



## County of San Diego Compost Voucher Program Application

In partnership with Waste Management of California, Inc., the County of San Diego is offering vouchers to help cover the cost of compost and/or compost delivery to unincorporated area agricultural producers.

The funding for this opportunity is being provided by the American Rescue Plan Act and is required to support unincorporated area producers who are in certain qualified census tracts. To verify if your operation meets the requirements, use the [Compost Voucher Eligibility Map](#). Click on the search box to type in an address or click within the map to determine eligibility. If you are unsure if you meet the requirements, please still submit an application and County staff will notify you upon review.

To apply for a voucher, complete the application below. Once complete, click the “Submit Application” icon at the bottom of the page and follow the prompts to email the application to County staff. Or, download the completed application as a PDF and email to County staff (details below). The application can also be printed, filled out, scanned, and sent to County staff.

The applicant(s) will receive a confirmation email that the application was received. If you do not receive a confirmation email, please contact County staff. The application will be reviewed for eligibility by County staff. If approved, you will receive a voucher which you can redeem with Waste Management.
