

COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT METHODS

- Request for Information (RFI) Market research invitation seeking industry feedback, best practices, etc.
- Request for Quotation (RFQ) Awarded either to lowest price or best value as established in the RFQ.
- Request for Bid (RFB) Awarded to the lowest responsive bid.
- Request for Statement of Qualifications (RFSQ) Used as a first step to qualify Offerors leading to a second procurement action.
- Request for Proposals (RFP) Awarded based on best value to County as established in the RFP.
