

<u>Discussion</u>: This request consists of an increase in density to a single parcel at the Lake Jennings Parkway/Interstate 8 interchange from Village Residential (VR) 4.3 to VR7.3, which would result in an increased yield of 15 dwelling units. The Lakeside CPG does not support the increase in density.

Rationale for Low Complexity Category:

- The request consists of a single parcel in a developed environment, adjacent to freeway connections, commercial services and residential parcels with both lower and higher densities.
- The workplan designation would result in an increase of approximately 15 dwelling units in a village environment that can support the additional density.
- Though mapped as Coastal Sage Scrub vegetation, aerial photos and street views reveal that most of the lot is highly disturbed with a low habitat value.
- Conservation Policy 9 of the Lakeside Community Plan encourages the preservation of mature trees on public and private
 property and requires equitable replacement of those removed. As such, any development proposal would likely avoid or
 replace the mature stand of trees in the eastern portion of the property.
