To Members of the Redistricting Commission:

I write again on behalf of the Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians to respectfully ask you to ensure that the Tribal Reservations in Inland North County are maintained in a North County Supervisorial District.

The independent and self-governing Nations, including the Reservations, of Rincon, Pala, La Jolla, Los Coyotes, Mesa Grande, Pauma/Yuima and San Pasqual are currently contained within one Supervisor District. We urge you to maintain their current placement within a North County district.

Doing so would ensure that the important community and intergovernmental ties we have forged with our neighbors will be maintained.

We value the deep and longstanding community and intergovernmental ties with our neighbors in the unincorporated communities, such as Valley Center, Bonsall, Fallbrook and Rainbow and the incorporated cities of Oceanside, Vista, San Marcos and Escondido.

For the Sovereign Tribal Reservations in North County, it is important that we continue to be part of a single North County Supervisor District, one that comprises the coastal and urban and rural communities that make up North County. These are our historic lands and we ask that you ensure that our voices continue to be heard.

Regarding the Commission's current draft maps, the current Draft Map 13a v.1-6 comes closest to representing a district that would ensure genuine and fair representation for the Sovereign Tribal Reservations of North County.
