I have reviewed the cultural resources aspects of the subject DEIR on behalf of this committee of the San Diego County Archaeological Society.

Based on the information contained in the DEIR and its cultural resources appendix, we have the following comments:

- 1. Mitigation needs to be provided for any archaeological sites which may fall within "defensible space" adjacent to development but within open space easements. The concern is that property owners may take it upon themselves to take actions within that area, to the detriment of the resources.
- 2. Likewise, the resource management plans for open space easements need to anticipate the
- potential for impacts to archaeological sites by firefighting activities.

 3. For the sites in the project area, the previous testing collections must be located and curated
