Hi Tona,

Yes, we concur that the gated entrances should be per DS-17, 18 or 19. For the onsite access roads, we could support D.G. or Class II base, but gravel or native soil would not be acceptable.

to check your input for these items:

- 1. We had commented that the gated driveway entrances must follow San Diego County Design Standard Drawings DS-17, DS-18, or DS-19 (with 38' turnaround radius). Will this be required by Fire?
- 2. For onsite access roads throughout the site, they are proposing Gravel or DG. Is this acceptable by Fire for this site? Some of the details in their plan showed compacted native soil, which I told them is not acceptable.
