

Please refer to response to comment O10-23, which discusses the Groundwater Mitigation and Monitoring Program that will be implemented during construction and operation of the Proposed Project, per Mitigation Measure M-BI-PP-15. Please also refer to Appendix 3.1.5-6 (Table 3-20) which lists drawdown estimates by distance and duration of pumping. The commenters well (as depicted on the image attached to the comment letter) is located approximately 0.5-mile (2,640 feet) from Well 6b and based on the information provided in Table 3-20, projected drawdown would be less than significant based on County of San Diego well interference thresholds (see Section 1.3 of Appendix 3.1.5-6). For the Tierra del Sol Solar Farm, all wells to be monitored are listed in the GMMP, which are available for review on the County's administrative record for the Proposed Project. The administrative record for the Proposed Project can be found online at http://www.sdcounty.ca.gov/pds/cega/SOITEC SOLAR\_DEVELOPMENT\_ADMINISTRATIVE RECORDS.html. For the Rugged Solar Farm, all wells within ½ mile of the Project site are eligible to be included in the monitoring program.


