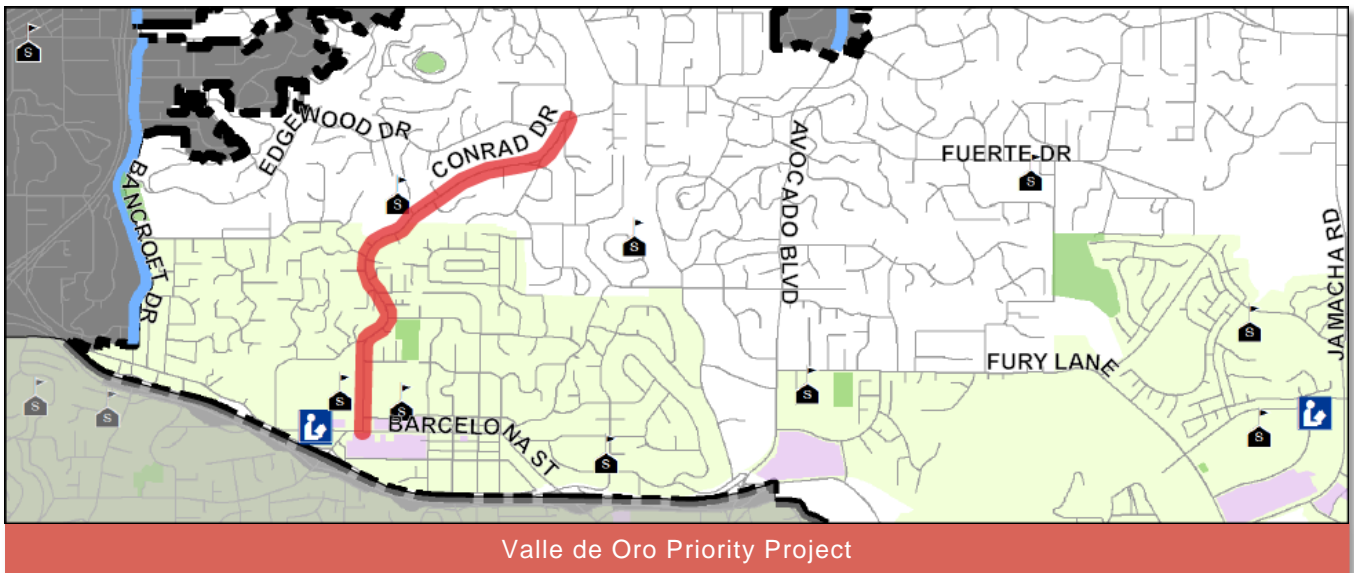


## Valle De Oro

### *Conrad Dr: Campo Rd to Edgewood Dr*

Class II bike lanes are recommended on both sides of Conrad Drive. Protected intersections should be considered to facilitate separated turning movements for all users.

In order to provide separated facilities for pedestrians, sidewalks or DG pathways are recommended to provide access to the schools on the west side of Conrad Drive. Mid-block crossings (with RRFBs, Raised Crosswalk, or HAWK Signals) are also recommended where warranted and most advantageous, particularly surrounding schools.



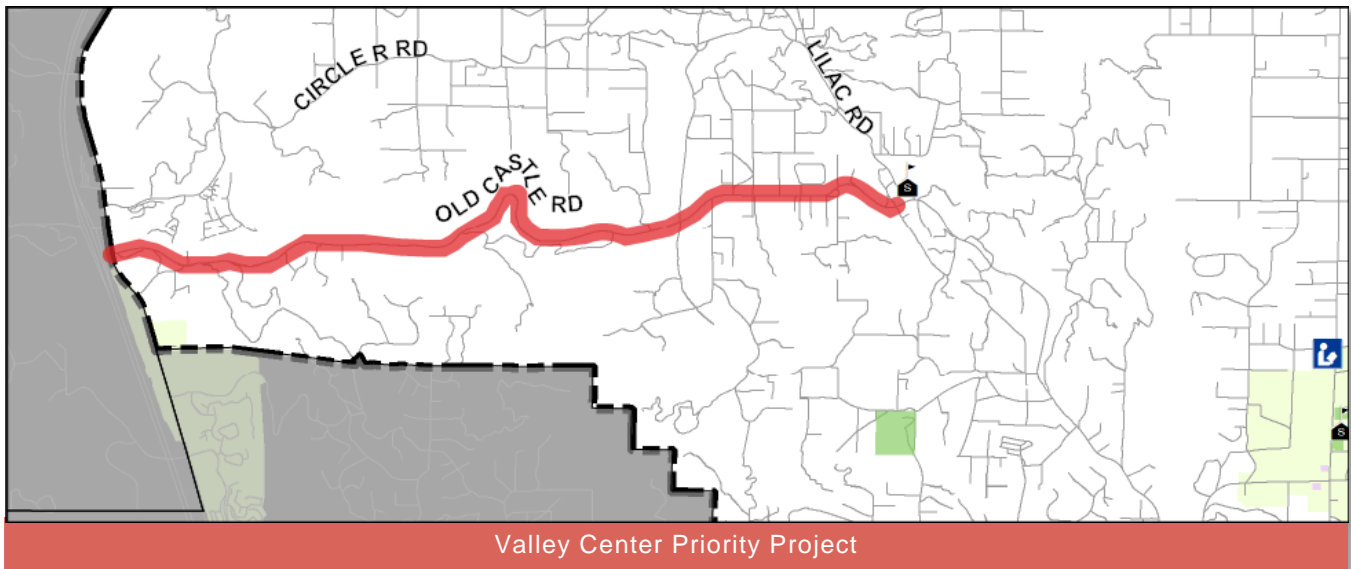


## Valley Center

### *Old Castle Rd - Lilac Rd to Valley Center Community Boundary*

Class II bike lanes are recommended on both sides of Old Castle Road. Protected intersection treatments at large intersections are recommended for consideration to facilitate separate turning movements for all modes and users.

To accommodate pedestrians, the installation of a DG path is recommended between residential areas and Lilac School, located at the intersection of Old Castle Road and Lilac Road. To encourage walking and pursue continued opportunities for funding, it is recommended that the school implement a SRTS program.
