

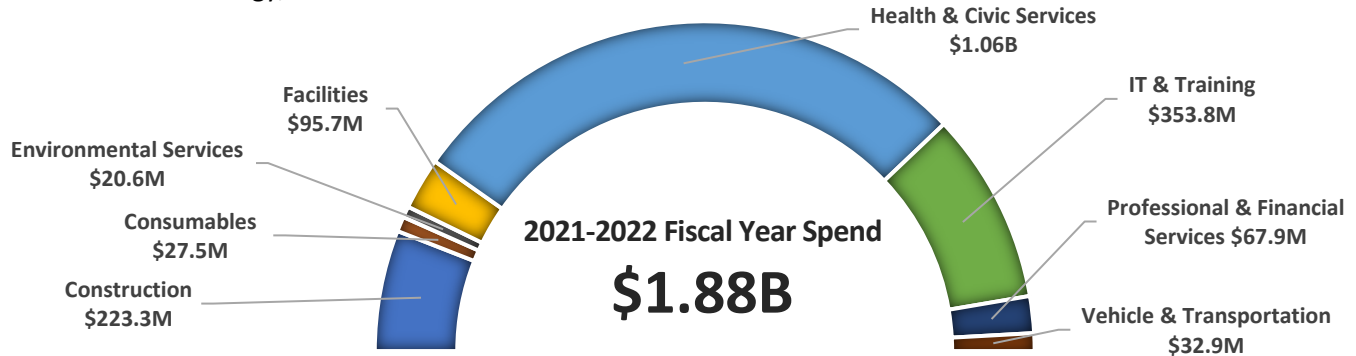

COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT METHODS

- **Request for Information (RFI)**
Market research invitation seeking industry feedback, best practices, etc.
- **Request for Quotation (RFQ)**
Awarded either to lowest price or best value as established in the RFQ.
- **Request for Bid (RFB)**
Awarded to the lowest responsive bid.
- **Request for Statement of Qualifications (RFSQ)**
Used as a first step to qualify Offerors leading to a second procurement action.
- **Request for Proposals (RFP)**
Awarded based on best value to County as established in the RFP.
