
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- The comment states that the author has lived in the Ribbonwood area for 46 years, and that it used to be a peaceful place, but with the turbines and soon proposed power lines, the area has become noisy, with blinking lights, shadow flickers, and the sound of jets when the turbines are turning. For a discussion of Campo Wind Project with Boulder Brush Facilities noise impacts, refer to Chapter 2.6, Noise, of the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR). For a discussion of aesthetic impacts, including light and glare and shadow flicker, refer to Chapter 2.1, Aesthetics, and the Shadow Flicker Analysis (Appendix O) of the Draft EIR. Please also refer to Global Response GR-4, Noise, and Global Response GR-8, Visual Impacts. The comment does not raise an issue regarding the adequacy of the analysis contained in the Draft EIR; therefore, no further response is required.
- The comment provides a statement offering the reasoning behind why the author purchased their home in the country, and states the health issues the author has been living with. Please refer to Global Response GR-2, Public Health. This comment does not raise an issue related to the adequacy of the analysis contained within the Draft EIR; therefore, no further response is required.
- The comment states that property values will drop. Please refer to Global Response GR-1, Socioeconomic Impacts. This comment does not raise an issue related to the adequacy of the analysis contained within the Draft EIR; therefore, no further response is required.
- The comment begins by stating that the author's property is one way in and one way out and is within a major fire zone. The comment then states that the author lives in the area for health, peace, and quiet, and that the author has videos of the shadow flicker. The comment then provides concluding remarks, stating that the author has more comments and concerns, and that the author never thought that they would have to fight to keep their home quiet and peaceful.
